From the port in Bari, you'll head to **Matera**, a city that you don't simply visit: you've got to experience it. Wander among the **Sassi**, houses and churches carved into the rock, and inhabited for thousands of years, which are now a **UNESCO World Heritage site**. With a local guide, discover a truly timeless place, where history is everywhere and a surprise hides around every corner. And between one surprise and the next, don't forget to look up: you may spot a Lesser Kestrel, the true **Master of the house** in Matera.

Main stops

- Matera's alleys and houses dug out of the limestone
- "Stones" and rock churches with frescoes

The programme

- From the port of Bari, you'll travel to **Matera** by bus. The city is truly astonishing. It is centuries old, with **roots in the Bronze Age**, enriched by a globally unique **artistic and cultural heritage**.
- Our **local guide** will accompany you on a tour through the narrow streets and past the houses dug out of the limestone rock. You'll visit the **Stones**, the two districts dug out of the Murgia stone which, together with over 100 rock churches, are considered a **UNESCO World Heritage Site**. Inhabited since prehistory up until the 1950s, this urban ecosystem has, over time, made expert use of natural resources like water, soil and energy. Mel Gibson found the right inspiration here to create the film set for the epic movie **The Passion of the Christ**.
- Don't be surprised if you find many wooden nests among the Stones. They are used to help with the reproduction of the **Lesser Kestrel**, a symbol of Matera that is in danger of extinction.
- The tour of the City of Stones includes a walk across rough ground.
- Slight changes may be made to itineraries and the length of excursions in order to safeguard your health and comply with regulations and the safety protocol.

ALBEROBELLO, THE VILLAGE OF TRULLI: A FAIRYTALE EXPERIENCE

In a nutshell

Alberobello, the village that looks like a fairytale...but it's all real. With a local guide, wander among the trulli - white houses with a unique shape that now have **UNESCO World Heritage status**. Stroll through the lively, colorful Rione Monti neighborhood and through Aia Piccola: it's still inhabited, but here time seems to have stood still. Every symbol on the roofs tells a story, every trullo is different to the next. And to end on a high? A typical tasting with a delicious glass of wine. You don't visit Alberobello: you savor it.

Main stops

- Trulli of Alberobello
- Rione Monti and Rione Aia Piccola
- Local food tasting

The programme

- You'll travel to **Alberobello** on our bus. Accompanied by a **local guide**, you'll visit the two urban areas with the greatest number of trulli: **Rione Monti** to the south, where there are roughly a thousand trulli used as craft workshops, and **Rione Aia Piccola**, with around 400 units that are actual homes belonging to local inhabitants.
- These buildings, which are typically white, cylindrical and topped with a dome, date from the **mid-14th century** and have been declared a **UNESCO World Heritage Site**. An edict of the Kingdom of Naples levied a tax on every new building. This is how the idea of the trulli was conceived; as they were built without mortar, they were considered to be temporary constructions and therefore not taxable.
- The whiteness of the walls indicates purity and the whitewashed symbols on the dome indicate the family's religion, while the shape of the overlapping stone pinnacles was the final touch that made your home unique and recognizable.
- We can't leave Alberobello without tasting some local products, accompanied by a glass of wine.

ALL OF BARI BY MINIATURE TRAIN: THE ICONIC PLACES AND THE SOUL OF THE CITY

In a nutshell

Hop on board the train, relax...and let **Bari** come to you! A simple, fun way to explore the city, setting off from the **Basilica of St. Nicholas**. Then, get lost amongst the authentic alleyways of **Bari Vecchia**, where tradition comes to life on the famous street of orecchiette...where you'll be surrounded by handmade pasta! The journey continues to the **Norman-Swabian Castle**, where you can stroll between its medieval walls and admire the city from above. Surrounded by legends, glimpses of the sea and interesting facts, you'll arrive at **Piazza Ferrarese**, for a **tasting of a typical treat**. Then enjoy the grand finale on Europe's longest seafront promenade, where the sea, the city and the flavors will leave you with memories that will stay with you forever.

