**EASY TOUR MARSEILLE**

**Description**

A tour for those who want to explore Marseille free from a fixed itinerary, with plenty of time to ourselves and a special guide who will give us the historical, cultural and practical information we need to explore the city on our own.

**What we will see**

- The Old Port, Fort Saint-Jean and the Cathedral of Saint-Marie-Majeure
- La Tourette Esplanade, Panier Quarter, La Vieille Charité, Daviel Pavilion and the Town Hall Square
- Dockside Area

**What we will do**

- Our guide will be waiting to welcome us as we disembark from the ship. Together, we make our way to the city centre, specifically, a point near the Old Harbour where we begin our walking tour with a visit to **Fort Saint-Jean**, built in 1660 at the behest of Louis XIV, and the chance to admire the exterior of the Neo-Byzantine **Cathedral of Saint-Marie-Majeure**.
- Next, we head across **La Tourette Esplanade**, which offers views over both the old and new harbours.
- Together with our guide, we visit the old heart of the city, the **Panier** quarter, with its artisan workshops and colourful, lively cafés, then pay a visit to **La Vieille Charité**, built in 1664 as an almshouse for the city's poor and now home to a cultural centre and a venue for temporary exhibitions
- We then proceed on foot through typical, narrow Provençal streets to the **Daviel Pavillion**, which in turn leads to the **square in front of the Town Hall**.
- The last stop on our tour takes us to the **Dockside** area, a lively part of the city with many galleries, restaurants and shops. Our guide will give us some useful pointers as to where to make our purchases.
- At this point, we are left with plenty of free time and we are given a map of the city to explore **Marseille at leisure**.
- At the end of the excursion, we can avail ourselves of the dedicated shuttle bus service to make our way back to the port.
- Places on this excursion are limited. We recommend booking early to avoid disappointment.
- This excursion is not recommended for guests with mobility problems.
- This excursion involves some walking. We recommend wearing appropriate footwear and comfortable clothing?

MARSEILLE DISCOVERY & TASTE

**What we will see**

- The Church of Saint Laurent and the view of the Old Port
- La Major Cathedral and Esplanade
- Museum Complex
- Panier quarter, La Vieille Charité courtyard and loggia

**What we will do**

- We begin our discovery tour of Marseille by taking the shuttle bus from the port to the Church of Saint-Laurent. The little square in front of the church offers **beautiful views of the Old Port** and the hills surrounding the city.
- We make our way downhill from the church towards Marseille's Neo-Byzantine cathedral, known locally as **La Major**. After a tour around the outside of the building, we have a short stop in the new **Esplanade**, recently completed to coincide with Marseille's nomination as the "European capital of culture 2013".
- We then make our way to the new **museum complex**, which comprises three institutions: the Musée Regards de Provence, the Ville Méditerranée and MuCEM the Museum of European and Mediterranean Civilisations. Our guide will provide an overview of each building from the outside.
- We walk onwards, heading into the old heart of the city, the **Panier** quarter, with its artisan workshops and colourful, bustling cafés.
- Before we make our way into the web of narrow streets of the old town, we stop to visit the courtyard and the loggia of **La Vieille Charité**, a building that originally served as an almshouse for the city's poor, but which is now home to a cultural centre and a venue for temporary exhibitions. We then take another short break to sample the famous panissa, a sort of cake made with just a few humble ingredients: chickpea flour, water and salt.
- We make our way back to the Old Port, where we can either board the ship straight away, or spend a couple of hours of free time in the city centre.

Space is limited, so please reserve early. Comfortable walking shoes are recommended. The order of visits may vary.

We will have complete freedom to explore Aix-en-Provence, savouring the joy of strolling through its narrow streets, squares and historic buildings, and discovering its colours and aromas with a visit to the local market or an open-air café.

