With stop-offs to admire the views and talks on the fauna and life in these extreme valleys, you will see the fjords close up - a powerful experience - impossible to forget.

## FLÅM BY TRAIN AND ON FOOT: THE THRILLS OF THE FJORDS AND WATERFALLS

#### In a nutshell

Snow-capped mountains, plunging ravines and fjords that will take your breath away. From the picturesque village of **Flåm** you will board the legendary **Flåm train**, on a journey past surging waterfalls and stunning landscapes, to reach **Vatnahalsen**. Then on foot, to: walk between **Blomheller** or **Berekvam**, through woods, in the pure air, surrounded by water. A return trip by train? Just to get your breath back and start dreaming all over again.

- Flåm
- Flåm Railway
- Spectacular landscapes
- Vatnahalsen
- Blomheller or Berekvam

#### The programme

- We will set off from **Flåm**, a village with 450 inhabitants that takes its name from the ancient Norwegian word *flå*, which means "plain" and refers to the flood plains of the River Flåm.

## NORTHERN EUROPE & FJORDS



- The **Flåm Railway**, or Flåmsbana, is one of the world's steepest railways: 80% of its length has a gradient of 5.5%. We will admire spectacular sights, steep mountains and thundering waterfalls as we pass through 20 tunnels, captivated by the variety of the landscapes. National Geographic has named the Flåmsbana one of the world's ten most picturesque train rides, while Lonely Planet described it as the most beautiful of all in 2014.
- On arrival at **Vatnahalsen** (Aurland Valley) station, we will begin our walk up river towards **Blomheller** (approx. 7 km) or Berekvam (approx 9 km). As we walk, we will literally be surrounded by the wonderful natural paradise of the fjords.
- As soon as we arrive in Blomheller (or Berekvam), we will board a train back to the port of Flåm.

## ON THE FLÅMSBANA: A BREATHTAKING EXPERIENCE OF NORWAY

### In a nutshell

Ready for a trip that defies gravity and the imagination? On the **Flåmsbana**, one of the world's steepest and highest railways, you will be thrilled by a dreamlike Norwegian landscape: deep fjords, mountains that seem to touch the sky, cascading waterfalls and plunging ravines. **From Flåm to Myrdal**, each bend is a thrill, each stop a stunning view. Get ready to take some memorable photos, to listen to the legend of the Huldre and enjoy an adventure that will be a lasting memory: Norway as you've never seen it before.

### Main stops

- Sightseeing train tour along the Flåmsbana: photo stops

### The programme

- All aboard! **Camera in hand**, your journey along the **Flåmsbana** begins in **Flåm**, at the foot of **Aurlandsfjord** and of **one of the world's most beautiful railroads**.
- While the train slowly climbs, you've got time to look left and right and listen to your **guide**. It might seem unbelievable, but this railroad line dating back to 1909 is among the steepest of them all: just think, the difference in altitude is 900 meters!
- Ever higher up, the **Flåm river** is now far behind and the **mountain** seems to go on forever. But it's when the forest opens out onto the view of the fjord that you'll find yourself open-mouthed. Snap out of it and listen: it's time to get out and take your **photos**.
- And this is just a taste. At the **Kjosfossen falls**, the play of water, rock and sky represents an **unmissable challenge**: capture the **perfect view** and you'll remember the power of nature in this narrow gorge forever.
- After **20 km of scenery and tunnels**, there's **Myrdal station, 876 meters above sea level**. Before heading back, listen out: think you can hear bells? As the legend has it, the **Huldre** may be nearby!
- This experience will be narrated in English.
- The length of the train ride can vary between 2 and 2 and a quarter hours, depending on the seasonal timetable.

## THE AURLAND VALLEY: NORWAY'S GRAND CANYON

#### In a nutshell

From **Flåm** to the stunning fjords, past picturesque villages and spectacular mountains, to reach the magnificent **Aurlandsdalen**, 'Norway's Grand Canyon'. Through breathtaking valleys, isolated farms and fairytale scenery, you will reach **Østerbø**, a small, age-old settlement, which in the past would be cut off in winter. Enjoy some refreshments here, before your return. Surrounded by nature that is so powerful, it will make you feel tiny and incredibly alive.

