Kristiansand **A WALK THROUGH KRISTIANSAND**

In a nutshell

Being the business centre of Southern Norway, Kristiansand has a long and fascinating history. This guided walking tour is the ideal way to discover Kristiansand's past and its most interesting corners.

Main stops

- Excursion on foot with a guide
- Kristiansand, fish market, cathedral, market square, Posebyen, old town district

The programme

- Our **guided walk** begins at the pier and we soon reach the **fish market**, where we can look around the stalls with various local seafood specialities.
- Proceeding in our tour we go past the **cathedral** and the **market square**.
- The oldest part of the city has a grid plan with streets at right angles, known in Norwegian as the **Kvadraturen**. Part of this area called **Posebyen** constitutes the longest continuous lines of low, wooden houses in Northern Europe.
- The guide tells us all about the big fire that destroyed half of the city's houses and how the locals managed to make small specialty boutiques and cafes flourish in this part of the **old borough**.
- We recommend that you book early because only a limited number of places are available.
- This excursion is not recommended for guests with mobility problems.
- Comfortable shoes are recommended.

LINDESNES LIGHTHOUSE AND NORWAY'S SOUTH CAPE

In a nutshell

An excursion to the lighthouse at Lindesnes, the southernmost point of the Scandinavian Peninsula, which is now a museum: a charming and evocative place surrounded by a spectacular landscape.

Main stops

- Excursion by coach
- Lindesnes lighthouse, museum, guided tour, South Cape of the Scandinavian Peninsula, free time, tea and a muffin
- Coast road, Panoramic views
- Høllen, photo stop

The programme

- Built in 1655, **Lindesnes** is Norway's oldest lighthouse. It is located at the southernmost point of the Scandinavian Peninsula, 2518 km from North Cape. The **lighthouse** has been designated a national lighthouse museum, and hosts various exhibitions related to the history and development of lighthouses and maritime culture. The view from the top of the lighthouse over the coastal landscape is simply spectacular.
- Upon arrival at the lighthouse we are greeted by the lighthouse keeper who shows us a film about

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the history of the building. A guide then accompanies us in a **tour of the museum** after which we have some **free time** and those who wish can climb the stairs to the top of the lighthouse. Alternatively we can sit and enjoy the spectacular view of the waves breaking on the rocks below us.

- Before boarding our coach again we are served a home baked **Lighthouse Muffin**, together with a cup of tea or coffee.
- Our return journey to Kristiansand follows a different route from the way we came, going along the **coast road**, where there are idyllic summer houses and **panoramic views** that are typical of southern Norway.
- When we arrive in **Høllen**, a small suburb of Kristiansand, we have a short **photo stop** before continuing along the scenic North Sea Road back to the ship.
- We recommend that you book early because only a limited number of places are available.
- The film at the lighthouse will be shown in English with German subtitles.
- This excursion is purely scenic and involves long coach journeys.
- It is possible to reach the top of the lighthouse by climbing a staircase with 100 steps, we recommend you wear comfortable shoes. *This excursion is not recommended for guests with mobility problems or wheelchair users.

Kristiansand THE BEST OF KRISTIANSAND

In a nutshell

A complete tour to discover the most significant sights of Kristiansand, the fifth largest city in Norway located on the southern coast: from the open-air folk museum of Vest Agder and the oldest part of the city centre featuring a cathedral, market and high street to the Christiansholm fortress and the modern Kilden theatre. A perfect occasion to get to know this marvellous city and its most charming corners in an exceptional combination of ancient and modern features.

