FROM MOUNTAINTOP TO FJORD BY BIKE

Description

The perfect excursion for bike enthusiasts: a downhill biking tour with spectacular views of waterfalls and mountains as well as a hint of adrenaline for an unforgettable experience.

What we will see

- Djupvasshytta, Dalsnibba Mountain
- Downhill Biking Tour: scenic points, spectacular view of the Geirangerfjord

What we will do

- We will depart by coach from the Geiranger lifeboat station and head to **Djupvasshytta**, which sits at an altitude of 1,030 metres, at the foot of the **Dalsnibba Mountain**. This marks the departure point for our thrilling, 17-km **Downhill Bicycle Tour**.
- Everybody will be provided with a bicycle, but before getting in the saddle and beginning our descent to the valley, the guide will provide instructions and information on safety and the signposting along the route.
- On route, we will find many points from which we can take photos or simply admire the incredible scenery that the **Geirangerfjord**, a UNESCO-protected site, has to offer.
- Places on this excursion are limited. We recommend booking early.
- We recommend wearing sports clothing.
- You need to be physically fit to take part in this excursion.
- The safety helmet provided must be worn during the excursion.
- Minimum age: 12.

BRIKSDAL GLACIER WALK

Description

A walk which, with the landscape, will leave even the most expert mountain enthusiasts open-mouthed: a journey amongst rocky

cliffs, basins of blue and green water, and pristine country in one of the most famous and most visited fjords in the world.

What we will see

- Community of Geiranger
- Flydal Gorge, break area, breathtaking view of the Geirangerfjord
- Lake Djupvatn, spectacular views of the valley, Dalsnibba Mountain, unspoilt landscapes
- Summer ski park on the Tystigbreen glacier, Grotli, villages of Loen and Olden, Nordfjord
- Lake Oldenvatnet and the Jostedalsbreen glacier
- Norwegian lunch
- The Hornindalsvanet glacier and village of Hellesylt

What we will do

- Our tour begins in Geiranger , a small community situated in an inlet of the famous Geirangerfjord , a UNESCO-protected site.
- Starting at the docks, we head immediately for higher ground.
- Our first stop will be Flydal Gorge, an historic point of interest since 1936. Here, we find a break area with services and a platform from where we can admire Geirangerfjord from above... and take photos of our ship!
- Our winding road leads us in the direction of Lake Djupvatn , offering spectacular views of the entire valley along the way. We then continue to the top of Dalsnibba Mountain (1,500 m). We will find ourselves nestled amongst pristine scenery. We will breathe in extremely fresh air and remain speechless faced with the breathtaking landscape of mountains, waterfalls and lakes. If there is enough time, from here we can also see Geirangerfjord.
- After admiring the valley in all its glory, we make our way passed through the summer ski park on the Tystigbreen glacier , which sits at an altitude of 1,139 metres and Grotli. We continue along a road with 19 turns, all the while enjoying a landscape of exceptional beauty, in order to reach the villages of Loen and Olden on Nordfjord , one of the largest fjords in Norway.
- Next stop: Lake Oldenvatnet , which is encircled by majestic mountains and the striking Jostedalsbreen glacier. Our coach will drop us off outside the Briksdal Inn hostel; our walk to the glacier, where a small lake has formed, will begin here. The glacier's impressive ice tongue lies before us, strong and powerful, putting on a magnificent show.
- After admiring this beautiful landscape, we will relax by taking a break at the lodging house where we will sample a Norwegian lunch.
- We then head towards Hornindalsvanet , which is the largest lake in West Norway and the deepest in Europe, as well as offering the clearest waters in Scandinavia.
- By late afternoon, we will arrive at the village of Hellesylt , located in lower Sunnylvsfjord (a branch of Geirangerfjord), where the waters of the waterfalls fall straight into the fjord.

- The walk to the waterfall takes around 1 hour (3 km) and covers rough ground and steep sections so it may be tiring.
- We recommend wearing walking shoes and suitable clothing.

HIGH END KAYAKING
Description

Discover the Geirangerfjord paddling in the true heart of the norwegian fjords, one of the most beautiful and suggestive places of Scandinavia.

