Cherbourg **Mont St. Michel On Your Own**

In a nutshell

We explore Mont Saint-Michel, a 'wonder of the West' and masterpiece of medieval religious architecture, as well as an exceptional vantage point for admiring the spectacle of the tides which have the biggest height difference in the whole of France.

Main stops

- Mont Saint-Michel
- Porte de Bavole, Grand Rue and village
- Walls and Benedictine abbey

The programme

- On this excursion we spend the whole day at **Mont Saint-Michel**, a rocky island surrounded by a magnificent bay known as the 'wonder of the West' and a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1979. Visits to the island are spectacular at any time of year thanks to its configuration, the rich history of the abbey and the beauty of its architecture. The little island, with a circumference of around 1 km, reaches a height of 80 metres and is connected to the bay via a paved road built in 1879 which is submerged at high tide. The area is known for its alternating tides, causing changes to the sandbars that surround the mount. Here the movement of the tides is the highest in the whole of France and the difference between high and low tide can be over 12 metres.
- You will begin our visit at the fortified entrance, the **Porte de Bavole** built by Gabriel du Puy in 1590, and continue along the **Grand Rue**, a steep road that comes to life in the summer with souvenir shops and restaurants and crosses the picturesque village towards the abbey, church and cloister.
- You can also visit the **walls** along a route that offers enchanting views of the bay and the abbey gardens.
- We arrive at the **Abbey** which dates back to the 8th century when the Archangel Michael appeared to Aubert, bishop of Avranches, telling him to build a church on the rock. The bishop founded an oratory on the island, then known as Mont Tombe. In the Carolingian period the oratory was replaced by an abbey and from that time until the 16th century, magnificent Romanesque and Gothic buildings were constructed. The abbey was well fortified and never conquered; having been used as a prison during the French Revolution and the Second Empire, in 1874 it was declared a Historic Monument and opened to the public all year round.
- You can choose to visit the Abbey or have free time to shop for souvenirs (with a wide range of copper, ceramic and porcelain objects to choose from) and local produce (such as butter biscuits and other typical products of Normandy). We can enjoy the atmosphere of this medieval village

whose inhabitants carry on the island's traditions, continuing to make products for the delight of visitors and pilgrims coming to this unique site, just as they did over a thousand years ago.

Cherbourg **VAL DE SAIRE**

In a nutshell

An excursion along the evocative coast of Normandy with its romanticism, nature and history, exploring picturesque fishing villages and recalling its glorious past.

Main stops

- Val de Saire
- Cotentin peninsula, village of Le Vast and La Pernelle
- Saint-Vaast-la-Hougue and the fortifications of Vauban
- Barfleur

The programme

- We will leave the port of Cherbourg for the beautiful **Val de Saire**, which refers not only to the enchanting valley through which the river Saire flows, as its name suggests, but also to the whole northern part of the **Cotentin peninsula**.
- Travelling the country lanes of the peninsula and passing the picturesque village of **Le Vast**, famous for its little waterfalls, we will arrive at **La Pernelle** for the first stage of our half-day excursion. From here we can enjoy a fantastic panoramic view of the peninsula's eastern coast. On a clear day the view stretches from Barfleur to Grandcamp-Maisy.
- Back on the coach we will travel along the panoramic road to the village of **Saint-Vaast-la-Hougue**, a picturesque location on the Val de Saire coast which, as well as being a fishing port, is also a major oyster production centre. Saint-Vaast-la-Hougue is also popular for its seaside resorts and the presence of one of the **fortifications of Vauban**, rebuilt following the French defeat at the naval battle of La Hougue to protect the 17th century port. Here we enjoy some free time to stroll around the centre and indulge in some shopping.

- We continue our tour in the direction of **Barfleur**, a small tourist and fishing port listed as one of the most beautiful villages in France. In medieval times it was the main port of the Anglo-Norman kingdom and at the time of the Norman conquest it was an inhabitant of Barfleur who built 'La Mora', the ship that carried William the Conqueror to England in 1066. Over the centuries the port of Barfleur has witnessed the comings and goings of kings, dukes and their families travelling back and forth between the various kingdoms.
- Near Barfleur is the famous **Gatteville lighthouse**, built from 11,000 blocks of granite between 1829 and 1834 located. With a height of 75 metres it is the second tallest lighthouse in France. It features 52 windows recalling the number of weeks in the year, 12 landings for the number of months and 365 steps, one for every day of the year.

Cherbourg **LA HAGUE CAPE**

In a nutshell

A tour of the Normandy coast from the La Hague cape to Nez de Jobourg. The breathtaking landscapes and dizzying rocks enhance the magnificent atmosphere of these places where nature is the star attraction.