Main stops

- Vest Agder open-air folk museum

- Posebyen, the oldest part of the city, and Kvadraturen
- Kristiansand Cathedral
- Torvet market
- Walk along the Markens Gate high street
- Christiansholm fortress with views over the port and sea
- Stop at the local fish market

The programme

- We start our tour of Kristiansand on a coach headed to the **Vest Agder open-air folk museum** inaugurated in 1903 and located approximately 4 km from the city centre. Here, we have the opportunity to go on a journey through the history of the region among ancient wooden houses, farms and perfectly recreated scenes of everyday life. The museum, in fact, displays 30 buildings rebuilt in the Colonial style and is divided into sections reproducing the various districts of the city.
- After visiting the museum, we get back on the coach for a **panoramic tour of the suburbs** and finally the **city centre**.
- Kristiansand, with approximately 117.000 inhabitants, is the fifth largest city in Norway and was founded in 1641 by Christian IV. Located on the southern coast, it is considered the Norwegian holiday destination par excellence: it is in fact one of the Norwegians' favourite holiday destinations thanks to its picturesque coast and is also a major access road to the villages along the southern coast and the inland Setesdal area.
- We get off the coach in **Posebyen**, the **oldest part of the city** made up of characteristic right-angle alleyways forming the so-called **Kvadraturen**, i.e. quadrilateral and low wooden houses. The name **Posebyen** derives from the French **Reposer** meaning to rest: at the time, in fact, French was the language used by the soldiers who used to live there. The district has preserved its characteristic Renaissance square layout.
- We continue discovering the centre on foot and stop at the **Kristiansand Cathedral** for a guided tour. The cathedral is an imposing building in the **Gothic style** built in 1880 and is the city's main place of worship.
- Our next stop is the busy **Torvet fruit and vegetable market** with local producers also selling flowers, plants and honey.
- We continue discovering the city with a stroll along **Markens Gate**, the city's **high street** where we can find shops of all kinds.
- We then reach the beach and **Christiansholm fortress**, erected between 1662 and 1672 to protect the coast against the pirates and the attacks from the Swedish. The building, which is stocky and circular, is made up of a closed bastion with 8 sealed bronze cannons. The top offers **spectacular views overlooking the port and the sea**.

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- After the fortress, another interesting stop awaits us: the **local fish market** with its lively **restaurants**, pleasant canals and countless **stalls** where we can also witness how salmon is smoked.
- Before returning to the ship, we **drive past the Kilden theatre and concert hall**, the city's new architectural symbol and an ultramodern example of design and technology that can seat up to 2,600 people.
- There is limited availability of Italian speaking guides; if none are available, the excursion will be conducted in English.

KRISTIANSAND SURROUNDINGS AND RAVNEDALEN NATURE PARK

In a nutshell

Main stops

- Posebyen, the oldest part of the city, and Kvadraturen
- Village of Søgne and ancient wooden parish church
- Stop for photos at the Høllen fishing village
- Return to Kristiansand along the North Sea panoramic road
- Ravnedalen Nature Park

The programme

- We start our tour of Kristiansand by leaving the port on a coach and driving through the famous **Posebyen**, the **oldest part of the city made up of characteristic right-angle alleyways forming the so-called Kvadraturen***, i.e. **Quadrilateral** and low wooden houses. The name **Posebyen** derives from the French **Reposer**, meaning to rest: at the time, in fact, French was the language used by the soldiers who used to live there. The district has preserved its characteristic Renaissance square layout.
- After driving along a panoramic road as well as the motorway, we reach the **picturesque village of Søgne** located in the Vest-Agder county and head towards the **ancient parish church** completed in around 1640 and mainly made of **wood**.
- We then move on to the **fishing village of Høllen** on the estuary of the river Søgneelva where we **stop to take photos** and capture the amazing coastal scenery made up of a myriad of islands.

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- We get back on our coach to **return to Kristiansand** on the marvellous **panoramic road stretching along the North Sea** and providing spectacular views of the typical Norwegian fjords, rivers and lakes.
- Once in Kristiansand, the last stop on our tour awaits us: a **guided tour of the Ravnedalen Nature Park** located north-west of the city and established between 1874 and 1878 by General Oscar Wergeland. This park was originally a swamp and boasts various panoramic views, lakes, expanses of green and a large variety of flowers and plants and is also one of the most popular in Kristiansand.
- After our guided tour and before returning to the ship, we have some time for a **stop at Café Generalen** inside the park where we are served coffee and waffles.
- There is limited availability of Italian speaking guides; if none are available, the excursion will be conducted in English.

