- We will then explore **Parque de María Luisa**, donated by the Duchess to the city in 1893. The scenery is truly wonderful, and architecture and nature coexist in perfect harmony. Cedar, elm and palm trees are reflected in the numerous ponds creating an enchanting atmosphere.
- After a thrilling day dedicated to art and culture, we will make our way back to Cádiz.

The muezzin calls the city's faithful to prayer every day from its splendid and impressive minaret, a masterpiece of Hispano-Moorish art. * At lunchtime we have the opportunity to taste some ****typical dishes**** of the local cuisine. * Our excursion proceeds with a visit to the ****Bahia Palace****, built around 1880 by the Vizier Ba Ahmed, Prime Minister of the Sultan of Marrakech. This lavish building is a true masterpiece of Moroccan art, so much so that its architectural charm has been chosen as the set for many famous films including 'Ali Baba and the

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Forty Thieves', 'Lion in the Desert' and 'Casablanca'.

- * We now go into to the heart of the ****medina**** and, together with our guide, venture into the maze of its thousand and one alleyways teeming with frenetic daily activities to discover the ****riads****, the old dwellings of the Moroccan gentry with lush courtyards and refined decorations which render Marrakech a city of unrivalled charm beyond. It is impossible not to remain spellbound by the succession of striped multi-coloured walls, doors inlaid with decorations from a thousand and one nights and scenes of daily life where time seems to have stopped centuries ago.
- * As we cut across the ****Talaa Square****, we can view the ****Ben Youssef Mosque**** from outside. * From here we venture into the world of the Marrakech ****souks**** where we are welcomed and embraced by rich colours and aromas. As we go from the blacksmiths' souk to the ***babouches*** souk and all the way to the Semmarine souk in the alleyways covered with canes and lanterns we can admire the rich local crafts and the colourful setting created by a myriad of spices, mountains of dried fruit, typical sweets and delicious olives.
- * At our last stop we go to Morocco's most famous square: ****Jemaa el Fna Square****, a true 'Court of Miracles' teeming with a heterogeneous and multicoloured crowd; dancers, singing storytellers, snake charmers and monkey trainers. This square, which is the beating heart of the city, was designated a Masterpiece of Oral and Intangible Heritage of Humanity by UNESCO in 2001. A true synthesis of the many facets of Marrakech, the image of this square will be our last impression of Morocco, an authentic and fascinating image indeed!
- * Before boarding the coach for our return to Casablanca we have some free time for some ***shopping in a typical Berber Pharmacy****.
- * This excursion lasts approximately 12 hours, of which 8 hours are spent travelling by coach.
- * As this excursion is conducted mainly on foot, you are advised to wear comfortable shoes.

- Moulay Idriss Mausoleum
- Kairouyine Mosque

The programme

- We cross the rolling landscape of the Moroccan countryside by coach to reach the city of **Fez**. If we had to choose one city to visit in the whole of Morocco, our choice would certainly fall on Fez for its architectural treasures, its charming medina, its magnificent monuments and its fascinating history, all of which make it the cultural capital of the country. A religious, intellectual and artistic metropolis and cradle of a millenarian monarchy, Fez was the political capital of the empire for a long time.
- Once inside the medieval city having passed through the monumental **Bab Bou Jeloud Gate**, with its glazed tiles reflecting the sun, we are immersed in a world where the pace of life is far removed from that of the modern world: artisans at work using original tools, women baking bread in public ovens, weavers at the loom using methods consolidated by tradition over the centuries, and the donkeys, which are the only means of transport allowed inside the medina, carrying all sorts of goods.
- We visit the **Bou Inania Madrasa**, the largest and most elaborate in Fez, built at the behest of Sultan Abou Inan, with its magnificent marble and onyx courtyard.
- Inside the **Mnebhi Palace**, one of the most refined palaces of the medina whose terrace commands a fine panorama of the surrounding area, we are served a typical Moroccan **lunch**.
- We proceed on our visit by venturing into the maze of alleys of the medina, with its thousand and one curiosities and sensations, where each **Souk** is specialized for a different trade or for specific products: the Attarine Souk is dedicated to spices, the Nejarine Souk is for carpenters, **Seffarine Square** is full of blacksmiths and the Dyers Souk is full of colourful skeins of dyed silk, hung to dry in

the sun. Accompanied by our guide we explore the most fascinating souk in Fez, the Hunters Souk, which is announced by a strong pungent smell of animal skins. We can observe the extraordinary traditional dyeing of skins in large vats from a panoramic terrace.

- Our excursion proceeds with the **Mausoleum of Moulay Idriss**, the founder of the millenarian city of Fez, a holy city for Muslims. Through the main doorway which is decorated with brightly coloured wood, we can see the prayer hall with its numerous chandeliers and a surprising collection of clocks including two splendid pendulum clocks donated by the Sun King Louis IV.
- We walk around the **Kairouyine Mosque**, founded around the middle of the 9th century, and also the seat of a University that is believed to be the oldest in the world. The building is strictly off-limits for non-Muslims, however it is possible to catch a glimpse of the several precious treasured inside through the numerous doorways.
- We leave the medieval city passing by the **Saadian North Borj Fortress**, where there are a number of vista points in the vicinity for taking photos of the mysterious medina.
- Before setting off in the direction of Casablanca, we cut across the **Jewish quarter of Mellah**, stopping in front of the **Royal Palace**.