**What we will see**

- Aix-en-Provence
- City centre
- Cours Mirabeau
- Mazarin Quarter
- Place des Quatre Dauphins
- Saint Sauveur Cathedral
- Shops, cafés and local fruit market

**What we will do**

- We will leave the port by coach and make our way to **Aix-en-Provence**, a university and spa city and the political hub of Provence, located about 30 minutes away from Marseille.
- As soon as we arrive in Aix-en-Provence, we will immediately notice its sophisticated atmosphere as we walk freely around the **romantic streets** in the centre, admiring aristocratic residences dating back to the 17th and 18th centuries.
- Our walk wouldn't be complete without a stroll along **Cours Mirabeau**, a stunning, tree-lined avenue boasting beautiful fountains and numerous outdoor cafés.
- Another must is the **Mazarin Quarter**, designed by the Archbishop Michel Mazarin, brother of the famous Cardinal.
- In the same area we can also admire the **Place des Quatre Dauphins** or "Four Dolphins Square", with a beautiful fountain adorned by sculptures of four dolphins, and the **Saint Sauveur Cathedral**, featuring various architectural styles ranging from the 5th to the 17th century, which can be admired from all sides.
- Yet Aix-en-Provence isn't all history and art, it's also **a vibrant town offering a host of activities**. We will set some time aside to independently explore the elegant streets dotted with typical shops, the local fruit and vegetable market or relax at a café.

An excursion for everybody with a taste of what is considered the capital of the South of France: a panoramic tour of Marseille's main landmarks and some free time for shopping or simply to walk around the city centre.


**What we will see**

- La Corniche seafront promenade, Escale Borely
- Sainte-Marie-Majeure Cathedral, Fort Saint-Jean, Church of Saint-Laurent (panoramic) and Basilica of Notre-Dame de la Garde
- The Old Port

**What we will do**

- We will start our coach trip driving along the famous **Corniche Kennedy**, Marseille's seafront promenade with a fantastic view of the islands at the entrance to the port, and we proceed up to the **Escale Borely** where we stop briefly to take some photos and admire the view.
- We set off again and make our way to the Neo-Byzantine **Cathedral of Sainte-Marie-Majeure**, where we make another stop to take more photographs. Our route then takes us to **Fort Saint-Jean** built in 1660 by Louis XIV , the church of Saint-Laurent, a fine example of Provençal Romanesque architecture built in pink stone from Couronne and the **Basilica of Notre-Dame de la Garde** which commands splendid views of the city.
- At the end of the tour the coach will drop us off at the **Old Port** area, where we have a little **free time** for **shopping** or a stroll around the city, before heading back to the port.
- During religious functions visits to churches are limited to a tour of the exterior.
- We recommend wearing comfortable shoes.
- Dress code that is appropriate for the places of worship to be visited is recommended.
- This excursion is not recommended for guests with mobility problems.
- This excursion is reserved for guests who are not ending their cruise at Marseille.

**AVIGNON, CITY OF THE POPES**
**Description**

An opportunity not to be missed to explore a UNESCO World Heritage Site, Avignon, "the city of the Popes": a step back into the history of the church and the Papacy, tracing the splendour of the reign of 7 pontiffs who brought prosperity and prominence to Avignon.

**What we will see**

- Palace of the Popes
- Free time for shopping and exploring the city

**What we will do**

- We leave the port of Marseille by coach, and head for **Avignon**, a journey that takes about one hour. The city of Avignon is famous for having been the seat of the Papacy from 1309 to 1377, a period known as the Avignon captivity . Pope Clement V transferred the Papal court from Rome to Avignon, from where 7 Popes reigned until 1377 and 2 antipopes stayed on almost until the end of the 14th century, bringing a period of prominence and prosperity to the city.
- Our tour takes us to the **Palace of the Popes** which has been recognised in France as a historic monument since 1840, and as a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1995. The building, which is both a palace and a fortress, is one of the most extraordinary examples of Gothic architecture of the 14th century. It was built in two phases, by two popes: to the north, the more austere Palais Vieux (Old Palace) was built during the reign of Benedict XII; the Palais Neuf (New Palace), to the south, was built by his successor, Clement VI. Inside, the now-empty galleries, chambers and chapels give an apparent impression of austerity. The frescoes and handwoven tapestries in the bedrooms and the Papal study however, give a better idea of the pomp and splendour of times gone by.
- Before going back to the ship, we have some free time for a walk in the streets of the centre or for shopping.
- This excursion is not recommended for guests with mobility problems.

**MARSEILLE AND ITS HIDDEN TREASURES**
**Description**

An excursion for those who want to discover the hidden treasures and secrets of Marseille, a millennial melting pot of people and cultures, a city of indisputable charm and a distinct identity that draws visitors in with its magical atmosphere.