Kristiansand **HØLLEN, SØGNE AND OPEN-AIR MUSEUM**

In a nutshell

The environs of Kristiansand are full of surprises and secrets, all to be discovered: ancient churches, picturesque hamlets, museums and coastal landscapes, which are there for the taking.

Main stops

- Coach trip
- Centre of Kristiansand, fortress of Christiansholm, harbour, church of Oddernes
- Vest Agder Open Air Museum, Søgne, church of Søgne, Høllen

The programme

- We will board our **coach** and immediately head to the **centre of Kristiansand**, in the direction of the various areas to appreciate the city's architecture, with the ancient wood houses, typical of the area and those boasting a more modern design.
- Continuing on, we will discover the **fortress of Christiansholm** surrounded by a splendid park, the **harbour** and the **church of Oddernes**, one of the oldest, dedicated to the Patron Saint, Olaf who introduced Christianity into Norway.

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- We will then visit the **Vest Agder Open-Air Museum**, where we will have the opportunity to delve into this region's past with the ancient dwellings and a glimpse into everyday life.
- On the way to **Søgne**, it will then be possible to admire the myriad of small islands which encircle the coast. Once we get to the city, we will visit the **church**, which was recently freshened up according to both a Renaissance and Baroque style, to then make a final stop in the village of **Høllen** where we will take a stroll.
- We will then return to Kristiansand, where we will be surrounded by an idyllic landscape, a place where many Norwegian families spent their summer holidays.
- We recommend that you book early because only a limited number of places are available.
- When one of the churches is being used for religious ceremonies, our tour will be limited to the exterior of the building.

Kristiansand **DISCOVERING LILLESAND**

In a nutshell

Allow ourselves to be carried away with the beauty of the eastern coast of Kristiansand: a boat tour exposing us to a landscape littered with islands, islets and reefs, stopping at the picturesque town of Lillesand.

Main stops

- Boat tour
- Eastern coast of Kristiansand, Blindleia canal, Lillesand

The programme

- Kristiansand, with approximately 73,000 inhabitants, is located on the southern coast and it is a favourite holiday destination amongst the Norwegians with its typical towns and picturesque coastline.
- Against this background, on the **eastern coast of Kristiansand** an internal canal has formed, **Blindleia**, which we will cross by **boat** along with three hundred other small vessels, which navigate

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here protected from the open sea.

- The coastline is characterised by white wood houses, originally built by local fishermen and sailors but which now belong to city dwellers who use them as holiday homes.
- We will then board our bus and head to **Lillesand**, a city with approximately 9 thousand inhabitants, where we will have some free time to explore the small roads brimming with typical shops, restaurants and art exhibitions before returning to Kristiansand.
- We recommend that you book early because only a limited number of places are available.
- This tour is not recommended for guests who suffer from sea sickness and those who have mobility problems.
- The itinerary may be subject to change.
- The boat has seats inside and outside; in the event of inclement weather, you are advised to bring a raincoat and wear appropriate clothing.

DISCOVERY OF KRISTIANSAND SURROUNDINGS BY BUS AND STEAMBOAT

In a nutshell

Norway is primarily known for its fjords, the stretches of sea which weave into the coast, even across a few kilometres and which are often spectacular. We will be able to discover them on board a picturesque steamboat as part of this excursion which will also allow us to visit the Setesdal Open-Air Museum.

- Coach and steamboat trip
- Setesdalen valleys, Bygland fjord, village of Bygland
- Setesdals Museum, guided tour

The programme

We explore Mont Saint-Michel, a 'wonder of the West' and masterpiece of medieval religious architecture, as well as an exceptional vantage point for admiring the spectacle of the tides which have the biggest height difference in the whole of France.