What we will see

- Geirangerfjord: breathtaking scenery and clifftop farms

What we will do

- The **Geirangerfjord** is described as the most beautiful fjord in the world: we will set off on a kayak journey surrounded by magnificent and striking mountains, which, with their steep faces, reach heights of up to 1,500 metres.
- Grip those paddles and away we go: we will admire the **brehtaking scenery and the farms perched on their rocky outcrops**. According to local folklore, farmers would tie ropes to their children and animals to prevent them from falling from the high walls of rock. We will skim the waters and breathe in the extremely fresh air of the fjord: what better way to feel the strength and greatness of mother nature in person than on a kayak tour?
- Our kayak will follow the outline of the basin, which curves between two tower-shaped mountains. It is a magical and majestic place at any time of the year.
- After admiring the verdant nature and the striking rock formations of the fjord, we will set off on the return journey, during which our guide will tell us the history of Geiranger and its population.
- You must be physically fit to take part in this excursion and not suffer from back pain.
- You must be able to swim.
- No prior kayak experience is required.
- The excursion includes a 5 minute walk to the kayak platform, where participants will receive safety instructions and information on how to paddle.
- Minimum age for the kayak excursion with an adult: 8.
- Maximum weight: 120 kg.
- Maximum height: 190 cm.
- Minors under 12 years of age must share the kayak with an adult.
- It is recommended that you only bring personal belongings which are strictly necessary; belongings will be left in a locked local office.
- Guests under 18 years must have the waiver signed by an adult (parent or guardian).

Description

A full immersion in the unspoilt nature of Geirangerfjord, protected site by UNESCO, admiring the best of Western-Norway and a breathtaking views of mountains, waterfalls, fjords and valleys.

What we will see

- Village of Geiranger
- Scenic view of the village and the Geirangerfjord
- Lake Djupvatn and Dalsnibba Mountain: mountains, glaciers, waterfalls and lakes
- Djupvasshytta: free time

What we will do

- Our tour begins in the **pleasant village of Geiranger** and will continue to the top of the mountain along the extremely steep Geiranger road.
- During the journey, we stop to enjoy a marvellous **scenic view** of the village of Geiranger below, the famous fjord and surrounding mountains. Verdant and unspoilt countryside as far as the eye can see.
- We continue on to **Lake Djupvatn**, then take the road to the top of **Dalsnibba Mountain** (1,500 m).
- If there is enough time, we can again enjoy a view of the **breathtaking landscape of mountains, glaciers, waterfalls and lakes**.
- We make a stop at **Djupvasshytta**, where we will have some **free time** to go looking for souvenirs and take photos of the lake to take home as lovely memories.
- Places on this excursion are limited. We recommend booking early.
- For safety reasons, if the road to Mount Dalsnibba is closed or covered by snow, an alternative panoramic view point will be suggested depending on weather conditions.

THE HERDAL VALLEY, ALPINE FARM AND TASTING OF LOCAL SPECIALITIES
Description

A perfect excursion for those wishing to combine the splendid countryside of the fjord and the discovery of local traditions and

lifestyle, tasting typical products of the alpine farm located at the heart of the fjord: an unforgettable journey.

What we will see

- Ørnevegen: views of the fjord and the Knivsflå alpine farm
- Seven Sisters Waterfall and Suitor Waterfall
- Village of Eidsal and the village of Norddal
- Summer farm of Herdalssetra: unspoilt nature, grazing animals and local specialities
- Heregga Peak: wood houses with turf roofs
- Herdøla River

What we will do

- The excursion begins on the **Ørnevegen** (literally, "Eagle Road"), which rises via 11 hairpin bends to the highest point of the fjord, at a height of 620 metres. From here, we can enjoy the **spectacular scenery of the fjord and the Knivsflå alpine farm**. This is the steepest section of road out of Geiranger and is the only means of communication with the outside world during winter!
- From here, it is possible to get a glance of the **Seven Sisters, a group of 7 waterfalls** which, together with the **Suitor Waterfall** (located opposite on the other side), provide one of the most beautiful natural spectacles of all of the Norwegian fjords... as well as being the subject of a fascinating legend.
- We reach the **village of Eidsdal** in Norddalsfjord and follow the coast up to the **village of Norddal**.
- Leaving the fjord, we head into the valley until we arrive at the **summer farm of Herdalssetra**. Operational for over 300 years, it is formed of 30 old houses and for hundreds of years, has housed goats and cows, lambs and horses which are free to graze. Here, old traditions are more alive than ever. Various types of white and brown goat's cheeses are produced here, as well as other mountain delicacies typical of the Norwegian fjords. These form the basis of a special **tasting session**, which is sure to delight the palate.
- The dwellings we will see are small **wood houses with turf roofs**, purposely built under the large **Heregga Peak**, which protects them from the frequent avalanches .
- On the journey to the valley, we can admire the **Herdøla River**, which receives the waters from numerous waterfalls.
- We arrive in Eidsdal then return to Geiranger via, once again, Ørnevegen, the "Eagle Road".