**What we will see**

- Cathedral of Notre Dame de la Garde and Church of Saint-Laurent
- Le Panier quarter
- Vieille Charité and Cathedral of Sainte Marie Majeure

**What we will do**



- We leave from the left-hand side of the port and begin our tour of Marseille with a visit to the **Cathedral of Notre-Dame de la Garde** which is at the highest point of the city at an altitude of 162 m above sea level, from where we can see the whole of Marseille laid out before us.
- We will then make our way to the **Church of Saint-Laurent**, a handsome example of Provençal Romanesque architecture, built in pink stone from Couronne, with splendid views of the Old Port.
- It also marks the beginning of the quarter known as **Le Panier** ("the basket"), which is one of the oldest quarters of Marseille and the old heart of the city. It owes its name to the Le Logis du Panier inn, an old establishment dating back to the 17th century. This part of the city is a typical Mediterranean port neighbourhood with the fronts of houses painted in a variety of colours and narrow winding streets. Historically a favoured haunt of sailors, it is now one of Marseille's most characteristic areas.
- Following a visit to **La Vieille Charité** originally an almshouse for the city's poor, now home to a cultural centre and a venue for temporary exhibitions we have the opportunity to try a local speciality, the navette (little boat), a traditional biscuit flavoured with orange blossoms that is baked in the shape of a boat.
- After a short break, close to La Vieille Charité, we pay a short visit to the Neo-Byzantine **Cathedral of Saint-Marie-Majeure** also known by the locals as La Major before heading back to the port.
- Places on this excursion are limited. We recommend booking early to avoid disappointment.
- The itinerary may be subject to change.
- This excursion is not recommended for guests with mobility problems.
- This excursion involves some walking. We recommend wearing appropriate footwear and comfortable clothing.

**Description**

Majestic monuments from times gone by, fascinating works by talented modern artists, and historical and cultural traditions from across Spain: the city of Barcelona holds an entire world waiting to be discovered.

**What we will see**

- Montjuïc hill
- Avenida Diagonal and Sagrada Familia
- Gothic Quarter and Cathedral
- The Poble Espanyol open-air museum

**What we will do**




- We will start our ascending **Montjuïc hill**, which towers over the city at 177 metres high and offers spectacular panoramic views.
- We will cross the city centre and head to the southern part of the city where we will travel down **Avenida Diagonal** before reaching the stunning **Sagrada Familia**. Work started on this majestic Neo-Gothic church in 1882 following the design of the great architect Antoni Gaudí and it is still under construction (tour of the exterior).
- We will explore the **Gothic Quarter** (Barrio Gótico), the medieval district scattered with the old town's most important points of interest. Most noteworthy of all is the **Cathedral**, a Catalan Gothic masterpiece built on the site of an ancient Roman basilica (tour of the exterior).
- We will end our excursion by returning to Montjuïc to visit **The Poble Espanyol open-air museum**. It was built for the 1929 Universal Exhibition to show visitors the many cultural and architectural sides to Spain, with historic recreations of over 100 places of interest across the country.

In the case that religious celebrations are taking place, the cathedral will only be visited externally. This tour is not recommended for guests with mobility problems.

**THE SAGRADA FAMILIA AND GAUDÍ'S MAGICAL SPLENDOUR**
**Description**

Barcelona is Gaudí's city: he produced some of his greatest masterpieces there which we will discover one by one and be amazed by their charm.

**What we will see**

- Sagrada Familia: Nativity façade and Passion façade, church interior, construction works
- Passeig de Gràcia
- Casa Batllò (inside visit)
- La Pedrera (photo stop)