Main stops

- Mont Saint-Michel
- Porte de Bavole, Grand Rue and village
- Walls and Benedictine abbey

The programme

- On this excursion we spend the whole day at **Mont Saint-Michel**, a rocky island surrounded by a magnificent bay known as the 'wonder of the West' and a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1979. Visits to the island are spectacular at any time of year thanks to its configuration, the rich history of the abbey and the beauty of its architecture. The little island, with a circumference of around 1 km, reaches a height of 80 metres and is connected to the bay via a paved road built in 1879 which is submerged at high tide. The area is known for its alternating tides, causing changes to the sandbars that surround the mount. Here the movement of the tides is the highest in the whole of France and the difference between high and low tide can be over 12 metres.
- We will begin our visit at the fortified entrance, the **Porte de Bavole** built by Gabriel du Puy in 1590, and continue along the **Grand Rue**, a steep road that comes to life in the summer with souvenir shops and restaurants and crosses the picturesque village towards the abbey, church and cloister.
- We will also visit the **walls** along a route that offers enchanting views of the bay and the abbey gardens.

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- We arrive at the **Abbey** which dates back to the 8th century when the Archangel Michael appeared to Aubert, bishop of Avranches, telling him to build a church on the rock. The bishop founded an oratory on the island, then known as Mont Tombe. In the Carolingian period the oratory was replaced by an abbey and from that time until the 16th century, magnificent Romanesque and Gothic buildings were constructed. The abbey was well fortified and never conquered; having been used as a prison during the French Revolution and the Second Empire, in 1874 it was declared a Historic Monument and opened to the public all year round.
- Before returning to the port we will have free time to shop for souvenirs (with a wide range of copper, ceramic and porcelain objects to choose from) and local produce (such as butter biscuits and other typical products of Normandy). We can enjoy the atmosphere of this medieval village whose inhabitants carry on the island's traditions, continuing to make products for the delight of visitors and pilgrims coming to this unique site, just as they did over a thousand years ago.

- We will then travel to Arromanches 360°. Located on the cliffs of Arromanches, the Circular Cinema dominates the remains of one of Mulberry's two man-made ports set up by the Allies. The remains of the artificial port are still visible today from the panoramic point of view of the Cinema. A 20-minute film, produced by the authors of the very successful television series French Apocalypse, will be screened in High Definition on 9 screens and will tell the terrible battle of Normandy.
- The **beach of Arromanches** was the center of events where the remains of the floating port where thousands of Allied soldiers embarked are still visible.
- After lunch, stop for a photo at historic Omaha Beach, infamous as 'Bloody Omaha' due to heavy losses suffered by American troops.
- At the top of the hill overlooking the beach we will visit the **American cemetery of Colleville-sur-Mer** where, on a green English lawn full of perfectly aligned and immaculate white crosses, 10,000 American soldiers are buried. The emotion is almost palpable.
- The last stop will be **Pointe du Hoc**, which was heavily fortified by the Germans to serve as an observation point. During D-Day, American troops climbed the cliffs with rope ladders.

In the various rooms we can admire reproductions of some of **Monet's artworks** and his collection of **Japanese prints** (18th and 19th century).
- We will then move on to the exterior of the house, where together with a guide we visit the picturesque '**water gardens**' with their weeping willows and the famous Japanese bridge in a riot of wisteria, azaleas and rhododendrons, ending with the famous water lily pond that so inspired the French painter's works.
- The last stop on our tour is in **Rouen**, the city where Joan of Arc was burnt at the stake. Accompanied by our guide, we will stroll along the narrow streets of the **old town** with over seven hundred houses, large and small, built in typical style from wood and timber, characteristic examples of medieval architectural techniques.
- Finally, we visit **Rouen Cathedral** (13th-16th century), considered to be one of the greatest examples of French Gothic art.