FROM GEIRANGER TO HELLESYLT

Description

This excursion will enable us to see the unmissable and most important sites along the journey from the village of Geiranger to Hellesylt: Norway's deepest lake, fertile valleys, a UNESCO protected site, releasing the emotions of even the most expert travellers.

What we will see

- Village of Geiranger
- Flydal Gorge, scenic platform and views of the entire fjord
- Dalsnibba Mountain
- Stryn Lake and Valley
- Jostedal Glacier National Park Centre
- Lake Hornindal
- Hellesylt

What we will do

- The Geirangerfjord is described as the most beautiful fjord in the world and this is no exaggeration. Our tour begins surrounded by imposing, steep mountain and countless waterfalls, in the small **village of Geiranger**.
- From there, we head to **Flydal Gorge**, historic point of interest since 1936. Here, we find a break area with services and a platform from where we can admire the Geirangerfjord from above... and take photos of our ship!
- Next, we head upwards to about 1,476 m, on the slopes of **Dalsnibba Mountain** where, on clear, sunny days, it is possible to enjoy unforgettable scenery.
- Next stop: **Lake Stryn**. Found in the fertile and green valley of the same name, it is a spectacular sight, and one not to be missed.
- Close to the lake shores is the **Jostedal Glacier National Park visitor centre**: we will take a break and take some photos to immortalise the stunning landscape.
- We continue along the shores of Lake Stryn and the banks of the river, heading to **Lake Hornindal**, which is the deepest lake in Europe, with depths of up to 514 m.
- We then descend to **Hellesylt**, one of the area's most important settlements, which is visited by over 100 cruise ships and 200,000 visitors every year. In this idyllic place, whose wild landscape of fjords, rivers and mountains has earned the protection of UNESCO, and whose population has managed to make the most of very difficult conditions, we find our ship awaiting us.
- Places on this excursion are limited. We recommend booking early.
- For safety reasons, if the road to Mount Dalsnibba is closed or covered by snow, an alternative panoramic view point will be suggested depending on weather conditions.
- Participants will rejoin the ship at Hellesylt.

- The excursion includes a break for lunch.

EXCURSION THROUGH THE FLO MOUNTAINS
Description

On this short excursion, we discover the beautiful Geirangerfjord and Stryn Lake, and the striking mountains and splendid landscape of waterfalls, lakes and traditional farm buildings that surround them.

What we will see

- Geiranger, Dalsnibba Mountain and a photo opportunity at Flydal Gorge
- Stryn Road and Lake
- Flo and its orchards
- Powerful mountains and glaciers and splendid natural landscape
- Traditional farm buildings
- Hellesylt

What we will do

- We depart by coach from **Geiranger** and ascend **Dalsnibba Mountain**, with the chance to take a **photo stop at Flydal Gorge**.
On a clear day, this viewpoint offers a splendid scenic view of the fjord and surrounding mountains.
- We take the new **Stryn mountain road** which, with a range of tunnels, makes the descent possible even during the winter season. We descend to **Lake Stryn**, continuing on to the **magical, orchard-sprinkled village of Flo**. From this point, the excursion will continue on foot.
- During the climb we will briefly stop to admire Lake Stryn, where we see **imposing mountains** such as Skåla and Lofjellet and numerous smaller **glaciers** reflected in the waters.
- During the excursion, we will pass close to **three seter (traditional farm huts)**; the preservation status of the structures remains excellent and there is still some evidence of the traditional methods which were used in the past.
- Our route offers the opportunity to admire the majestic, **splendid landscape** made up of mountain lakes and we will ascend to

a maximum height of 550 metres above sea level.

