Description

We pick up our cameras as real influencers to capture the essence of Marseille. An innovative stimulating excursion for those who love to share their emotions with their dear ones and, why not, be the envy of followers!

What we will see

- Old Harbour: ombrière, Notre Dame de la Garde, ...
- "Panier" Quarter
- Cathedral of Saint-Marie-Majeure
- MuCEM and Fort Saint-Jean

What we will do

- We take out our cameras ready to capture the spirit of Marseille and create a true social photo feature.
- Our guide will be waiting to welcome us as we disembark from the ship. Together, we make our way to the city centre, specifically, a point near the **Old Harbour** where our tour begins.
- First of all, we reach the **ombrière**: a sheet of stainless steel acting as a mirror, showing us our upside-down reflex and offering us endless photo opportunities.
- Let us not forget to capture the city's emblem – the magnificent **Notre Dame de la Garde** in the Romanesque-Byzantine style. Will we manage to capture all its charm in a single picture?
- We pass by Hotel Intercontinental (former Hotel Dieu) and venture into the old "**Le Panier**" district, the city's historic city centre populated by workshops, colourful lively cafés, and many original curiosities ready to be photographed!
- We continue towards **Marseille Cathedral**: it is rather peculiar how a boules court, the game symbol of Provence, is found right in front of the entrance to this imposing church. Why not seize the chance of having our photo taken as we mime a throw?
- We then head back to the Old Port and to the area between the **Musée des civilisations de l'Europe et de la Méditerranée (MuCEM)** and **Fort di Saint-Jean**, the fortress built by Louis 14th in 1660. From here, we can admire the city in all of its splendour. – an unmissable occasion to capture this breathtaking scenery on camera!
- Our excursion has come to an end: we return to our ship ready to post all the emotions we have enjoyed, which will be forever etched in our memories and available on our photo gallery.
- Places on this excursion are limited. We recommend booking early.

A tour in search of the true soul of Marseille, a bustling, multicultural city with a long and fascinating history, brimming with the flavours and aromas of Mediterranean culture.

What we will see

- The Church of Saint Laurent and the view of the Old Port
- "La Major" Cathedral and Esplanade
- Museum Complex
- "Panier" quarter, "La Vieille Charité" courtyard and loggia

What we will do

- We begin our discovery tour of Marseille by taking the shuttle bus from the port to the Church of Saint-Laurent. The little square in front of the church offers **beautiful views of the Old Port** and the hills surrounding the city.
- We make our way downhill from the church towards Marseille's Neo-Byzantine cathedral, known locally as **La Major**. After a tour around the outside of the building, we have a short stop in the new **Esplanade**, recently completed to coincide with Marseille's nomination as the "European capital of culture 2013".
- We then make our way to the new **museum complex**, which comprises three institutions: the "Musée Regards de Provence", the "Ville Méditerranée" and "MuCEM" - the Museum of European and Mediterranean Civilisations. Our guide will provide an overview of each building from the outside.
- We walk onwards, heading into the old heart of the city, the "**Panier**" quarter, with its artisan workshops and colourful, bustling cafés.
- Before we make our way into the web of narrow streets of the old town, we stop to visit the courtyard and the loggia of "**La Vieille Charité**", a building that originally served as an almshouse for the city's poor, but which is now home to a cultural centre and a venue for temporary exhibitions. We then take another short break to sample some local products.
- We make our way back to the Old Port, where we can either board the ship straight away, or spend a couple of hours of free time in the city centre.
- Space is limited, so please reserve early.
- Comfortable walking shoes are recommended.
- The order of visits may vary.

IN THE HEART OF CAMARGUE

Description

We venture in the wild yet charming region of Camargue, visit an ornithological park to see the local flora and fauna up close and visit the lovely Saintes-Maries-de-la-Mer for some shopping and relaxation.