The programme

- We leave the port by coach and set off towards **Santiago de Compostela**, one of the most famous and popular religious centres of Christianity and a pilgrimage destination since the Middle Ages.
- Santiago, situated on a hill, is a town that emanates history, with the narrow streets of the old town, quiet porticoes and many small squares; it boasts many beautiful and important monuments and is home to an ancient university and seat of an archbishopric.
- We begin our tour of the city's most interesting attractions on foot, starting from **Plaza del Obradoiro**, the main square of the old town where the magnificent Cathedral is located.
- We enter the maze of Medieval streets and we come to the **old Fonseca University**, we then proceed to **Plaza de las Platerías**, the square to the south of the Cathedral, which owes its name to the silversmiths' workshops (*platerías* means silversmiths in Spanish) which occupied the ground floor porticoes of the cloister in Medieval times and which have now been replaced by souvenir shops. The square is dominated by the only remaining Romanesque façade of the Cathedral.
- We then walk to **Plaza de la Quintana**, dominated by the east façade of the Cathedral. This square, the second largest in the historic centre of the city, is the ideal place to sit at one of the tables of the many bars and restaurants, the so-called *terrazas* and have a drink or enjoy one of the many free concerts or performances.
- We then proceed to the **Monastery of San Pelayo**, a lateral wall of which runs alongside Plaza de la Quintana, and then on to **Plaza Azabachería**, where we admire the Neoclassical Baroque north façade of the Cathedral which features a statue of St. James as a pilgrim.
- Our walk then takes us in front of the **Monastery of San Martín Pinaro**, the second largest religious building in Santiago after the Cathedral. The highlight of the excursion is the visit to the magnificent **Cathedral**, one of the most important Catholic sanctuaries and the burial place of the Apostle Saint James the Greater, patron saint of Spain and Christian martyr.
- After stopping for **Tapas lunch at the Hostal de los Reyes Católicos**, we set off by coach towards Vigo.

- Our first stop is the **Hermitage of La Lanzada**, located at a peninsula next to the biggest beach of Galicia. Before the hermitage was built seems that a little fortress was here in combination with other defensive points against the invasions of Vikings and Normans. Also from here we can get a great view of all the landscape of the region and also a view of the Atlantic Islands of Galicia National Park.
- When we arrive in the village of **Cambados**, we can admire its typical picturesque characteristics. The town is dominated by stone buildings, which exude ancestral sturdiness, and is home to one of the most important noble palace complexes of Galicia. The historic centre was declared to be a Heritage of Cultural Interest by the Spanish Ministry of Culture.
- We then take the coach to the renowned '**Agro de Bazán' Wine Cellar**, which, exploiting the fine Albariño grape, produces excellent white wine, sold in particularly original bottles. Accompanied by our guide, we visit the premises where the wine making and bottling processes take place. At the end of our visit we enjoy a **snack**, a fitting conclusion to our excursion, to appreciate the aroma and

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flavour of **typical local cheeses and wines**.

- Places on this excursion are limited. We recommend booking early.
- The Agro de Bazan winery may be closed on Sundays and holidays. On those dates, an alternative winery of equal quality will be chosen.

MEDIEVAL IMPRESSIONS: VIGO AND THE ANCIENT VILLAGE OF BAIONA

In a nutshell

Galicia and its delightful towns boast Medieval charm, the fruit of a thousand years of history and the scent of the ocean.

Main stops

- Monte del Castro or Mount la Guia (panoramic)
- Baiona
- Panoramic Vigo
- Parador Monterreal

The programme

- After leaving the port by coach we head for the **Monte del Castro or Mount La Guia**. From here we can admire the **panorama of the city of Vigo**, the bay and the port.
- Back on our coach we proceed along the coast road in the direction of **Baiona**, one of the major and most characteristic fishing villages on the Galician coast. Its historic centre, with its quaint narrow streets and neat stone and granite houses, cobbled streets and the views from the ramparts with a sheer drop above the sea, exudes an atmosphere of orderly tradition and a sense of pleasant intimacy.
- It was right here, on 1st March 1493, that one of the caravels of the Columbus expedition, the 'Pinta', having crossed back over the Atlantic Ocean, docked on its return to Europe with the news of the discovery of the 'New World'. Today a replica of the Pinta is berthed in the very same port.