- At the Vollster alpine hut, we will get on-board the coach once again for the last part of the tour, which takes us to the **Hellesylt** area, before returning to the ship.
- Places on this excursion are limited. We recommend booking early.
- We recommend wearing comfortable, hard-wearing shoes.
- We recommend that you bring a wind-proof jacket as the mountain air can be cold even on a sunny day.
- The hiking will take less than 3 hours.
- This excursion is not recommended for guests with mobility problems.
- For safety reasons, if the road to Mount Dalsnibba is closed or covered by snow, an alternative panoramic view point will be suggested depending on weather conditions.
- Participants will rejoin the ship at Hellesylt.

Description

The perfect combination of breathtaking scenery, traditional landscapes and a little adrenaline, when gliding along the waters, in a raft, of the majestic fjord of Geiranger: on this excursion, we will discover one of the most magical places in Scandinavia, right from its very waters.

What we will see

- Geirangerfjord: spectacular landscapes amongst majestic mountains and unspoilt scenery
- Traditional mountain farms
- Seven Sisters Waterfall and Bridal Veil Falls

What we will do

- Our tour begins at the port: we will be welcomed by our guide and will walk approximately 200 metres to our raft.
- Before setting off on this stirring excursion on the waters of the fjord, we prepare ourselves by listening to some brief safety

instructions and we put on the windproof and waterproof coverall provided.

- Now the real excitement begins: our **Geirangerfjord** adventure can begin!
- The raft goes increasingly fast and the extremely pure air of the fjord can be felt on our faces providing a great sense of freedom whilst we admire the **majestic landscape**.
- Our helmsman will amaze us with a host of spectacular manoeuvres injecting a little adrenaline to the experience. The raft journey is not just about speed: the helmsman will slow down when approaching some **small mountain farms** located along the Geirangerfjord and will tell us a little bit about their history in English.
- We will admire the **Seven Sisters Waterfall and Bridal Veil Falls** up close, two of Norway's most important waterfalls, and we will discover the legend that lies behind their names. An unforgettable experience!

Olden **BRIKSDALEN GLACIER**

Description

An entire day to spend amidst the wonders of nature Norway has to offer: the Briksdalen glacier. As we venture into the mountains, the surrounding landscapes and majestic glacier will leave us spellbound.

What we will see

- Olden
- Lake Floen
- Lake Olden
- Briksdalen Glacier
- Stop at Briksdal Inn

What we will do

- We begin our excursion from the village of **Olden**, nestling at the head of the Innvikfjord, an arm of the Nordfjord. A pleasant village at the estuary of the River Oldeeva, surrounded by towering mountains, superb waterfalls and several glaciers, Olden is a popular resort for both residents and tourists alike.

- We continue by coach along the banks of two marvellous lakes: **Lake Floen** waiting for us with its delightful, little, red church and the very beautiful, long, narrow **Lake Olden**, one of the most admired in Norway.
- Welcome to the far end, Rustøen, where the wide, fertile, upper valley is spangled with multi-coloured farms. Our first excursion begins at the Briksdal Inn and we'll be walking up a spectacular, winding road, which carries us on to the shoulder of the mountain and will test our abilities Panoramic views of cascading waterfalls and enchanting mountain landscapes open up throughout our journey.
- The path ends near the lake, from where we can enjoy the magnificent view of the **Briksdalen glacier** rising majestically behind us. Surrounded by trees, high peaks and waterfalls, this is "just" an arm of the larger Jostedalbreen.
- We set off down the slope back to the *"Briksdal Inn"*, where we can have a break before returning to our starting point.
- At the end of our excursion it's back on board the coach to return to the quay.
- Places on this excursion are limited. We recommend booking early.
- The excursion involves some walking, so we recommend you wear comfortable walking shoes.

FROM THE FJORD TO THE SKY IN FIVE MINUTES
Description

An excursion entirely dedicated to striking fjord views: glass cable cars will take us up to over 1,000 metres asl to take in mountains, lakes, picturesque villages and all the magic of wild Norway.

What we will see

- Loen
- Loen Skylift
- Mountain Station
- Spectacular fjord views

What we will do

- We leave the Olden port by coach and head North along the fjord to reach the **small town of Loen** 6 km away.
- We get on the main attraction - the **Loen Skylift**, a modern cable car with glass cabins that in just 5 minutes takes us on the top of the Hoven mountain 1,011 metres above sea level.
- The skylift will stop at the Mountain Station, from where we can enjoy **striking 210° views**: to the East, we can admire Mount Skåla and Lake Lovatnet; to the South, we have the majestic Jostedalsbreen glacier with the town of Olden; to the West, the Nordfjord winds its way towards Stryn.

