Rice fields, lagoons and pink flamingos: it's not a dream * it's the **Camargue**. It is said that Mary Magdalene also passed through here: you'll find out for yourself as you step into the 9th century **fortified Roman church**, before strolling through the **narrow streets**, among **typical restaurants** and **artisan boutiques** that feel like they're from another era.

Marseilles SEAFARING MARSEILLES

In a nutshell

Marseilles as seen by its seafaring people: the **port**, **Notre-Dame de La Garde cathedral** and the church of **Saint-Laurent**, the multicultural district of **Le Panier**, the **Vieille Charité**, that provided refuge for the poor, and Saint-Marie-Majeure cathedral, known locally as 'La Major'. Not forgetting a **taste of navettes**, the local cookies which, obviously, are a nod to the sea.

- Cathedral of Notre-Dame de la Garde
- Church of Saint-Laurent: external visit
- 'Le Panier' district
- Vieille Charité and Cathedral of Sainte-Marie-Majeure
- Tasting of **navettes**, the local cookies

The programme

- The forts of **Saint-Jean and Saint-Nicolas** welcome you to **Marseilles**, the quintessential **sea port**, multicultural, busy, bold.
- Arriving in this city **founded by the Greeks in 600 BC** as **Massalia**, you'll notice the **Cathedral of Notre-Dame de La Garde** on the highest hill. After visiting it, continue the sightseeing tour to the **church of Saint-Laurent**, the seafarer's church, with a view of the **Vieux Port**.
- Walk through the **district of Le Panier**, the oldest in the city. With a name that means **basket**, inherited from the Logis du Panier inn of 1600, it is a hotchpotch of shops, painters' and potters' studios, and social housing.
- After the **Vieille Charité**, which once welcomed the poor, we'll take you to a typical **bistro** to try some **navettes**, the local cookies that are boat-shaped and flavored with orange flower.
- A final taste of local culture at the **Sainte-Marie-Majeure Cathedral**, known as **La Major** by locals, and then you too can get back to sea.

- After a short journey we arrive at the first buildings built by the British in Gibraltar, now home to the historical '**City under Siege Exhibition**'. Visiting the exhibition we can learn about the hardships suffered by the Rock's inhabitants in times of great poverty due to the long and relentless Spanish sieges. The aggressors aimed (without success) to reconquer Gibraltar, considered to be a strategic point for access to the Mediterranean.
- A short distance away we find the medieval **Moorish Castle** dating back to 1333 and one of Gibraltar's major attractions.
- Returning to the higher part of the city we walk along the typical narrow, steep streets until we reach **Main Street**, a famous pedestrianised shopping area. Here, depending on the participants' wishes, the driver can return to the ship or drop off those wishing to take advantage of the duty free shops in the city centre.

- In the reproduction of the Andalusian quarter, we visit the Tablao de Carmen, named after the great dancer Carmen Amaya, where we attend a flamenco show, the dance that best represents the Iberian soul.

- We continue with the **Sagrada Família** to admire its façades, doors and towers. The vastness of the

- design and its unique style have made Gaudí's unfinished project the most iconic in the city.
- We have lunch in a **typical restaurant** where we can savour **a few Iberian specialities** including *patatas bravas, ensaladilla rusa, corquetas, buñuelos* and *pulpo*... All these traditional delicacies cater to our palate every whim and perfect to nibble and share *para compartir* just the way the Spaniards do!
 - After refuelling, we continue towards **Casa Vicens**, the first important project commissioned to Gaudí. Declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 2005, the modernist building combines Gothic, Mediterranean and Islamic elements while expressing the amateurish yet already unique style of the artist, who was looking for a *Gothic building full of light, which made use of colour; a Gothic that was half maritime, half continental*.
 - Our excursion continues with a stop for photos at one of Gaudí's most famous works of art: **Casa Mila**. This monumental, eccentric and futuristic building - also known as *La Pedrera* * enabled the architect to break with all of the architectural rules of the time thereby sparking the rage of the municipal authorities and attracting the criticism of his colleagues while, at the same time, managing to create what went down in history as one of the most representative examples of his naturalist period and modernism in general.
 - We then move on to the splendid **Barrio Gótico**, the historic city centre and vibrant hub of the Catalan capital. We take in this open-air museum and let ourselves be conquered by the timeless atmosphere which envelops its maze of alleyways.
 - The central element of the Barrio Gótico and the maximum representation of the style the district is named after is Barcelona Cathedral, i.e. **Cathedral of the Holy Cross and Saint Eulalia**. With its stained glass windows and statues characterized by a more expressive and angular naturalism, it perfectly incarnates the archetype of Gothic architecture whose features inevitably invite observers to lift their gaze upwards and admire its beauty in its entirety.
 - Our tour has come to an end but, before returning to the ship, we enjoy some **free time** to do a spot of shopping or stroll around the city centre while we remind ourselves of the incredible experience that has enabled us to fully experience this dynamic city.
 - We recommend that you book early as only a limited number of places are available.