**What we will do**

- The first stop on our excursion is the **Sagrada Familia**, the iconic symbol of the city of Barcelona, a destination for visitors from all over the world, believed by many to be one of the most extraordinary man-made monuments in the world.
- It is a majestic Neo-Gothic church inspired by the great medieval cathedrals and built in a Modernist style: the Catalan version of Art Nouveau.
- It was the work of talented architect Antoni Gaudí, who designed it at the age of just 30 and dedicated the rest of his life to completing it. Work began on the church in 1882 and is still ongoing, following the designer's plans. This will make our visit even more fascinating as **we will witness the creation** of one of the greatest architectural masterpieces in the world.
- Our guide will show us two of the façades that have already been completed: **the Nativity façade and the Passion façade**. Then we will enter the church where expert artisans are working on this constantly evolving monument.
- Then we will continue on towards **Passeig de Gràcia**, the most fashionable avenue in the city with its charming, modern buildings like **Casa Batllò**, another of skilful Gaudí's masterpieces.
- Much more than just a building, Casa Batllò holds an entire world of contemporary art, architecture and design, offering visitors a unique, surreal experience. The extravagant inventiveness of the shapes is inspired by the legend of Saint George (the patron saint of Catalonia) who fought the dragon, alluded to in the multi-coloured sinuosity of the roof, while the rows of balconies and bone-like structures symbolise the victims.
- We will end our tour admiring Casa Milà, better known as **La Pedrera** (tour of the exterior), Gaudí's last work. The building is a true triumph of curved lines with undulating faces, chimneys that coil around one another and the magnificent wrought iron railings resembling breaking waves.
- Places on this excursion are limited. We recommend booking early to avoid disappointment.
- Guests are not allowed to stay on the bus during the stops.
- The way from the parking lot to the venue of Sagrada Familia is approximately 15 minutes of walking.

- Then we will head to the **Nou Camp** stadium, home to Barcelona football club, for an exclusive tour that will take us to the areas reserved for employees: we will go from the changing rooms of great football champions to the pitch where we will tread the grass that has seen some epic finals.
- The **stadium museum** offers a historic tribute to this great club. We will be able to admire the trophies, photos, shoes and shirts belonging to Barça's great champions such as Stoychkov, Ronaldo and the "Golden Child", Diego Armando Maradona.
- Before getting back on board, we will travel along **Avenida Diagonal** and **Passeig de Gràcia** for a panoramic view of one of incredible architect Antoni Gaudí's greatest masterpieces: **Casa Batllò**.
- At the end of the tour, we will stop for a stroll in **Plaça de Catalunya** and some shopping on the **Rambla**, the city's most famous and iconic street.
- Barcelona Football Club reserves the right to modify the schedule or cancel the tour, even at the last minute.

No hassle, just pure fun. To appreciate incredible Barcelona with no fuss, there is nothing better than a coach tour with the appropriate stops at the most significant places.

### What we will see

- Barceloneta Quarter
- Christopher Columbus monument and La Rambla
- Plaza de Catalunya
- Passeig de Gracia: La Pedrera and Casa Batllò, Palau de la Música Catalana
- Sagrada Família
- Montjuic Hill and the Olympic Ring

### What we will do


- Your tour will depart from the port, for a scenic panoramic drive, passing through the **Barceloneta** Quarter or Fisherman Area.
- You will see the **Columbus Monument** and the bottom of the famous promenade of **Las Ramblas**.
- You will pass through Via Laietana, to reach **Cataluña square**, considered the heart of the city.
- From here, you will continue the panoramic drive along **Passeig de Gràcia**, the best known boulevard in town. Guides will also point you out one of the masterpieces of Gaudi's architecture: the **Palau de la Musica**, **Manzana de la Discòrdia** and **Casa Batlló**.
- Your first stop will be in **Sagrada Família**, which is said to be an icon of Barcelona. The project and supervising of the works were realized by a genius architect Antoni Gaudi (at that time was only 30 years old), who was involved in the process until his death. From the outside, guides will offer you a deep explanation of all the details related to the Temple.

- Once finished you will proceed to **Montjuic Hill** which was claimed by the city on the occasion of the **1929 International Exposition**, when the mountain was developed and trade fair halls and sports installations were constructed as well as the parks and gardens which are to be found all over the mountain.

You will pass by the **Olympic Ring** and make a brief stop at Montjuic Hill to get a panoramic view of the city before returning to the ship

Please note: The tour is mostly by coach. Space is limited, so please book early. For security reasons in case the road to Mount xxx is closed or covered with snow we will suggest an alternative viewpoint depending on the weather situation.

**GAUDÍ'S MASTERPIECES**

**Description**

Barcelona is the city where the great architect Antoni Gaudí produced his most important and famous works which today define the look of the Catalan metropolis. We will visit four of them, all of which are UNESCO World Heritage Sites.