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- After our stroll around the historic centre, we visit the **Parador Monterreal**, an imposing 16th century palace, built in the style of a Galician manor house within the walls of a Medieval fortress. Today it houses a splendid hotel, whose centrepiece is the magnificent stone staircase which leads from the entrance to the floor above. - We move on towards **O Grove**, a seaside town located on the estuary of the Arousa river. We get on a boat and enjoy a cruise along the estuary to admire the rugged coast where the steep rocks alternate with vast beaches and numerous ports dotted with picturesque and colourful boats.
- We then reach the **Bateas**, a floating wooden platform used to farm mussels and other shellfish. The guide illustrates this curious activity that is one of the cornerstones of local agriculture. They are, in fact, so popular that a special festivity is dedicated to it * in October, O Grove celebrates the seafood festival, which was declared one of national tourist interest.

- Historic centre of Alicante: Calle Labradores and Rambla de Méndez Núñez

The programme

- We will leave the port heading towards the centre of Alicante to begin our exploration of the city with a **sightseeing tour**. Founded by the Romans and located at the heart of the Mediterranean, Alicante is a popular and lively place. It was the first Spanish city to be connected to Madrid via train in 1851, subsequently, it became the capital's main maritime port.

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- Accompanied by a guide, who will present the city's history, our journey takes us to **Plaza de Toros**, which puts on various types of bullfights, concerts and shows, and **Mercado Central**, which sells local fresh produce and souvenirs within a happy, buzzing setting.
- We will admire the magnificent **Santa Barbara Castle**, one of the largest across the entire area of the Mediterranean in terms of surface area and number of buildings. Standing on Mount Benacantil, taking up most of the slope, from above, it dominates the city with the 180 metre rocky buttress which looks out to the sea. We will continue our journey across **Alicante's historic centre**, which leads us to **Calle Labradores** and **Rambla de Méndez Núñez**, built along the route of ancient defence walls and where presently the city's night-life is focused.
- We will arrive at **Explanada de España**, a long promenade which runs along the sea, covered by over six and a half million 'azulejos' (marble tile mosaics) in red, white and black, arranged to form a wave pattern, which represents one of Alicante's most characteristic images.
- In the shade of the palm trees which flank Explanada, we will pass the usually busy stalls, going from the **beach of Postiguet**, located to the north of Explanada, and the **Parque de Canalejas**, with its fish market, which presently is the best exhibition hall in Alicante, located on the other side.
- At Explanada, we will stop to **taste the famous 'horchata de chufa'**, a refreshing drink typical of this region, prepared using water, sugar and sweet almond milk.
- After this refreshing break, there will be some **free time to stroll** as we desire before returning to the boat.
- We recommend that you book early because only a limited number of places are available.

- The walk ends at **Plaza San Gregorio**, the nerve centre of the small village, where a monument dedicated to the Saint stands and from where you can enjoy a spectacular view of Lake Guadalest.
- Before returning to the coach which will take us to the ship, we will have some **free time** to freely visit shops, cafes and the numerous local museums where we can discover many facts on this magical region.
- We recommend that you book early because only a limited number of places are available.

The monumental and striking main façade is considered a Spanish Baroque masterpiece.
- We will have the opportunity to visit the **church of San Juan de Dios**, which is near to the cathedral. Built in the area where the ancient Muslim fortress once stood, some remains of which can still be seen, it is formed of six connected chapels and is topped by a splendidly decorated dome.