Main stops

- Old town of Bari
- Basilica of San Nicola, crypt and miraculous column
- Norman-Swabian Castle: external visit
- Piazza Ferrarese with food tasting and free time
- Bari's seafront promenade

The programme

- Take a seat on the miniature train and set off for the **Basilica of San Nicola**, the city's protector. Walk down into the crypt that houses the **saint's relics** and the legendary **miraculous column**.
- Strolling around Old Bari you'll soon come to the **orecchiette street**, where local women get together to **make pasta by hand**. A few steps further on is the **Norman Swabian Castle**, a 13th century fortress built to defend the city, **destroyed in 1156 by the people of Bari themselves** and then rebuilt by **Frederick II** as it is today. Make the most of the view from the **medieval walls** to follow in the footsteps of the lookouts on their tour of duty.
- Rejoin the train for **Piazza Ferrarese**, the center of Bari nightlife. Take a photo near the **infamous column**, an ancient pillory for debtors, and take the opportunity to **taste local products**. End on a high with a trip along the **seafront promenade**, the longest in Europe at 15 km.
- This is one of the most popular excursions so book early.

Hop into a **rickshaw** and experience **Matera** like never before! Whiz through the **Sassi** neighborhoods, along narrow streets and past cave dwellings and views like something straight out of a movie. In the districts of **Barisano** and **Caveoso**, which boast UNESCO World Heritage status, there's a surprise around every corner: frescoed churches, ancient stories and breathtaking views. Discover life in the cave houses, breathe in the atmosphere of a city sculpted from stone... and don't be surprised if you feel like you're walking through a movie set. Welcome to Matera!

Main stops

- Rickshaw ride through the old town and the Sassi neighborhoods.
- The **Cave House** - a typical dwelling carved out of the rock.

The programme

Set off to conquer **Matera**, the oldest city in southern Italy: here, the houses are carved out of the rock, the churches are more like caves and time has taken a coffee break of a century or two. But don't be alarmed: here, you won't be walking - instead, whiz about **in a rickshaw** among the **Sassi**, in the **Barisano** and **Caveoso** neighborhoods - a UNESCO world heritage site sculpted from the rock, with the same patience as it takes to prepare a proper Sunday lunch.

You'll step inside the **Cave House** to discover what life was like when **open space** meant a single room for everyone and everything. And you'll find yourself looking at frescoed churches that would make certain city museums pale in comparison.

It'll be like stepping onto a film set, and it's no coincidence that **Mel Gibson** filmed **The Passion of the Christ** here. Except that here, you write the script: laughter, stories, anecdotes, and glimpses that will make you want to stay.

And before going back, you'll receive a small souvenir. Because you may not be able to take **Matera** home...but at least you can keep a little piece of it in your pocket.

- Make sure you have your driving license and some ID with you to ride the rickshaw.

ALL OF BARI: THE TREASURES OF THE OLD AND NEW CITY

In a nutshell

Discover **the Old and the New Town in Bari**, on a tour that will take you straight to the heart of the city! Set off from the majestic **Basilica of Saint Nicholas** and wander through the historic alleyways of the Bari Vecchia, the old town, from the church of Saint Gregory to the iconic Norman-Swabian Castle, with views that reveal centuries of history. Then, make your way through Bari Nuova, the city's newest neighborhood, with its elegant seafront, 1930s buildings and glimpses of the sea, before ending on a high with a tasting of typical products. An experience that combines history, atmosphere and flavors in every corner of the city.