To the east stretches the fertile **landscape of Jæren**, with the **Ryfylke Mountains** in the distance.
- We will then continue to the outskirts of Stavanger to admire the **Sverd i fjell ("Swords in Rock")**, a fascinating memorial by the sculptor Fritz Røed. The monument depicts three 10 metre-high swords that commemorate the historic battle of Hafrsfjord. The largest sword represents the victorious Harald, while the smaller ones symbolise the vanquished kings. The monument is also intended to symbolise peace, as the swords are struck in solid rock, from which they can never be removed.
- We will now pass through both the older and more modern districts of Stavanger; we will admire the inside of the **Cathedral**, built in around 1125 by Bishop Reinald of Winchester with the help of British craftsmen. Of all the churches built in Norway during the Middle Ages, Stavanger Cathedral is the only one that still retains its original features.
- Before returning to the ship, we will treat ourselves to a walk through "Old Stavanger", with its typical narrow streets lined with picturesque wooden houses that date back to the 18th and 19th centuries, a time when it was home to sailors, craftsmen and merchants. - The last stop on this interesting tour of the marvels of Göteborg takes us to the **Universeum**, the **National Science Museum** as well as the largest Centre for scientific discoveries in Scandinavia boasting many attractions and activities for all the family.
- It features different exhibition areas over 7 floors and includes the **rainforest with exotic flora and fauna, the aquarium with sharks and giant stingrays, the chemistry and space lab** as well as sections given over to reptiles and spiders. - We continue our tour exploring the **district hosting events** of all kind such as the **Svenska Mässan exhibition and congress centre**, the gigantic **Liseberg amusement park** filled with thrilling attractions suitable for all ages and visited every year by around 3 million people and the **Ullevi Stadion** built for the 1958 Football World Cup of and now home to the local team, IFK Göteborg. This magnificent multi-purpose stadium can hold 43,000 spectators during football matches and 75,000 for concerts and shows.
- The itinerary continues with an interesting visit to **Masthuggskyrkan**, a **church** built in 1914 in the Swedish Romantic style and one of the city's symbols as well as a popular tourist attractions thanks to its incredible vantage point.
- After visiting the church, we continue towards the **Haga district**, renowned for its **picturesque wooden houses, its 19th-century atmosphere and its many cafés**. It started off as a suburb inhabited by the working class but it evolved over the years to become one of the most popular destinations for both tourists and locals, especially after many buildings were refurbished or rebuilt during the 1980s.

What we will do

- We reach **Copenhagen**, the enchanting capital of the world's oldest kingdom, a city where history, tradition and the modern world are interwoven with the magic of fairy tales.
- Our tour begins with an opportunity to take a few photographs of the world-famous statue of **Hans Christian Andersen's Little Mermaid**.
- Next, we make our way to **Amalienborg Palace**, comprising four identical buildings; this has been the **principal seat of the**

Danish royal family since 1794. It is guarded by soldiers in traditional bearskin hats and is also home to the **statue of King Frederick V** on horseback, depicted as a Roman emperor and considered one of the most important equestrian statues in the world.

- We move on to the picturesque entertainment district of Nyhavn, which dates back to the 17th century, with its colourful wood, brick and mortar townhouses, its famous wooden boats and the romantic sailing ships moored at the quays.
- Here we find some of the city's most interesting sights: the **Stock Exchange**, and **Christiansborg Palace**, home to the Danish Parliament and many of the country's other political institutions.
- We cross old canals and streets ensconced between ancient buildings to reach the pedestrian walkway that crosses the entire city. Our guide will point out the **famous Royal Copenhagen shop** where we can go on our own and admire the unique quality of its renowned, hand-painted, blue and white porcelain, and the hand-hammered silverware and hand blown glassware.
- At the end we will drive back to the pier crossing by the **City Hall**, **Tivoli Gardens** and **Rosenborg Castle**.
- Places on this excursion are limited. We recommend booking early.
- The excursion is reserved for guests who are not disembarking in Copenhagen.
- This excursion is not recommended for guests with mobility problems.