What we will see

- Tour of Camargue
- Parc Ornithologique du Pont de Gau
- Guided tour of the park
- Saintes-Maries-de-la-Mer: at own leisure

What we will do

- We leave Marseilles behind us and venture into spectacular **Camargue**, a series of swamps, ponds and paddy fields where nature still reigns supreme.
- Along the way, we are charmed by the magnificent views and could be lucky enough to spot the famous wild **white horses** or majestic untamed bulls grazing in the moorland.
- We stop at the **Parc Ornithologique du Pont de Gau**, which combines the joy of a stroll with the discovery of the bird species living in the region such as graceful flamingoes, once on the brink of extinction, herons, egrets and storks.
- We walk along paths, footbridges and walkways on a **guided tour** of the park, which covers 60 hectares of unspoilt nature where flora and fauna coexist in harmony in their natural habitat.
- After the visit, we leave the park and head towards the capital of Camargue, **Saintes-Maries-de-la-Mer**, a small fishing village with white houses dominated by a relaxed evocative atmosphere.
- Here, we have some free time to **explore the town**. We can wander around the shops, enjoy local specialities or visit the town sights before returning to the ship.

AVIGNON, CITY OF THE POPES

Description

An opportunity not to be missed to explore a UNESCO World Heritage Site, Avignon, "the city of the Popes": a step back into the history of the church and the Papacy, tracing the splendour of the reign of 7 pontiffs who brought prosperity and prominence to Avignon.

What we will see

- Palace of the Popes
- Free time for shopping and exploring the city




What we will do

- We leave the port of Marseille by coach, and head for **Avignon**, a journey that takes about one hour. The city of Avignon is famous for having been the seat of the Papacy from 1309 to 1377, a period known as the "Avignon captivity" . Pope Clement V transferred the Papal court from Rome to Avignon, from where 7 Popes reigned until 1377 and 2 antipopes stayed on almost until the end of the 14th century, bringing a period of prominence and prosperity to the city.
- Our tour takes us to the **Palace of the Popes** which has been recognised in France as a historic monument since 1840, and as a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1995. The building, which is both a palace and a fortress, is one of the most extraordinary examples of Gothic architecture of the 14th century. It was built in two phases, by two popes: to the north, the more austere Palais Vieux (Old Palace) was built during the reign of Benedict XII; the Palais Neuf (New Palace), to the south, was built by his successor, Clement VI. Inside, the now-empty galleries, chambers and chapels give an apparent impression of austerity. The frescoes and handwoven tapestries in the bedrooms and the Papal study however, give a better idea of the pomp and splendour of times gone by.
- Before going back to the ship, we have some free time for a walk in the streets of the centre or for shopping.
- This excursion is not recommended for guests with mobility problems.
- The duration from the port to Avignone is approximately 1h30minutes.?

MARSEILLE AND ITS HIDDEN TREASURES
Description

An excursion for those who want to discover the hidden treasures and secrets of Marseille, a millennial melting pot of people and cultures, a city of indisputable charm and a distinct identity that draws visitors in with its magical atmosphere.

What we will see

- Cathedral of Notre Dame de la Garde and Church of Saint-Laurent
- "Le Panier" quarter
- Vieille Charité and Cathedral of Sainte Marie Majeure (external visits)

What we will do

- We leave from the left-hand side of the port and begin our tour of Marseille with a visit to the **Cathedral of Notre-Dame de la Garde** which is at the highest point of the city at an altitude of 162 m above sea level, from where we can see the whole of Marseille laid out before us.
- We will then make our way to the **Church of Saint-Laurent**, a handsome example of Provençal Romanesque architecture, built in pink stone from Couronne, with splendid views of the Old Port.
- It also marks the beginning of the quarter known as "**Le Panier**" ("the basket"), which is one of the oldest quarters of Marseille and the old heart of the city. It owes its name to the "Le Logis du Panier" inn, an old establishment dating back to the 17th

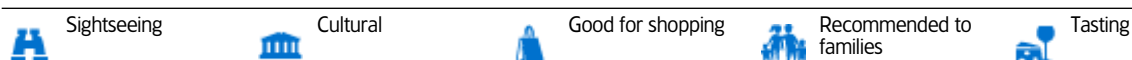
century. This part of the city is a typical Mediterranean port neighbourhood with the fronts of houses painted in a variety of colours and narrow winding streets. Historically a favoured haunt of sailors, it is now one of Marseille's most characteristic areas.