#### Main stops

- Aurland: Gothic church
- Lake and village of Vassbygda: power lines
- Laavisdal
- Valley of Stonndalen
- Valley of Aurland
- Østerbø: farm and refreshments

#### The programme

- We will start our coach tour by leaving the port at Flåm and skirting the fjords all the way to **Aurland**, a typical coastal town with a wonderful stone **Gothic church** from the 13th century, with windows painted by Norwegian artist Emanuel Vigeland.
- From Aurland we climb the river of the same name - known for its abundance of salmon - and, having passed the **Vassbygda lake**, we reach the **village** of the same name. Hydroelectric power is produced here, as you might deduct from the many **power lines**. The generators are located inside the mountain.
- The road that takes us even higher, up to **Laavisdal**, comprises hairpin bends and tunnels, giving us a magnificent view of Vassbygda and the region of Aurland.
- We climb further, to **Stonndalen**, a spectacular wide mountain valley typical of western Norway.
- Finally we will reach the **Aurland valley** which, with its breathtaking natural landscape, is known as the "Norwegian Grand Canyon" and is one of the country's most famous tourist routes. The valley,

from Geiteryggen to Vassbygdi, is roughly 40 km in length and varies between 50 and 1660 metres above sea level. Along the way, we will admire the spectacular scenery, which is rich in flora and fauna.

- We will cross the valley to **Østerbø**, a small farm that was inhabited until the end of the 1920s. During the winter, a season that could last from six to eight months in this region, the **farm** was totally cut off from the rest of the world.
- At Østerbø we will enjoy **refreshments**, before taking the same road back to Flåm.
- Places on this excursion are limited. We recommend booking early.

### FLÅM AND VOSS: A TRAIN RIDE TO SEE THE FJORDS AND WATERFALLS

#### In a nutshell

A train ride that is an experience in itself: **from Flåm to Voss**, past fjords, plunging waterfalls, lakes and wild valleys, climbing up and down past scenery that seems unreal. Here Norway is not just to look at: you will travel through it, bit by bit, from the best lookout possible.

#### Main stops

- Flåm, Kjosfossen waterfall, Myrdal
- Gravhalsen Tunnel, Raundalen valley, Lake Vangs
- Voss, the Tvinde waterfall, Oppheim lake
- Nærøy river

#### The programme

- We depart by train from the picturesque village of **Flåm**, at the tip of the Aurlandsfjord, and begin one of the most thrilling and spectacular tours of Norway. The train will slowly take us through some evocative scenery, stopping close to the marvellous **Kjosfossen waterfall** - roughly 220 metres high - and giving us chance to take some photos.

## NORTHERN EUROPE & FJORDS



- After a 45-minute trip, during which we will experience an altitude change of 800 metres, we reach the station of **Myrdal**, located on the main Oslo-Bergen line.
- At Myrdal station we will take another train, through the **Gravhalsen tunnel** and down towards the **Raundalen valley**, to Voss. Immersed in breathtaking surroundings close to **Lake Vangs**, Voss is a renowned all-year-round tourist destination. Its position and the many activities that one can enjoy (rafting, paragliding, etc.) have given it a reputation, internationally, as Norway's adventure capital.
- Leaving the train, we will continue on by coach to the **Tvinde waterfall** that drops down the side of the mountain; we will then reach the **Oppheim Lake** and we travel alongside the salmon-rich **Nærøy river**, crossing two long tunnels.
- Places on this excursion are limited. We recommend booking early.
- This excursion is not recommended for guests with mobility problems.

## STALHEIM AND UNDREDAL: THE WILDER SIDE OF NÆRØYFJORD

#### In a nutshell

Have you ever seen Norway from so close up? Experience the very heart of the **Nærøyfjord area**, between narrow fjords and mountains that defy gravity, past villages where time seems to have stood still. You will sail past **Gudvangen and Stalheim**, around breathtaking bends and past scenery that will leave a lasting impression, and on to discover the tiny authentic village of Undredal, with its goat's cheese and the smallest wooden church in all of Scandinavia. A heady mix of the real Norway, unhoned and spectacular - all for you.