Main stops

- The historic centre of Bari: Basilica of Saint Nicholas and Church of Saint Gregory
- Norman-Swabian Castle (external visit)
- The New City

The programme

- This tour takes us to the beautiful historical centre of Bari to visit its "treasures". We start with the **Basilica of Saint Nicholas** * built in the Apulian Romanesque style during the Norman domination * where the relics of the famous patron saint of the city are preserved, followed by a tour of the exterior of the **Church of Saint Gregory**. Built during the 10th and 11th centuries, its interior is divided into three naves which lead to three apses.
- The tour proceeds with a visit of the exterior of the famous **Castello Normanno-Svevo (Norman-Swabian Castle)**, a defensive bulwark of the old town that has come to symbolise the whole city. Built by the Normans in the 12th century, it was destroyed in 1156 and rebuilt at the behest of Frederick II between 1233 and 1240. The manor is one of the most interesting fortifications in the region, above all because of its strategic location. The castle, which is a fascinating example of a

medieval construction, has numerous extensions that were built in successive periods. Today it hosts occasional events and temporary exhibitions.

- After a pleasant tasting of typical products, we move to the città nuova (the new city). We then proceed with a panoramic tour along the seafront promenade, Bari's pride and joy, which features numerous imposing buildings from the 1930s.

Main stops

The programme

- Our excursion begins with a **scenic coach tour** of the hills overlooking the city of Dubrovnik, which offer breathtaking views of the old town, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- We continue along the stunning eastern stretch of the **Dubrovnik Riviera**, with its string of picturesque seaside villages, exceptionally beautiful coves and hills teeming with lush Mediterranean vegetation.
- We reach the town of **Cavtat**, also known as the Old City. It is one of the oldest settlements in this area of the Adriatic and lies on a strip of land that juts out into the sea and is surrounded by hills.
- After a short **guided walking tour of Cavtat**, we are free to explore the town in our own time, walking along the promenade dotted with palm trees, wandering around the shops and taking in the sea views.
- We continue our tour and cross the lush Konavle valley, an enchanted corner between Bosnia and Montenegro where the mountains retract to give space to vineyards and crops.
- We stop in a **typical Croatian village** where we are welcomed by a local family living in a characteristic valley home and which has been producing grape distillates, olive oil and wine following traditional techniques for generations.
- We are served a **delicious lunch with local dishes** accompanied by a glass of excellent wine and the melodies of two musicians playing Croatian and international songs.
- We then head back to our starting point for a short **guided tour of Dubrovnik**, where we can admire the magnificent exteriors of its monuments and soak up the charming atmosphere in the old town.
- After our walk, we have some free time to **further explore** the most fascinating spots in the city on our own before returning to the ship by coach.
- The excursion involves walking for about 1 hour and 15 minutes. We therefore recommended wearing comfortable shoes and clothing.
- This excursion is not recommended for guests with mobility problems.
- We recommend that you book early because only a limited number of places are available.

Dubrovnik **CABRIO BUS IN DUBROVNIK**

In a nutshell

Put on your sun cream and board the **cabrio bus**. This time you'll visit Dubrovnik comfortably seated, with the wind in your hair. Be ready to immortalize it all in photographs. If you prefer, you don't even have to get off the bus. At the end of the excursion, if the length of the stopover permits, stay as long as you wish in the city center for a walk and some shopping and then get back on board free of charge with the Costa shuttle bus service, showing your Costa Card to the driver. Check the time for returning on board and of the last available shuttle bus in **Oggi a Bordo**

- Climb up to Mount Sr, panoramic stop
- Franjo Tudjman Bridge, Bosanka, Old Town: photo stops

The programme

- Wondering what a **cabrio bus** is? It's a partly open-top bus with a light roof covering and fully opening windows. There's nothing better for a 360 degree tour of the city. Jump on and head straight to **Mount Sr**. It's the **best place** from which to enjoy the whole of Dubrovnik. So, with camera or smartphone in hand, snap, post and watch the likes pour in!
- You'll then cross the recently built Franjo Tudjman bridge, a **500-meter cable-stayed bridge** built over a fjord to connect the two shores of the Bay of Ombla.
- On your way back to port, you'll pass by the picturesque town of **Bosanka**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- Commentary will be provided via an audio guide with earphones supplied at the beginning of the tour.