- Following a visit to **La Vieille Charité** - originally an almshouse for the city's poor, now home to a cultural centre and a venue for temporary exhibitions - we have the opportunity to try a local speciality, the "navette" ("little boat"), a traditional biscuit flavoured with orange blossoms that is baked in the shape of a boat.
- After a short break, close to La Vieille Charité, we pay a short visit to the Neo-Byzantine **Cathedral of Saint-Marie-Majeure** - also known by the locals as "La Major" - before heading back to the port.

TRANSFER TO AIX-EN-PROVENCE

Description

We will have complete freedom to explore Aix-en-Provence, savouring the joy of strolling through its narrow streets, squares and historic buildings, and discovering its colours and aromas with a visit to the local market or an open-air café.

What we will see


- Aix-en-Provence
- City centre

- Mazarin Quarter

What we will do

- We will leave the port by coach and make our way to **Aix-en-Provence**, a university and spa city and the political hub of Provence, located about 30 minutes away from Marseille.

- As soon as we arrive in Aix-en-Provence, we will immediately notice its sophisticated atmosphere as we walk freely around the **romantic streets** in the centre, admiring aristocratic residences dating back to the 17th and 18th centuries.
- Our walk wouldn't be complete without a stroll along **Cours Mirabeau**, a stunning, tree-lined avenue boasting beautiful fountains and numerous outdoor cafés.
- Another must is the **Mazarin Quarter**, designed by the Archbishop Michel Mazarin, brother of the famous Cardinal.
- In the same area we can also admire the **Place des Quatre Dauphins** or "Four Dolphins Square", with a beautiful fountain adorned by sculptures of four dolphins, and the **Saint Sauveur Cathedral**, featuring various architectural styles ranging from the 5th to the 17th century, which can be admired from all sides.
- Yet Aix-en-Provence isn't all history and art, it's also a **vibrant town offering a host of activities**. We will set some time aside to independently explore the elegant streets dotted with typical shops, the local fruit and vegetable market or relax at a café.

From here we can enjoy a **breathtaking view of Malaga**, its

bays and the surrounding areas.

- Then we will head to the centre of Malaga where we will enjoy a **pleasant stroll** to a typical Andalusian tavern. Here we will sample a **glass of fine wine** from the region whilst watching a fascinating **flamenco show**, which will leave us with an unforgettable memory of this city thanks to the sensuality of the dance, the intensity of the song and its unmistakable rhythm.

A VISIT AROUND MALAGA

Description

Monuments, ancient fortresses, palaces, typical lanes, elegant gardens and tree-lined avenues: a tour to discover Malaga.

What we will see




- Malaga
- Cathedral
- Historic city centre
- Alcazaba
- Gibralfaro

What we will do

- The first stop on our trip takes us to **Malaga**, a city founded more than two thousand years ago and now one of the oldest ports in the Mediterranean, and the **cathedral**, one of the most important Renaissance monuments in Andalusia. Dating back to the 16th century, the cathedral was constructed on the site of a former mosque.
- We will then move on to the **historic centre** of Malaga, where we can admire the beauty of the typical *calles*.
- Our trip will then take us on to **Alcazaba**, a fortress from the Muslim era that testifies the Moorish resistance to the Christian kings. From its ancient peripheral walls we can enjoy an evocative view of the city and its surroundings, including the bay.
- Another beauty spot from which we can enjoy a breath taking view is **Gibralfaro**, an ancient fortress situated on top of the hill that dominates the city. Constructed in the 14th century by Yusuf 1, Caliph of Granada, in the spot on which the Phoenicians

had built a lighthouse, it was, for a long time, the most impregnable fortress on the Iberian peninsula. Here we take a final look at Malaga, its bay and the beautiful surroundings, before beginning our return journey to the ship.