#### Main stops

- Gudvangen and Nærøyfjord
- Nærøy valley and river
- Village of Stalheim and Stalheim Hotel photo break
- Undredal village

#### The programme

- We leave from the picturesque village of Flåm, at the tip of the Aurlandsfjord, and head for the other side of the mountain and the Viking village of **Gudvangen**, which is located at the tip of the **Nærøyfjord**. This fjord, roughly 17 km in length, is part of the larger Sognefjord and is considered to be the most spectacular branch of this fjord. The Nærøyfjord is also the world's narrowest fjord. At one point it measures only 250 m and is surrounded by 1800 m high mountains that loom over its tranquil waters. In 2005 it was made a UNESCO World Heritage Site along with Geirangerfjord, together with which it was also elected by National Geographic as the world's most significant natural heritage site.
- After taking a photo break, we will continue along the **Nærøy valley**, following the salmon-rich **river of the same name**, and pushing on to **Stalheim** on the side of the mountain. Between 1647 and 1909, the village of Stalheim was a resting place for travellers taking the Royal Postal Road between Copenhagen, Christiania (Oslo) and Bergen. In 1780, a road for horses and carriages was constructed and Stalheim became the resting place for postmen who would rest and change their horses after climbing the valley. From Stalheim we can enjoy a breathtaking view of the Nærøy valley and the surrounding mountain range. We will stop at the **Stalheim Hotel** to take a **photo break**.
- Before returning to Flåm, we will visit the splendid **village of Undredal**, renowned for its long tradition of producing goats cheese, both fresh and mature. Undredal has a population of 80 and boasts Scandinavia's smallest wooden church.
- Places on this excursion are limited. We recommend booking early.
- In the event of adverse weather conditions the Stalheimskleiva road may be closed. In this case the tunnel road will be used in both directions.

### THE WILDER SIDER OF NORWAY BY TRAIN AND BIKE

#### In a nutshell

From **Flåm to Myrdal**, past soaring mountains and narrow fjords, the Flåmsbana railway will take you up

to the top, and then by bike you can pedal down past remote villages and cascading waterfalls. A day where you play the leading role, in the heart of the most authentic part of Norway.

### Main stops

- Flåmsbana: the Flåm railway line to Myrdal station
- Kjosfossen waterfall: short stop
- Panoramic bike ride back to Flåm

### The programme

- The **Flåmsbana** is one of the most **spectacular** historical railways in the world: the tracks climb over four hills of different altitudes to **Myrdal**, which is 876 meters above sea level. **Your guide** will explain the history of its construction. Do they know everything? Sure - they've lived here for 15 years.
- On the ascent, the fjord will seem bottomless, and your ears will pop: the difference in altitude is 900 meters! You're so high it seems a bit like magic.
- And of course, there's a Norwegian legend associated with this place too: on the train, you will hear the story of the "**huldra**", the nymph who seduces men with her singing.
- After the darkness of the **Nåli** tunnel, the train will come to a halt, with fairytale views of the valley. Shortly afterwards, you will drop back down for an **enchanted encounter**. With whom? No spoilers!
- When you think you've already seen it all, in **Berekvam** you'll get back on your **bike** and retrace your route to Flåm from a new perspective, still in the midst of nature.
- The waterfalls are now even higher, the villages more isolated, the rocks of the fjord steeper. After a day like this, **it's impossible not to feel just a little Norwegian**.
- Wear appropriate clothing for the trail, without forgetting a windproof jacket and sports shoes, ideally waterproof.
- Helmets and bicycles are provided by the local agency.

- Following the itinerary along the **Borgundfjord**, we go past **modern districts** and the **old commercial centre**.
- Then we will really venture into the past with a visit to the **Sunnmøre Museum**, an open-air museum located in a fascinating setting, home to 30 original **ancient houses** from different parts of the country. The museum reproduces traditional local scenes, and houses a **craft collection**, allowing us to retrace the history, traditions and customs of this seafaring culture. For nautical enthusiasts, there is also a collection of around 40 ancient boats, including reconstructions of Viking ships and a merchant vessel dating back to approximately 1000 AD.