A STROLL THROUGH THE MIDDLE AGES

In a nutshell

Walk through the old town of **Dubrovnik**, a **UNESCO World Heritage Site**. Follow the ancient **Stradun**, visit **Europe's first pharmacy** and the **Franciscan Monastery**, slow down as you pass by **paintings of the Ragusa school** and the **Sponza Palace**.

Main stops

- Old town: Vrata od Pila, Stradun, Onofrio's Fountain
- Franciscan Monastery with the oldest pharmacy in the world and Dominican Monastery
- Sponza Palace, Church of St. Blaise: external visits

The programme

- Board the bus on the hill above **Dubrovnik**, but only to see why the Romans called it **Ragusa**, i.e. **on the cliff**
- From here you'll proceed **on foot**. Passing through the Vrata od Pila, the 1537 gateway to the old town, you'll be officially inside the medieval citadel named a **UNESCO World Heritage Site**. Follow the paved **Stradun** through the city center to the **Loggia Square**.
- In the **Franciscan Monastery** you'll find a cloister with frescoes depicting the life of St. Francis and **the oldest pharmacy in Europe**, operating since 1317. Walking among the glass cases of the **Dominican Monastery** you'll find sacred gold objects, manuscripts and paintings of the Renaissance **Ragusa school**
- Count the columns in the **Sponza Palace** portico, continue to the **Church of St. Blaise**, the city's patron saint.

PANORAMIC WALK ALONG DUBROVNIK'S HISTORIC WALLS

In a nutshell

Main stops

- Pile Gate
- Minceta Tower
- Fort Bokar
- St John's Fortress
- Maritime Museum

The programme

- In the company of our local guide we climb to the panoramic heights of the hill overlooking the city, from where we can admire a breathtaking view of the hamlet that was once the legendary Ragusa.
- We then return towards Pile Gate where we begin our walk along the city walls: an imposing system of fortifications, among the most beautiful and best preserved in the entire Mediterranean, which still protects Dubrovnik's historic centre today.
- On a panoramic route of nearly 2 km, we walk along the city's bastions, admiring spectacular monuments such as the **Minceta Tower**, a powerful and monumental fortress that is a symbol of Dubrovnik, with its mighty round body towering dramatically above the city's highest point, dominating land and sea and protecting the inhabitants from all threats.
- We proceed to **Fort Bokar**, a circular stronghold built between 1564 and 1570, whose strategic position dominates the open sea and protects the western port, the moat and Pile Gate.
- We then move on to **St. John's Fortress** which hosts the **Maritime Museum** where we can learn all about the city's great naval traditions, its maritime history, its sea captains and its skilled ship builders.
- We spend some time at the **Maritime Museum** looking at documents, prints, portraits and model ships that bear witness to the major maritime development of the Republic of Ragusa and the evolution of steamships.
- The excursion involves a long walk, it is therefore recommended to wear comfortable shoes.
- This excursion is not recommended for guests with mobility problems.
- Guests can return to the ship on the shuttle buses provided. Please check in the **Diario di bordo** program the timing of the last shuttle bus available.

At the end of the excursion, if the length of the stopover permits, stay as long as you wish in the city center for a walk and some shopping and then get back on board free of charge with the Costa shuttle bus service, showing your Costa Card to the driver. Check the time for returning on board and of the last available shuttle bus in **Oggi a Bordo**.

- Dubrovnik's old town
- Island of Lokrum

The programme

Discover Dubrovnik accompanied **by our guide** along the spectacular **Stradun**, one of the most picturesque **pedestrian streets in Europe**. Beautiful, elegant and with a hushed atmosphere, it is 300 meters long and paved with **polished white limestone**. With its elegant buildings, stores, restaurants and cafés, it is the heart of the city.

At the **clock tower**, you may see the **Belencio** or **green twins** cast in bronze they emerge on the hour to strike a 2-ton, 16th century bell.