THE TREASURES OF GRANADA: THE ALHAMBRA AND GENERALIFE GARDENS
Description

A chance to be enchanted by the Arabian atmosphere of Granada's architectonic masterpieces: the Alhambra and the Generalife.

What we will see

- Granada
- Alhambra Palace
- Generalife

What we will do




- In **Granada**, capital of the Andalusian province, we are won over by the countless, priceless architectonic wonders. We begin our excursion with a visit to the **Alhambra Palace**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. A small fortified royal city, it is built on the top of a hill, La Sabika. The fortress, testament to the city's Moorish past, is one of few Moorish monuments still intact today.
- The spell continues as we walk through the stunning **Generalife gardens**, the former summer residence of the Arabian kings, located outside of the fortified walls of the Alhambra. The name derives from the Arabic "Yanat-al-Arif" which means "the architect's garden", taken to signify the "Garden of God". We soak up the magical atmosphere of this heavenly garden and its terraces, water features and elegant decorations.
- Having admired this Arabian architectural work of art, we will take a break at a **typical restaurant** where we will taste delicious local cuisine before heading back to the ship.

DISCOVERING GIBRALTAR

Description

At the furthest point of the Iberian peninsula lies Gibraltar, an overseas territory of the United Kingdom, rich in colonial history and

natural wonders.

What we will see

- Torremolinos, Fuengirola and Marbella
- Línea de la Concepción
- Baia dei Catalani
- Punta de Europa
- St. Michael's Cave
- Barbary Monkeys
- Moorish Castle
- Main Street

What we will do

- From Malaga we will head for the tourist resorts of **Torremolinos, Fuengirola and Marbella**, before reaching the Cadiz province, where we will visit the **Línea de la Concepción**, the city that borders Gibraltar.
- Once across the border, we will leave the coach and board a minibus, the ideal way to admire the enchanting views, as described by the audio guide.
- We initially head north, before crossing the border between Spain and England behind Gibraltar airport.
- We continue on to **Catalan Bay**, or La Caleta, a traditional fishing village that apparently owes its name to the landing of the troops who arrived from Catalonia during the War of the Spanish Succession in the 18th century.
- We are enchanted by **Gibraltar** that extends all the way to the famous rock, a calcareous stone with reefs that jut out of the sea. Here we find Europa Point, the most southern tip of Gibraltar, where the Mediterranean Sea meets the Atlantic Ocean. If it is a clear day, we can see the African coast and take some beautiful photos.
- We will have chance to visit **St. Michael's Caves**, natural caves used as a refuge by Neolithic inhabitants of the Rock, where we will admire the captivating scene created by the many stalagmites and stalactites. Before concluding our tour of Gibraltar, we will get to know the real stars of this land, the **Barbary monkeys**, the only examples still to be found in the wild today. - Before climbing the watch tower and enjoying the breathtaking view that we have from the highest point of the old town, we stop at the **Cámara Oscura**, a truly unique attraction that involves the projecting of real, moving images of the city using a white screen, a mirror and magnifying lenses: an unforgettable experience.
- After this memorable experience, we reach the **Plaza de las Flores** and take the opportunity to walk through the maze of characteristic narrow streets that criss-cross the city.
- The magic continues with a visit to see the exterior of the famous **Cathedral**. We stop to admire the magnificence of this church – constructed with gold and silver brought from the New World – its golden dome towering over the Baroque-style building, which is enhanced with neoclassic elements. Begun in 1722, the Cathedral recalls the golden age of Cádiz, when the city controlled a large part of Spanish commerce with the Americas.
- Finally we take time to discover the **Pópulo** district, one of the oldest in the city, before stopping at **Plaza San Juan de Dios**, the municipal square, which features numerous, characteristic bars.