Get ready for a real **sea safari** off the coast of **Ålesund**! On board a rigid inflatable boat (RIB), you will be able to admire amazing landscapes and spot **marine birds** and **seals** in their natural habitat. A thrilling experience, against the backdrop of the sea, wind and a wild nature!

### The programme

- After donning our life jackets and listening to some safety information, we will leave the port on a rigid inflatable boat (RIB) to fully enjoy the waters off the **coast of Ålesund**.
- If the weather is good and it is not very windy, we can visit **Runde Island**, famous for the huge number of **birds** there. Situated 67 km south-west of Ålesund and connected to the mainland via a bridge, the island is home to over half a million seabirds of 230 different species, including 100,000 puffins and 50,000 pairs of kittiwakes, as well as colonies of gannets, petrels, razorbills and guillemots which nest there.
- In the event of less favourable conditions, we will stay in the sheltered waters of Ålesund. There are also many birds here and, with a bit of luck, we may even get to catch a glimpse of an eagle ray.
- Our guide will help us to spot some interesting examples of the **local fauna** and will take us near a rock where we can watch the **seals** basking in the sun.
- A maximum of 12 guests per departure is permitted.
- You must be physically fit to take part in this excursion and not suffer from back pain.

### **In a nutshell**

Discover **Ålesund**, the Norwegian town built on islands jutting out into the Atlantic ocean, surrounded by stunning mountains. Rebuilt after a devastating fire in 1904 in an **Art Nouveau** style, Ålesund is a true gem, elegant and easy to visit on foot. With vintage museums, viking statues, the **Park at the foot of Mount Aksla** and breathtaking views, the tour gives you a change to explore the history, architecture and seafaring traditions of a unique town.

### **Main stops**

- Art Nouveau Centre
- Art Nouveau in town
- Park at the foot of Mount Aksla: commemorative stone to William II and the statue of the Viking warrior "Gange-Rolv"

### **The programme**

- Let's discover Ålesund, the largest town on the north-west coast of Norway, built on islands extending into the ocean which stand out against the splendid backdrop of impressive mountain peaks..
- A large part of the town was destroyed by the fire of 1904. It was rebuilt in the typical Art Nouveau style of the first decade of the twentieth century .
- It was the German Emperor William II, a great friend of the Norwegian kings, who used to spend his holidays in district of Sunnmøre, to send four ships laden with help for the town. The central nucleus was rebuilt in bricks and stone to restrict any further fires.
- Today, Ålesund has a population of about 66,000, although the town centre is relatively small and is easy to visit on foot.
- Our tour begins with a visit to the **Art Nouveau Centre**, a museum in one of the most beautifully decorated buildings in this style: it used to be a pharmacy and inside it still houses the vintage containers of herbs and medicines on its shelves.
- The three-storey museum provides an interesting overview of the history of Ålesund, of the fire in 1904 and of the creative period in the Art Nouveau style.
- During our journey, we will be told of the importance of the fishmongers in Norway's largest port for

the export of fish. We will have the opportunity of seeing various examples of the **Art Nouveau style of the town's architecture**, which has made Ålesund famous as one of the last three Art Nouveau towns in Europe.,

- Our excursion continues to climb up to the small **park at the foot of Mount Aksla**.
- We will see numerous **plants** in the park as well as a commemorative stone dedicated to the emperor William II for the help he gave to the town after the fire of 1904. Here stands the **statue of the Viking warrior Hange-Rolv** who sailed from Ålesund to today's Normandy, the name of which comes from the Norwegian conquerors.
- We can walk round the park and take a break before returning to the quayside and to our ship.
- Guests must be able to walk for approximately 3 km on steep, asphalted and cobbled terrain.