Main stops

- La Hague cape
- Port Racine
- Gourey: visit to the Raz Blanchard boat
- Ecalgrain bay
- Nez de Jobourg

The programme

- This excursion dedicated to nature lovers will take us to the **La Hague Cape** area, to the wild yet beguiling and untainted countryside to the west of Cherbourg dominated by granite rocks and moorlands. Here the landscape is rugged, the rocks are vertiginous, the coast is battered by the wind and the sea is often choppy: in short, nature is the star attraction of these places right out of a Turner painting.

- We continue our tour by coach, travelling along the panoramic coastal road towards Goury, passing aristocratic residences and typical Normandy villages on our way. One of these villages is **Port Racine**, considered to be the smallest port in France, named after a naval captain who made it the base for his ship during the reign of Napoleon.
- We will arrive in **Goury**, a place famous for its small port used to rescue vessels at the mercy of the area's strong currents. Here we will visit the famous **Raz Blanchard boat** (the French name for the Alderney Race, a strait with one of the strongest sea currents in Europe), known for having carried out numerous rescue missions.
- We continue our excursion across the wild and picturesque **Ecalgrain bay** whose name comes from the French expression *écaler le grain*, literally "to shell the grain". The name dates back to the mills that once lined the shores of the stream that flows into the bay. Ecalgrain bay also offers an incomparable view of the Channel Islands and the Alderney Race.
- Continuing to the south we will finally arrive at the imposing **Nez de Joburg** with the highest cliffs in Europe (up to 128 metres) from where we can admire truly breathtaking views.
- We return to Cherbourg across the Normandy countryside.
- We recommend that you book early because only a limited number of places are available.
- In 2025 Raz Blanchard boat is unfortunately not be at Goury due to some reparation works. You could enjoy a guided tour of Goury, Cap of La Hague and the area instead of visiting the lifeboat.

We can enjoy the atmosphere of this medieval village whose inhabitants carry on the island's traditions, continuing to make products for the delight of visitors and pilgrims coming to this unique site, just as they did over a thousand years ago.
- This excursion lasts approximately 9 hours, of which 4 hours and 30 minutes are spent travelling by coach.
- New local regulations prohibit access to the city entrance by coach. For this reason the transfer from the coach parking area to the main entrance and vice versa, will be made in part on foot and in part using local buses.

Cherbourg **THE NORMANDY LANDING BEACHES**

In a nutshell

An unmissable excursion to explore the sites where the allies landed in Normandy on D Day and relive an event that changed the history of Europe and the whole world.

Main stops

- Region of Cotentin
- Caen: memorial museum
- Sword, Gold, Juno and Arromanches beaches
- Omaha beach and Pointe du Hoc

The programme

- We begin our tour by travelling through the countryside of the **region of Cotentin**.
- Arriving in **Caen**, the capital of the department of Calvados and the region of Lower Normandy, we will visit the unique **memorial museum**. Here a spectacular exhibition allows us to relive the history of the Second World War, illustrating the risks, dangers and dramatic consequences of the war in the international context of the 20th century. B
- At the end of our museum visit the tour will continue to the famous **Normandy landing beaches**, famous for the events that began at dawn on 6 June 1944: **Sword, Gold, Juno and Arromanches**, all on the northern coast, are locations whose names are synonymous with an event that changed the history of the 20th century. In Arromanches in particular, the floating jetties of the artificial harbour can still be seen.
- We will then head west along **Omaha beach** towards **Pointe du Hoc**, one of the strongholds of the German army and the scene of a battle between American troops and the German forces at dawn on D Day. In an accurate, meticulously reconstructed scenario we will admire a battery of artillery complete with gun-laying station, anti-aircraft artillery platforms and trenches.
- We recommend that you book early because only a limited number of places are available.

SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA - short version

In a nutshell

A cultural and spiritual excursion to discover the artistic and historic heritage of Santiago de Compostela.

Main stops

The programme

- We leave the port by coach and set off towards **Santiago de Compostela**, one of the most famous and popular religious centres of Christianity and a pilgrimage destination since the Middle Ages.
- Santiago, situated on a hill, is a town that emanates history, with the narrow streets of the old town, quiet porticoes and many small squares; it boasts many beautiful and important monuments and is home to an ancient university and seat of an archbishopric.
- We begin our tour of the city's most interesting attractions on foot, starting from **Plaza del Obradoiro**, the main square of the old town where the magnificent Cathedral is located.
- We enter the maze of Medieval streets and we come to the **old Fonseca University**, we then proceed to **Plaza de las Platerías**, the square to the south of the Cathedral, which owes its name to the silversmiths' workshops (*platerías* means silversmiths in Spanish) which occupied the ground floor porticoes of the cloister in Medieval times and which have now been replaced by souvenir shops. The square is dominated by the only remaining Romanesque façade of the Cathedral.