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- The adjacent **Museum of the Church of San Juan de Dios**, one of the buildings belonging to the museum of Bellas Artes de Murcia (MUBAM), houses a large collection of religious images dating back to the 19th and 20th Centuries.
- We will walk through the historic centre to look at the city's major monuments, beginning with **Plaza Cardenal Belluga**, where we can admire the **City Hall and Episcopal Palace** with its Rococo façade and the beautiful courtyard, the city's authentic architectural gems.
- We will head to **Calle Trajería**, one of the most characteristic and exclusive streets in Murcia, where the first stores selling imported clothing opened, and we can admire the **historic casino** building (external view).
- We can take advantage of our **free time** to browse in the shops and do a little shopping, walk along the old city's charming streets or have lunch in one of the centre's typical restaurants.

- We have lunch in a **typical restaurant** where we can savour **a few Iberian specialities** including *patatas bravas*, *ensaladilla rusa*, *corquetas*, *buñuelos* and *pulpo*... All these traditional delicacies cater to our palate's every whim and perfect to nibble and share *para compartir* just the way the Spaniards do!
- After refuelling, we continue towards **Casa Vicens**, the first important project commissioned to Gaudí. Declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 2005, the modernist building combines Gothic, Mediterranean and Islamic elements while expressing the amateurish yet already unique style of the artist, who was looking for a *Gothic building full of light, which made use of colour; a Gothic that was half maritime, half continental*.
- Our excursion continues with a stop for photos at one of Gaudí's most famous works of art: **Casa Milà**. This monumental, eccentric and futuristic building – also known as *La Pedrera* * enabled the architect to break with all of the architectural rules of the time thereby sparking the rage of the municipal authorities and attracting the criticism of his colleagues while, at the same time, managing to create what went down in history as one of the most representative examples of his naturalist period and modernism in general.
- We then move on to the splendid **Barrio Gótico**, the historic city centre and vibrant hub of the Catalan capital. We take in this open-air museum and let ourselves be conquered by the timeless atmosphere which envelops its maze of alleyways.

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- The central element of the Barrio Gótico and the maximum representation of the style the district is named after is Barcelona Cathedral, i.e. **Cathedral of the Holy Cross and Saint Eulalia**. With its stained glass windows and statues characterized by a more expressive and angular naturalism, it perfectly incarnates the archetype of Gothic architecture whose features inevitably invite observers to lift their gaze upwards and admire its beauty in its entirety.
- Our tour has come to an end but, before returning to the ship, we enjoy some **free time** to do a spot of shopping or stroll around the city centre while we remind ourselves of the incredible experience that has enabled us to fully experience this dynamic city.

- It's thanks to him that **Gavi DOCG** exists today. While you wander among the **50 hectares of vines in rows**, just think that in the past, only red grapes were grown here!
- After you've learned all there is to know about vines, it's time to head to the **winery**. Here, a **zero food miles process** transforms the grapes into wine, **respecting the raw materials and the land** that enable them to grow.
- All with a nod to the sea, too: did you know that the cork in the latest wine to be created by the estate is made from **plastic waste recovered from the ocean**?
- And while we're on the topic, it's time to pop a cork or two. On the terrace overlooking the vines, you **can turn into a sommelier yourself**, as you taste three of the **estate's labels**, and complete your rating card.
- Before leaving, a buffet of **typical dishes** and a **small gift** symbolizing the company's commitment to sustainability await you.

Excursion Booking

You can book excursions before departure by visiting the website www.mycosta.com, or by requesting to be contacted by our "Excursion Service" at +34 932952144 or through a request on the MyCosta website. Once on board, excursions can be booked through the Costa App, the Excursion Totem, or by visiting the MyTours office, where our staff will be available to offer advice and assistance.

Participation

Some excursions require a minimum number of bookings and have a maximum number of participants, so it is advisable to book them in advance.

Duration

The duration of the excursions is indicated in the description of each tour. Due to unforeseen circumstances, such as adverse weather conditions and/or transport delays, the duration may be subject to change. The program of individual excursions may also be modified for the reasons mentioned above. Please adhere to the times indicated by the guides at each stop (rest stops, photo stops, etc.).

Description