- Before returning on-board, we will visit the **Ålesund Aquarium**, one of the most characteristic in Europe. Large salted water pools are lined up along the coast, providing us with the opportunity to get to know the underwater world of the northern Atlantic. Through a transparent 18 metre panel, we can see the sea life within the largest of the pools, which holds 4 million litres of water.
- On the return journey, we can admire some elegant details of the Art Nouveau architecture before heading to the suburbs with the fascinating wood villas and the well-kept gardens.

#### The programme

- We will skirt the port of **Stavanger** by coach. Heart of the Norwegian oil industry, Stavanger is the country's fourth largest city in terms of population and is located at the entrance to the Gandsfjord, sheltered from the North Sea.
- We will then continue by coach to the **Preikestolen Refuge**.
- From there, we will walk along a rocky mountain path to admire the stunning views dotted with

small lakes. This area, which is home to a substantial population of ptarmigan, is well-known to local hunters and fishermen.

- Continuing our walking tour, we will reach the **Preikestolen (the "pulpit"rock)**, a flat rock that overlooks the Lysefjord from a height of 604 metres above sea level. From here, we can enjoy beautiful views of the surrounding mountains.
- After our visit, we will return along the same path to the Preikestolen Refuge, where our coach will be waiting to take us back to Stavanger.
- The Preikestolen area is not secure. We therefore recommend you move with caution and keep a safe distance from the cliff edge.
- The experience takes place on an uneven mountain track that also has steep sections. Accordingly, for your own safety, it is important to wear walking shoes. If you do not have any with you, they can be rented on site.
- We recommend you wear a waterproof windbreaker over your clothes.
- This outdoor excursion will take place in all weathers, with the exception of snow.
- The walk covers a distance of approximately 8 km with a difference in height of approximately 340 metres from start to finish and is only recommended for guests accustomed to walking on rough paths.

Ullandhaug also boasts breath-taking views of the **Hafrsfjord** where, in 872, the Viking king Harald Fairhair defeated the last of the local princes and unified 29 small kingdoms under one crown, founding the Kingdom of Norway. To the east stretches the fertile **landscape of Jæren**, with the **Ryfylke Mountains** in the distance.
- We will then continue to the outskirts of Stavanger to admire the **Sverd i fjell ("Swords in Rock")**, a fascinating memorial by the sculptor Fritz Røed. The monument depicts three 10 metre-high swords that commemorate the historic battle of Hafrsfjord. The largest sword represents the victorious Harald, while the smaller ones symbolise the vanquished kings. The monument is also intended to symbolise peace, as the swords are struck in solid rock, from which they can never be removed.
- We will now pass through both the older and more modern districts of Stavanger; we will admire the outside of the **Cathedral**, built in around 1125 by Bishop Reinald of Winchester with the help of British craftsmen. Of all the churches built in Norway during the Middle Ages, Stavanger Cathedral is the only one that still retains its original features.
- Before returning to the ship, we will treat ourselves to a walk through "Old Stavanger", with its typical narrow streets lined with picturesque wooden houses that date back to the 18th and 19th centuries, a time when it was home to sailors, craftsmen and merchants. This unique area, located just a few minutes from the port, is now at the centre of the city's most ambitious redevelopment project.
- Places on this excursion are limited. We recommend booking early.
- The Cathedral is currently under renovation, so the visit will be from outside.

## **KIEL AND LABOE: CANALS, SAILORS AND SUBMARINES – the tour ends at the airport**

You'll set off from the port, to discover the maritime heart of **Kiel**, its grand **Town Hall** and the immense **Canal**, winding its way between two seas and centuries of history. You'll then head to **Laboe** and visit the **Naval Memorial**, climbing to the top of the tower overlooking the Kiel firth. Afterwards, you'll head down to the beach and **climb on board the U995 submarine**: cramped spaces, war-time technology and life on board all depict an intense history. A powerful finale, made up of memories, steel and the sea, before heading back to Hamburg.