- We then walk to **Plaza de la Quintana**, dominated by the east façade of the Cathedral. This square, the second largest in the historic centre of the city, is the ideal place to sit at one of the tables of the many bars and restaurants, the so-called *terrazas* and have a drink or enjoy one of the many free concerts or performances.
- We then proceed to the **Monastery of San Pelayo**, a lateral wall of which runs alongside Plaza de la Quintana, and then on to **Plaza Azabachería**, where we admire the Neoclassical Baroque north façade of the Cathedral which features a statue of St. James as a pilgrim.
- Our walk then takes us in front of the **Monastery of San Martín Pinario**, the second largest religious building in Santiago after the Cathedral. The highlight of the excursion is the visit to the magnificent **Cathedral**, one of the most important Catholic sanctuaries and the burial place of the Apostle Saint James the Greater, patron saint of Spain and Christian martyr.
- After stopping for **Tapas lunch at the Hostal de los Reyes Católicos**, we set off by coach towards Vigo.

The programme

- We meet our guide at the port and a short walk takes us to the catamaran that will lead us to **discover the Atlantic islands** scattered along the stretch of sea in front of Vigo.
- We set sail towards our destination, the **Cíes Islands**, a true paradise made up of three islands part of the Atlantic Islands of the Galicia National Park.
- The Cíes Islands, which the ancient Romans defined as islands of the Gods, are particularly striking

thanks to their richly populated seabeds and variety of scenery, alternating white dunes, steep cliffs and pine forests.

- We disembark on the largest island, **Monteagudo**, connected to the second island of the archipelago thanks to a long sandy crescent forming the magnificent Praia das Rodas beach, considered by the press and international organisations as one of the 10 most beautiful beaches in the world.
- In this idyllic scenery, we can choose whether to explore the island on our own or follow the guide on an excursion along the Alto do Principe trail, which winds its way around the island of Monteaguno and offers superb views of the archipelago peaks and sea as far as the spectacular belvedere.
- Places on this excursion are limited. We recommend booking early.
- This excursion is not recommended for guests with mobility problems.

MEDIEVAL IMPRESSIONS: VIGO AND THE ANCIENT VILLAGE OF BAIONA

In a nutshell

Galicia and its delightful towns boast Medieval charm, the fruit of a thousand years of history and the scent of the ocean.

Main stops

- Monte del Castro or Mount la Guía (panoramic)
- Baiona
- Panoramic Vigo
- Parador Monterreal

The programme

- After leaving the port by coach we head for the **Monte del Castro or Mount La Guía**. From here we can admire the **panorama of the city of Vigo**, the bay and the port.
- Back on our coach we proceed along the coast road in the direction of **Baiona**, one of the major and most characteristic fishing villages on the Galician coast. Its historic centre, with its quaint narrow streets and neat stone and granite houses, cobbled streets and the views from the ramparts with a sheer drop above the sea, exudes an atmosphere of orderly tradition and a sense of pleasant intimacy.
- It was right here, on 1st March 1493, that one of the caravels of the Columbus expedition, the "Pinta", having crossed back over the Atlantic Ocean, docked on its return to Europe with the news of the discovery of the "New World". Today a replica of the Pinta is berthed in the very same port.
- After our stroll around the historic centre, we visit the **Parador Monterreal**, an imposing 16th century palace, built in the style of a Galician manor house within the walls of a Medieval fortress. Today it houses a splendid hotel, whose centrepiece is the magnificent stone staircase which leads from the entrance to the floor above. From the terrace you can admire the wonderful panorama of the city while enjoying a drink at the bar of this magnificent hotel.
- Once back in **Vigo**, a short panoramic coach tour gives us an overview of some areas of the city.
- Places on this excursion are limited. We recommend booking early.
- The visit to the Parador Monterreal does not include the services of a guide.

- In this city in the Province of Pontevedra we visit the **Cathedral of Santa Maria**, founded in 1120 and subsequently an embattled fortress in Romanesque-Gothic style.
- From the tower, which is like a balcony overlooking the river, we can enjoy a beautiful panoramic view of the city before returning to Vigo.

If you use a wheelchair, it is necessary to check the availability of suitable/compatible excursions before booking by contacting our "Excursion Service" at +34 932952144 or through a request on the MyCosta website. Once on board, it is recommended to visit the MyTours office on the first day of the cruise for further assistance.

Customized Programs

Personalized and exclusive tours can be arranged upon request and subject to quotation by contacting our "Excursion Service" or on the day of embarkation by visiting the MyTours office.

Prices

The prices of the excursions include transport where specified, which may include buses, minibuses, taxis, cable cars, and boats. Meals and/or drinks are included only where specified. Prices and excursion programs may be subject to change.

Children and kids

Children aged 3 to 13 are entitled to a 30% discount on all excursions. Children under 3 years old participate for free.

Squok Club