But now it's time to board a **motor boat** to reach the **island of Lokrum**, a paradise of Mediterranean and exotic vegetation, with pine trees, oak trees, cacti and palms.

The island is famous for its Dead Sea, a small natural saltwater lake created over the years thanks to a dense system of underground caves that allows sea water to resurface almost perfectly in the center of the island.

There are still the remains here of the Benedictine Monastery and Castle which were used as settings for several scenes in **Game of Thrones**. Fancy a swim? If so, there's a beach that's ready and waiting.

- There are no beach loungers or umbrellas on the beach.
- This is one of the most popular excursions so book early.

DUBROVNIK, FROM THE CABLE CAR TO THE DRAWBRIDGE

In a nutshell

If you have a bucket list of things to do in your lifetime, boarding a **cable car** from the sea and crossing a **drawbridge** might be two fairly unusual wishes, however you can fulfill them both on the same excursion in **Dubrovnik**. At the end of the excursion, if the length of the stopover permits, stay as long as you wish in the city center for a walk and some shopping and then get back on board free of charge with the Costa shuttle bus service, showing your Costa Card to the driver. Check the time for returning on board and of the last available shuttle bus in **Oggi a Bordo**.

Main stops

- Cable car to the summit of Mount Sr, museum of the Croatian War of Independence
- Dubrovnik's old town: Vrata od Ploa, Stradun, Church of St. Blaise, Onofrio's Fountain, Cathedral, Sponza Palace, external visits
- Drawbridge, Vrata od Pila

The programme

- The cable car takes just 4 minutes to reach the summit of **Mount Sr**. From the arrival station, 405 meters up, you can enjoy the view over the terracotta tiled roofs of the fortified city to the island of Lokrum, with the background of the sea and the Elaphite Islands on the horizon. Destroyed during the war of independence that began in 1991, the cable car has since been restored and put back into service.
- As a testimony to that war, there is an impressive collection of weapons, bullets, grenades and soldiers' uniforms at the **Croatian War of Independence Museum**, where the symbols of the recent struggle are housed in a 200-year-old fortress at the top of the mountain that was the last line in the heroic defense of Dubrovnik.

- Returning to the lower station, a 10-minute walk will bring you to **Vrata od Ploa**, the eastern gate to Dubrovnik's old town, close to the old harbor and an the entry point for caravans from the East.
- The excursion on foot will start here and continue along the **Stradun**, the main street, past the church of St. Blaise, **Onofrio's Fountain**, the **cathedral**, **Sponza Palace**, **Vrata od Pila** and across a real **drawbridge** under the watchful eye of **St. Blaise**. Just think that long ago the bridge was raised every evening, the door was closed and the key delivered to the prince.
- OK, you've just crossed two wishes off your bucket list.
- The cable car ticket price is included in the excursion price.
- The cable car operation is dependent upon weather conditions.
- Slight changes may be made to itineraries and the length of excursions to protect your health and to comply with regulations and the safety protocol.

Main stops

- Dubrovnik's old town, Vrata od Pila, Lovrijenac Fortress
- Kolorina Bay
- Lokrum Island: panoramic view
- Snack on Betina Beach

The programme

- **Vrata od Pila**, the main entrance to the old town, is accessed across a stone bridge supported by two Gothic arches built in 1471.

- Your **kayaking** adventure begins not far from here, in **Kolorina Bay**. You'll follow your local guide to a spot just below the walls of the **Lovrijenac Fortress**, which looks even more impressive viewed at this angle from the sea. We're talking about the famous Red Keep, a 37-meter high structure overlooking the sea, used as the **King's Landing** in the TV series **Game of Thrones**.
- Then continue along the southern section of the old town walls until you spot **Lokrum Island**. Rest your paddles on **Betina Beach**: it's time for a dip and some snorkeling to admire the many species of plant and animal life to be found on the sea bed here.
- All these activities will make you hungry so a **fresh snack** is what you need before returning to Kolorina Bay.
- A local guide will provide the necessary instructions for the activity.
- The excursion is unsuitable for children under 11 years old.
- Life jackets must be worn during the kayak trip.
- Two-seater kayaks are used for the excursion.
- Guests can return on board using the shuttle bus. Check the time of the last shuttle in the Diario di Bordo.