Thanks to their beauty, they often serve as a setting for concerts, ballet and other events.
- A particular and thrilling meeting with the real residents of these caves awaits us - **Barbary macaques** - the only ones in Europe that still live in the wild.
- We will then go back to the city, where we can admire the **Moorish castle**, a testimony to Arab domination, with its imposing tower that still houses the Arab baths.
- Before going back to the coach, we will still have some free time for a walk around the heart of Gibraltar, characterised by its typical British atmosphere.

- We will end our excursion by returning to Montjuïc to visit **The Poble Espanyol open-air museum**. It was built for the 1929 Universal Exhibition to show visitors the many cultural and architectural sides to Spain, with historic recreations of over 100 places of interest across the country.

BARCINO, THE HIDDEN ROMAN CITY
Description

We will travel back through time and discover the remains of the ancient Roman colony of Barcino, the original heart of what is now Barcelona. Traces of its legacy still remain today in the succession of buildings and architectural structures.

What we will see

- Accompanied by our guide, we will begin our **walking tour of what remains of Barcino**, the Roman town that was the foundation for modern-day Barcelona. As we stroll through the city, traces of this settlement will take us back in time to over two thousand years ago.
- We will venture into the labyrinth of streets that is the **Barrio Gótico** or Gothic Quarter. This district was the heart of political and religious life in the Middle Ages and, even today, its layout is still faithful to the classic Roman Cardo and Decumanus grid structure.
- In **Plaça Nova**, traces of the Roman settlement abound in a string of architectural delights. We can still see the two semi-circular towers that flanked the gateway to the Decumanus road, as well as sections of the city's defence walls and the arch of an aqueduct.
- Amidst temple columns and the remains of walls that peep up every now and then, almost casually incorporated into more modern buildings, we will walk along **Via Laietana**, which takes its name from the first Iberian population to settle in this region. Built in the early 20th century, it has retained the architectural heritage of the Roman walls.
- A must on our tour of the Roman remains is the **Barcelona History Museum, known as MUHBA**, which has preserved and

exhibits Barcelona's rich historical heritage, from its Roman origins to the modern day.

- The highlight of the tour is the **Plaça del Rei underground complex** where we can admire the remains of an entire district of the Roman city of Barcino, which spans over 4,000 square metres with its narrow passageways.

- You’ll be able to admire **Casa Milà**, best known by its nickname, La Pedrera. Gaudí’s most mature work, this building is a triumph of curved lines with undulating façades, chimneys that coil around one another and the rounded wrought iron railings. A little further on stands **Casa Batlló**, with its façade and roof covered entirely in glistening, multi-coloured scales.
- Barcelona is also home to the works of Gaudí’s distinguished colleagues belonging to the Modernist movement, including **Casa Fuster**, the final work of Domènech i Montaner, which features many of the architect’s characteristic elements, such as floral decorations or trefoil windows.
- Last of all, we pass opposite **La Monumental**, Barcelona’s, if not Spain’s, most famous plaza de toros, specially designed for the corrida.
- On our return, we’ll hand back our Segways and you’ll be free to return to our ship under your own steam.

- Our route continues alongside the neighbouring beach of **Playa de la Nova Icaria**, beyond which lies the bright blue, sparkling Mediterranean Sea.
- We'll ride along the sea front bordered by the beach and lush gardens, another legacy from the Olympic period, embellished with important buildings, such as **the Mapfre Tower and the Hotel Arts**, two of the city's highest skyscrapers, in front of which towers the monumental sculpture of the "golden fish" by Frank Gehry, one of the greatest living architects.