**What we will see**

- Parc Güell
- Eixample district and Sagrada Família
- La Pedrera
- Casa Batlló
- Plaça de Catalunya and port area

**What we will do**

- The first destination on our excursion will be the highly original **Parc Güell**, designed by Gaudí at the turn of the last century and created in collaboration with his disciples.
- Entering the park, we will be plunged into a surreal, picturesque setting: fairy-tale buildings, a gigantic salamander decorated with mosaics, forests of columns and a house with spires where the artist lived for twenty years.
- We will return to the coach and a short journey will take us to **Eixample**, the district that is home to the famous **Sagrada Família** church (tour of the exterior). This gigantic work is still under construction decades later, following the plans left by the master architect. Our local guide will point out the most distinctive details of the façade, a demonstration of Gaudí's incredible creativity in its own right.
- Before continuing our tour, we will have some free time to stroll around the district and do a bit of shopping.
- Then we will continue on towards Casa Milà, better known as **La Pedrera** (literally "The Quarry"), one of Gaudí's last works and the greatest example of Catalan modernism. The building, the last civil work designed by the master architect, is a true triumph of curved lines with undulating faces, chimneys that coil around one another and the magnificent wrought iron railings resembling breaking waves.
- The next masterpiece that we will visit on our tour is **Casa Batlló**, a residential building enveloped in a surreal atmosphere. We will admire the façade and roof, covered entirely in glistening multi-coloured scales. The extravagant inventiveness of the

shapes is inspired by the legend of Saint George (the patron saint of Catalonia) who fought the dragon, alluded to in the sinuosity of the roof, while the rows of balconies and bone-like structures symbolise the victims.

- On our way back to the ship, we will pass through the commercial heart of the historic centre, the famous **Plaça de Catalunya** and the port area before bringing this magical day to a close.
- Places on this excursion are limited. We recommend booking early to avoid disappointment.

### **The best of Majorca by helicopter**

#### Description

A spectacular helicopter tour to understand the essence of Palma de Majorca and get a very special, privileged view not only of its historic monuments and luxurious districts, but also to get a panoramic view of the natural surrounding landscape of mountains and tiny, characteristic villages.

#### What we will see

- Aerial view of the city of Palma
- Gothic Cathedral of Santa Maria
- Palma Port with cruise ships
- Bellver Castle
- Area of Son Vida
- Serra de Tramontana
- Valldemossa

#### What we will do

- Our helicopter excursion begins from Son Bonet Aerodrome, the international airport in Palma de Majorca.
- As we take off, an enthralling *\*aerial view of the city of Palma* unfolds beneath us, to reveal its most important monuments, including the **Gothic cathedral of Santa Maria**, commonly known as "la Seu", famous for its rose window and its immense size. It is approximately 120 metres long, 70 m wide, and covers a surface area of 6,600 m. Its 44 metre-high vaults are some of the highest in the world and make it the second highest Gothic cathedral. The Cathedral was begun in 1230 on the site of the original main mosque and it holds the Royal Chapel, which houses the tombs of King James II and King James III. The west

wall of the cathedral was seriously damaged in an earthquake in 1851. In the 20th century, la Seu changed its appearance under the hands of the Modernist Catalan architect Antoni Gaudí, who added the altar canopy.

- We'll also get a good view of the **port of Palma** and the enormous **cruise ships**, which dock in Majorca during their Mediterranean tours.
- As we continue to fly over the area, we get a glimpse of **Belver Castle**. Originally built as a military fortress to protect the island, the castle is one of the symbols of the city and dominates the entire bay below. It is about 3 kilometres from the historic centre of Palma and over the centuries has been put to various uses. King James II built it as a royal residence. In the 19th century, it became a coin mint.
- It has a rare circular structure for a castle in Europe, three watch towers and a four-storey keep. Inside the castle is a circular parade ground on two floors and a courtyard built over a storage tank. There is a chapel on the second floor.
- Our trip continues until we are flying over the **area of Son Vida**, a luxurious residential area with golf courses, famous hotels and dream villas, as well as elegant shops and clubs where celebrities can often be spotted.
- Properties in this area can even top EUR 2 million in value.
- Our helicopter tour continues towards the spectacular geography of the landscape of **Serra de Tramontana**, which was awarded World Heritage Site status by the UN in 2011.
- Serra de Tramontana stretches for 90 km. It covers 30% of the territory of Majorca and boasts numerous peaks of over 1000 metres.
- During our return journey towards the airport of Son Bonet Aerodrome, we can admire the village of **Valldemossa** to the south. This typical, tiny village lies on the north coast and has a stupendous view over the sea. Chopin and the writer George Sand lived for a long time in this romantic corner of Spain and their house is open to visitors. At the time, George Sand wrote a book ("A Winter in Majorca") set against the background of this lovely little village and in the summer months each year it holds a festival dedicated to Chopin.
- This excursion depends strictly on the weather conditions.
- In the event of inclement weather the tour may be cancelled at short notice on safety grounds.
- The excursion is not suitable for guests with restricted mobility.
- The crew will provide information in English.
- Children aged 2 to 12 must be accompanied by an adult.