Here we can lie in the sun and enjoy a refreshing drink or take a dip in the crystal clear waters.
- The beach of Jaz is also a meeting place for music lovers, as it hosts many events and concerts by world-renowned artists such as Madonna and the Rolling Stones every year. It is ideal for those who want to sip cocktails accompanied by good music and the warm embrace of the sun.
- Do not forget to bring swimwear, a towel, sunglasses and sun cream.

Kotor WALK AROUND KOTOR

In a nutshell

An excursion to discover Kotor, a picturesque town overlooking the crystal clear waters of Kotor Bay, and the Medieval treasures inside its ancient walls.

Main stops

- Ancient walls
- Old town
- St. Tryphon Cathedral
- Maritime Museum

The programme

- The town of Kotor, at the foot of Mount Lov_en, is located on a coastal strip in the Gulf of Kotor. The construction work on the **ancient fortification walls** started in the Middle Ages, in 1420 when Kotor was at the height of its splendour. and was only finished in the 18th century. The walls are 15 metres high and extend for 4.5 km around the town to St. John's Castle 280 m above sea level.
- In the **old town**, with its well-preserved medieval character, we will visit the **Cathedral of St. Tryphon**, built in 1166, to admire the Romanesque architecture enhanced by Byzantine elements. Inside, we observe the square pillars alternating with ancient columns between the naves and the apse.
- We will then visit the **Maritime Museum**, which illustrates the maritime tradition of the city,

consolidated between the 16th and 18th centuries, as well as recalling the most famous fleets and captains of its history.

- After our guided visit, we have some free time to walk around the picturesque streets to do some shopping or relax in one of the many cafés.
- We recommend wearing comfortable shoes.
- Dress code that is appropriate for the places of worship to be visited is recommended.
- This excursion is not recommended for guests with mobility problems and pregnant women.
- The itinerary may be subject to change.

BUDVA AND KOTOR: A TALE OF TWO CITIES

In a nutshell

We walk past the ancient walls of Budva to admire the picturesque town centre and venture among the Medieval treasures of Kotor, a city that has been declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Main stops

- Budva: old town, ancient walls, historic centre
- Kotor: historic centre

The programme

- After leaving the port of Kotor, we travel by coach to **Budva**, one of the most ancient towns of the region. According to the legend, the city was founded by Cadmus, son of Agenor, a Phoenician king. After leaving Thebes, he arrived with his chariot in the place that would later become Budva. The old city was originally located on an island which, over the centuries, became a peninsula due to the formation of a sandy isthmus connecting it to the mainland.
- Surrounded by **15th-century walls**, this imposing Medieval fortress is made up of towers and various access gates located along the walls.
- Once inside, we stroll around the **historic centre** made up of a charming maze of streets, squares

and monuments that is made even more interesting by the Venetian-inspired style adopted when rebuilding the city after the earthquake of 1979 in memory of Venetian domination.

- On our way back, we stop to visit **Kotor**, a magnificent town that was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and we spend some time in the **historic centre**, which bears clear evidence of the golden age of the city in Medieval times.
- Dress code that is appropriate for the places of worship to be visited is recommended.
- Places on this excursion are limited. We recommend booking early.

PERAST, VISIT TO "OUR LADY OF THE ROCKS" AND KOTOR

In a nutshell

An evocative journey to discover the only artificial island in the Adriatic Sea, ending with a visit to the town of Kotor and its Medieval treasures.