Barcelona is the city where the great architect Antoni Gaudí produced his most important and famous works which today define the

This gigantic work is still under construction decades later, following the plans left by the master architect. Our local guide will point out the most distinctive details of the façade, a demonstration of Gaudí's incredible creativity in its own right.
- Before continuing our tour, we will have some free time to stroll around the district and do a bit of shopping.
- Then we will continue on towards Casa Milà, better known as **La Pedrera** (literally "The Quarry"), one of Gaudí's last works and the greatest example of Catalan modernism. The building, the last civil work designed by the master architect, is a true triumph of curved lines with undulating faces, chimneys that coil around one another and the magnificent wrought iron railings resembling breaking waves.
- The next masterpiece that we will visit on our tour is **Casa Batlló**, a residential building enveloped in a surreal atmosphere. We will admire the façade and roof, covered entirely in glistening multi-coloured scales. The extravagant inventiveness of the shapes is inspired by the legend of Saint George (the patron saint of Catalonia) who fought the dragon, alluded to in the sinuosity of the roof, while the rows of balconies and bone-like structures symbolise the victims.
- On our way back to the ship, we will pass through the commercial heart of the historic centre, the famous **Plaça de Catalunya** and the port area before bringing this magical day to a close.

- Skimming the port, we will admire Lanterna, which has always been a point of reference for seafarers, and we will continue, by

coach, upon the discovery of the most interesting places within the city until we get to **Castelletto**, one of the oldest and aristocratic in Genoa which stands on the headland overlooking the historic centre.

- From here one of the city's historic lifts will take us to the very centre, to the alleyways which Rubens described as "Europe's most beautiful roads": **Via Garibaldi**, better known as Strada Nuova. This pedestrian area includes some of Genoa's most sumptuous squares, built in the 1500s as residences for the most important noble families and which were restored to their original splendour for the occasion of "Genoa 2004".
- At this stage, we will visit the **Palazzo Bianco and Palazzo Imperiale** (exclusive entry for Costa Cruises) followed by a delicious tasting session.
- From this elegant alleyway, we will go onto a part of the city which historically connected it to the sea, passing by **Porta Soprana**, the **House of Columbus**, **Via San Lorenzo**, the **Ducal Palace** and the **Ancient Port**.
- During the free time available until the end of the tour, we can trace the ancient and characteristic **Porticoes of Sotto Ripa**.
- The transfer to Genoa takes approximately 1 hour.
- Comfortable shoes are recommended.

ITALY'S HIDDEN TREASURES - FINALBORGO AND NOLI
Description

Centuries of history and suggestive settings transport us back in time to the Middle Ages as we explore two of Italy's most handsome medieval townships, Finalborgo and Noli.

What we will see

- Finalborgo
- Castel San Giovanni
- Basilica of San Biagio
- Convent of Santa Caterina
- Noli
- The *Torre del Canto* and the *Torre del Comune*
- Medieval walls
- Cathedral of San Paragorio

What we will do

- We leave the port by coach, in the company of our tour rep, and make our way to the first stop on our journey, **Finalborgo**, which is considered one of the most attractive townships in the whole of Italy. The settlement is undoubtedly medieval in origin, although recent research suggests that it was founded several centuries earlier than was previously believed.

- As we stroll through the streets of the old town, the imposing defensive mass of **Castel San Giovanni** and other notable monuments such as the **Basilica of San Biagio**, the **Convent of Santa Caterina** and numerous Renaissance *palazzi* conjure an almost palpable sense of history.
- We leave Finalborgo for another of the Italian Riviera's Medieval gems: the town of **Noli**. This gracious little settlement was home to skilled merchants and courageous navigators who saw it become an independent maritime republic.
- We explore the historic centre on foot, admiring the buildings that recount this fascinating history. There are the **Torre del Canto and the Torre del Comune**, two of the "seventy-two towers of Noli", of which but a few remain. Then there are the surviving **sections of the defensive walls** that once formed an impenetrable barrier around the city, and the 12th-century **Cathedral of San Paragorio**, one of the emblematic examples of Romanesque architecture in Liguria.