- Laboe: Naval Memorial to the Sailors who died in battle and exhibition inside, U995 submarine with museum

#### **The programme**

- We leave the port to start our panoramic tour of the city of **Kiel**. The capital of the Federal State of Schleswig-Holstein boasts a long tradition as a maritime city and port, which pervades daily life.
- Our route winds past the **main points of interest** in the city, including the **City Hall** and the spectacular **Kiel Canal**, which links the North Sea to the Baltic Sea.
- At the end of our city tour, our coach will take us to the eastern shore of the Kiel Fjord to the town of **Laboe**, where we visit the **Memorial to the Sailors who were killed in battle**. The tower was first erected to commemorate the soldiers of the German Navy who died in the First World War. Later, it was also dedicated to the sailors who died in the Second World War. In 1954, it became a memorial to all the fallen from the Navies of all nationalities.
- After an interesting visit to the **exhibition inside the monument**, we climb to the top of the building to enjoy the **spectacular view** that unfolds before us.

- Our visit to the memorial is over and we set off by coach for Hamburg airport.

- This fantastic tour will give us the opportunity to discover the vibrant city of Hamburg, the second largest metropolis in Germany after the capital, Berlin.
- Our panoramic tour winds its way past the main points of interest in the city. First of all, our route runs alongside the **Lake formed by the River Alster** in the city centre, and then crosses the residential districts and the **Jungfernstieg**, the famous fashion street, lined with luxury boutiques and shopping malls.
- We drive past the **Renaissance buildings of the City Hall and Stock Exchange** and venture into the **more modern part of the city**, with its parks and gardens, the television tower, 19th century buildings and much more.

Of particular interest are also numerous 15th- and 16th-century patrician residences and salt storehouses.

Pass by the **Buddenbrook House**, the former home of the Lubeck-born authors Heinrich and Thomas Mann.

Another highlight is the unique Marzipan-exhibition in the trademark **Café Niederegger**.

Enjoy your **free time** for having a lunch break and for exploring the narrow, cobble-stoned streets and the variety of small and elegant shops.

### PRACTICAL GUIDE TO EXCURSIONS

#### Excursion Booking

You can book excursions before departure by visiting the website [www.mycosta.com](http://www.mycosta.com), or by requesting to be contacted by our "Excursion Service" at +34 932952144 or through a request on the MyCosta website. Once on board, excursions can be booked through the Costa App, the Excursion Totem, or by visiting the MyTours office, where our staff will be available to offer advice and assistance.

#### Participation

Some excursions require a minimum number of bookings and have a maximum number of participants, so it is advisable to book them in advance.

#### Duration

The duration of the excursions is indicated in the description of each tour. Due to unforeseen circumstances, such as adverse weather conditions and/or transport delays, the duration may be subject to change. The program of individual excursions may also be modified for the reasons mentioned above. Please adhere to the times indicated by the guides at each stop (rest stops, photo stops, etc.).

#### Description

The descriptions of the excursions are up-to-date as of the printing of this document. However, in the interest of continuously improving our guests' shore experiences, the actual program may differ from the description.

#### Guests with Mobility Issues

If you use a wheelchair, it is necessary to check the availability of suitable/compatible excursions before booking by contacting our "Excursion Service" at +34 932952144 or through a request on the MyCosta website. Once on board, it is recommended to visit the MyTours office on the first day of the cruise for further assistance.

#### Customized Programs

Personalized and exclusive tours can be arranged upon request and subject to quotation by contacting our "Excursion Service" or on the day of embarkation by visiting the MyTours office.

#### Prices

The prices of the excursions include transport where specified, which may include buses, minibuses, taxis, cable cars, and boats. Meals and/or drinks are included only where specified. Prices and excursion programs may be subject to change.

#### Children and kids

Children aged 3 to 13 are entitled to a 30% discount on all excursions. Children under 3 years old participate for free.

#### Squok Club

For children aged 3 to 13, there is the possibility to enjoy the Squok Club while their parents are on an excursion. The service is free, and the request must be made in advance.

#### Tickets

All excursions will be registered on the Costa card: the Costa card becomes the excursion ticket. In the Costa App, under the MyAgenda section, you will find all the information about shore experiences. If necessary, the staff at the MyTours office can print a summary of the bookings.