- Our tour continues on to the fabulous **beach of Portals Vells**, a small stretch of fine, white sand surrounded by pine trees on the northernmost point of the Bay of Palma.
- Here, we park our Vespas and take some time to **relax on the beach**. Those who want to can take a dip in the crystal-clear waters, or enjoy a snack at one of the numerous bars or restaurants, before we make our way back to Palma to return our scooters and rejoin the ship.
- The main rider in each pairing, i.e. the participant designated to control the scooter, must present a valid form of ID.
- The main rider has to be at least 21 years old, and have held a valid driving licence for at least 3 years.
- The passenger has to be at least 18 years old and cannot be given control of the scooter.
- A refundable deposit of 200 Euros is required for each scooter, this being paid before leaving on the excursion in order to speed up the collection process.
- Transfers to and from the port is by 8-seater minibus. A guide is not provided.

- Next, we stop to **take a photo or two at the Colosseum**, perhaps the most famous monument in Rome and an absolute must-see on our visit to the city. From there, we begin a walking tour along the **via dei Fori Imperiali**, where the ancient imperial capital seems to come back to life. This leads us to the feet of the Capitoline Hill and **Piazza Venezia**, on whose southern side towers "Il Vittoriano" the imposing monument to King Victor Emanuel II.
- At this point, we may be beginning to feel a little languorous, so what better time to take a seat for some deliciously authentic Italian cooking with **lunch at a local restaurant?**
- Suitably restored, we head back out on foot, this time focusing on the treasures of Baroque Rome: we pass the **Trevi Fountain**, with the ever-present throngs of tourists, and the Palazzo Montecitorio, a glorious example of Roman Baroque, which overlooks the piazza of the same name, and which is now the seat of the Chamber of Deputies, one of the two houses of the Italian Parliament. Finally, we reach **Piazza Navona**, with the splendid fountain designed by the great sculptor and architect Gian Lorenzo Bernini.
- Our last stop is the Vatican City, where the two semi-circles of the colonnade designed by Bernini embrace the circular piazza and frame the façade and huge dome of the magnificent St. Peter's Basilica.

**A UNIQUE POSTCARD FROM ROME**

**Description**

An excursion designed especially for passengers who have already seen Rome's most famous sites and want to discover the less-well-known face of the eternal city: first by coach, and then on foot, we explore the atmospheric, hidden corners that fill in some of the gaps in our picture of Italy's endlessly fascinating capital.

**What we will do**

- From the port of Civitavecchia, we make our way to the capital of Italy for a **sightseeing tour of Rome**, on which we visit some of the less-well-known sites in the imperious "eternal city".
- From the comfort of our coach, we see the **Baths of Caracalla** – the grandest thermal bath complex of the imperial age, not to mention one of the best-preserved in all the Empire – and the **Circus Maximus**, which was used in ancient times for various sporting spectacles but which is most famous for its chariot races.
- At the Aventine Hill, we leave the coach briefly to visit a little-known attraction, the **keyhole at the Villa del Priorato di Malta**. As we peer through a hole in the gate, we are treated to a splendid view of the dome of St. Peter's at the end of a long, tree-lined boulevard.
- Back on board the coach, we pass the **Bocca della Verità** ("Mouth of Truth") – which is now encased in the wall of the porch of the church of Santa Maria in Cosmedin – and the **Theatre of Marcellus**, whose structure resembles that of the more imposing, and more famous, Colosseum, as we make our way to the district of Trastevere.
- Here, we visit the Basilica of **Santa Maria in Trastevere**, which was probably the first official Christian place of worship to be built in Rome. The interior includes some splendid mosaics from the 12th and 13th centuries.
- Our guide then leads us on foot through the **Jewish Ghetto** which, between the years 1555 and 1870, was the only part of

Rome where Jews were permitted to live. Today, it is a popular, lively area where fascinating monuments stand side-by-side with sophisticated restaurants.