Main stops

- Island of "Our Lady of the Rocks"
- Kotor: St. Tryphon Cathedral, Maritime Museum

The programme

- After a short bus ride, we reach the picturesque town of Perasto. A great maritime power that reached the height of its splendour in the 17th and 18th centuries, Perasto is in fact the best preserved Baroque town in Montenegro to this day.
- A boat then takes us to the **artificial island of "Our Lady of the Rocks"** (*Gospa od Ćr pjela*), built around a small rock (*Ćr pjela*) by the locals over the centuries using stones and parts of old sunken ships. Here we visit the church, dedicated to the Madonna, which has been defined a "true treasure trove", a testimony of the history and tradition of Perast. Before heading back, we stop to enjoy the magnificent view of the Bay of Kotor.

- We then board the boat again and head towards **Kotor**, a picturesque city surrounded by imposing Medieval walls that was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site after the earthquake of 1979.
- We stroll around the streets of the historic centre and see the **Cathedral of St. Tryphon**, the oldest cathedral on the eastern coast of the Adriatic Sea which boasts a precious collection of 14th-century Venetian art.
- We then visit the **Maritime Museum**, located in the 18th-century Grgurina palace, where we admire model ships, tools, banners, photographs and artefacts.
- At the end of our guided tour, we will have some free time to wander around the city and buy some souvenirs.
- Dress code that is appropriate for the places of worship to be visited is recommended.
- The itinerary may be subject to change.

- We then descend to the sea and we come to **Budva**, where we stop to stroll around the picturesque Medieval streets and admire the ancient 15th-century walls that surround the historic centre. The town is now located on a peninsula which was formerly an island and subsequently connected to the mainland by a sandy isthmus which formed over the years.
- The tour is conducted mainly by coach.

World Heritage Site.

- We start with the **Old Town**, which bears clear evidence of the golden age of the city in Medieval times, and continue along the coast dotted with picturesque fishing towns nestled in charming small bays.
- We reach the **fishing village of Mulla**, located at the foothills of a mountain and still maintaining the charm of days gone by with its moored boats and fishing nets hung to dry.
- We arrive at **Verige Bay**, a spectacular strait separating the Bay of Kotor from the Bay of Tivat and offering magnificent views over Baroque Perast.
- We venture into the picturesque **city of Tivast**, once a fishing village turned into a wealthy industrial centre where we will see the most modern side of the fjord.
- We cross the luxury resort of **Porto Montenegro**, where we admire the spacious seafront villas , exclusive restaurants and elegant harbour with first-class services.
- We then head back to Kotor, which we see from a new perspective as we climb down towards the town from the **Vrmac peninsula heights** offering enchanting views of the fjord.
- We recommend that you book early because only a limited number of places are available.
- A tuk tuk can carry a maximum of 4 passengers.
- It is not possible to bring strollers or wheelchairs on board the tuk tuk.

Lying in a valley along the River Alfios in north-western Peloponnese, Olympia held the famous Olympic Games in honour of Zeus every four years. Here in 776 BC, a list of winners was drawn up for the first time, presumably the results of the very first Olympics in history.
- As we stroll around ancient Olympia amongst the **archaeological excavations**, it feels as though we can still hear the spectators shouting to encourage the athletes and breathe the festive atmosphere which accompanied those 5, very long days, during which the best athletes challenged each other in the various sports: wrestling matches, charriot and horse races, the pentathlon and *pankration* (a primitive form of boxing). Let's delve into the past and discover the little secrets of the competition which was first accessible only for male athletes of Greek origin and was later opened up to young Romans. Perhaps not everyone knows that women and slaves were banned from the town, the sanctuaries and the terraces, at the risk of a terrible death by being thrown from a nearby cliff.
- We will stop in the **ancient squares**, where traders and citizens once met to carry out their business.
- After our exciting tour of the excavations, the kids can feel like athletes from Ancient Greece and challenge one another in an **event similar to the ancient Olympic Games**, to relive the fun of the past. The winner will be crowned according to ancient tradition with an olive branch, the *kotinos*, in honour of Zeus, the father of the Gods.
- Before we end our excursion, all the children will be given a certificate of participation to remind them of this unforgettable day when they competed "not for the prize, but for the honour".