- We pass through the **Campo dei Fiori** – which hosts a local market during the day, but becomes a bustling social hub in the evening – before emerging into **Piazza Navona**, with its opulent baroque buildings and splendid fountains.
- We admire the baroque church of **Santa Maria della Pace**, and the Gothic **Santa Maria dell’Anima**, before taking some free time for lunch, which we can enjoy wherever we fancy.
- After lunch, our guided walking tour continues with a visit to the **Pantheon**, originally a temple dedicated to the Emperor Hadrian and all the Roman gods, and we visit the Basilica of **Santa Maria Sopra Minerva**, which offers a rare example of Gothic art in Rome.
- We end our walk with paying homage to the celebrated **Trevi Fountain**, where visitors gather from all over the world to throw the customary coin into the water, and the equally famous **Piazza di Spagna** with its monumental “Spanish Steps”.

- From here, we take a real **walk back in time**: the majestic Arch of Constantine and the imposing ruins of the Forum, on to *Piazza Venezia*, where the *Altare della Patria* stands, and then Capitoline Hill, Michelangelo's masterpiece, where we finally bid farewell to the Eternal City.

**THE MEDIEVAL JEWEL OF TARQUINIA AND THE MYSTERIOUS ETRUSCAN CULTURE**
**Description**

An extraordinary journey of discovery in the area around Tarquinia, where the mysterious Etruscan people lived for centuries, leaving behind artefacts of rare beauty. Tarquinia is also a fascinating medieval hamlet and we do not miss this opportunity to discover its treasures and secrets.

**What we will see**

- Historical centre of Tarquinia
- Church of *Santa Maria in Castello*
- Fortified tower of the Countess Matilda of Canossa, *Piazza delle Erbe* and the Barucci Tower

**What we will do**

- We leave the port and head for **the ancient city of Corneto, today's Tarquinia**, an architectural and historical jewel within the medieval walls of a charming hamlet that has been nicknamed the "San Gimignano" of the Latium region because of its numerous towers.
- We leave the coach and wander through the alleys and hidden corners of the historic centre to discover an unexpected and exciting world that is not only made of the particular bricks with their unmistakable colour – the colour of *macco*, a unique local building material – but also of fascinating stories, legends and anecdotes.
- Romanesque, Gothic and Neoclassical architectural styles are almost unwittingly intertwined on the façades of the palazzi and churches, including the splendid **church of *Santa Maria in Castello*** which towers in isolation on the edge of the hill.
- Evoking memories, mysteries and surprises, our walk takes us to the **Fortified Tower of the Countess Matilda of Canossa**, a jewel set in fortification walls that are well worth viewing, *Piazza delle Erbe*, dominated by the **Barucci Tower** at the foot of which the executioner carried out his grim rituals in Medieval times.
- And then we come to more alleys, coats of arms, cloisters and medieval towers: a perfect setting which evokes a time when hoards of monks beguiled rich and poor, the powerful and the destitute in their attempt to address their needs and forecast their destiny.
- Our lunch break becomes a way to continue our encounter with this magical land steeped in history. Indeed, Tarquinia is also the cradle of the Etruscan civilization and at the restaurant we are served **typical local dishes** which have been handed down from the Etruscan culinary tradition.

- We continue to be spellbound at the **Necropolis of Tarquinia**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, where we have the opportunity to see some of the most beautiful painted tombs that have made this archaeological site famous
- To complete our journey through Etruscan culture which, in many ways is still unknown, we go to the Palazzo Vitelleschi which today houses the **National Etruscan Museum**, where we can relive the fascinating world of this Tyrrhenian people by admiring the precious exhibits on display.

## ROME AND ST. PETER

### Description

This excursion retraces the main stages of the long history of Rome, the cradle of civilization and Christianity, an amazing city with immense historical, artistic and spiritual wealth.