The programme

- We leave the port of Casablanca for a panoramic coach tour through the modern districts of the city which were built starting from the beginning of the 20th century according to an urban plan that was destined to transform the city and plan out its extraordinary growth.
- During one of the photo stops our guide takes us to see **Mohammed V Square**, the heart of the city and a modern Muslim architectural complex inspired by national traditions.
- We cut across the **Arab League Park** by coach and we drive along the **Moulay Youssef Boulevard**, one of the major thoroughfares of the city lined by elegant Art Deco and Neo-Moorish style houses.
- From here we reach the biggest mosque in the world after the one in Mecca: the **Hassan II Mosque**, which, according to the intentions of the king, symbolizes an Islam that is open to the world and to science. With a monumental 210-metre tall minaret, this mosque is a masterpiece of art and technology.
- Our tour proceeds through the wide avenues of the city centre where our guide shows us the **Casablanca Twin Centre**, a large post-modern complex comprising two 115-metre tall twin towers separated by an impressive marble staircase.
- We then go back to the seafront and drive along the **Corniche** past the trendiest clubs, elegant terraces, luxury hotels and well-equipped beach clubs, up to our **restaurant**. Here we are enchanted by the warm, cosy, romantic, almost sensual Moroccan atmosphere where nothing is left to chance, not even the excellent yet discreet service. Candles everywhere, Maghreb-style period decorations that are still popular today like the hand-painted inlaid ceramic art on the walls and ceilings creating an intimate atmosphere with the repetitive and relaxing rhythm of a fountain decorated with a thousand and one coloured tiles. We are embraced by the aromas and flavours of authentic **local cuisine** served in Limoges plates, whose secret lies in a balanced combination of sweet and salty tastes and the clever use of delicate and varied spices and aromatic herbs. Our dinner is also accompanied by **Arabo-Andalusian music** and a performance of a **traditional dance**.

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- After dinner and some typical mint tea, the symbol par excellence of Moroccan hospitality, we board our coach again for our return journey along the Corniche with its lively night life. On the way back to the ship we have a last glimpse of the Hassan II Mosque, which, as the inhabitants of Casablanca say, and thanks to its magical flood lighting, looks like a divine creation resting on the ocean.
- Places on this excursion are limited. We recommend booking early .
- This excursion provides an overview of the locations and their main sights and does not include tours inside the mosque and the souk.
- Depending on the time of year, the tour may take place while it is still light.

- During our visit, we will head to the medina of Tetouan, one of the best preserved in Morocco and declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1997, where we can admire Bab El Okla, the city's eastern port and the Bab Okla school of art.
- Before returning to Tangier, we will have some free time to buy souvenirs from a local herbalist or bazar.

- Returning to the higher part of the city we walk along the typical narrow, steep streets until we reach **Main Street**, a famous pedestrianised shopping area. Here, depending on the participants' wishes, the driver can return to the ship or drop off those wishing to take advantage of the duty free shops in the city centre.

- We have lunch in a **typical restaurant** where we can savour **a few Iberian specialities** including *patatas bravas, ensaladilla rusa, corquetas, buñuelos* and *pulpo*... All these traditional delicacies cater to our palate every whim and perfect to nibble and share *para compartir* just the way the Spaniards do!
- After refuelling, we continue towards **Casa Vicens**, the first important project commissioned to Gaudí. Declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 2005, the modernist building combines Gothic, Mediterranean and Islamic elements while expressing the amateurish yet already unique style of the artist, who was looking for a *Gothic building full of light, which made use of colour; a Gothic that was half maritime, half continental*.
- Our excursion continues with a stop for photos at one of Gaudí's most famous works of art: **Casa Milà**. This monumental, eccentric and futuristic building - also known as *La Pedrera* * enabled the architect to break with all of the architectural rules of the time thereby sparking the rage of the municipal authorities and attracting the criticism of his colleagues while, at the same time, managing to create what went down in history as one of the most representative examples of his naturalist period and modernism in general.
- We then move on to the splendid **Barrio Gótico**, the historic city centre and vibrant hub of the Catalan capital. We take in this open-air museum and let ourselves be conquered by the timeless atmosphere which envelops its maze of alleyways.
- The central element of the Barrio Gótico and the maximum representation of the style the district is named after is Barcelona Cathedral, i.e. **Cathedral of the Holy Cross and Saint Eulalia**. With its stained glass windows and statues characterized by a more expressive and angular naturalism, it perfectly incarnates the archetype of Gothic architecture whose features inevitably invite observers to lift their gaze upwards and admire its beauty in its entirety.
- Our tour has come to an end but, before returning to the ship, we enjoy some **free time** to do a spot of shopping or stroll around the city centre while we remind ourselves of the incredible experience that has enabled us to fully experience this dynamic city.

- The best gateway into the world of Gaudì is **Parc Güell**, with all its curves and colors, designed at the beginning of the last century. You can expect **fairytale buildings**, a mosaic of a **giant salamander**, **forests of columns** and house with spiers where the architect himself lived for twenty years.
- But that's only the beginning. In the Eixample district is the church of the **Sagrada Família**, a gigantic building with an open construction site that is **constantly evolving**, as even today, decades later, expert craftsmen are still following the designs left by the master.
- **Casa Milà**, on the other hand, better known as **La Pedrera** is the master's most mature work and is considered the greatest example of Catalan Modernism. It's a great photo opportunity with its **undulating façades**, chimneys that wrap around themselves and **original cast iron railings** that evoke **breaking waves**.
- This is one of the most popular excursions so book early.
- Casa Milà will be closed on 12/25/2023, on 01/15/2024 and on 01/19/2024, therefore the visit will be carried out externally. The external visit of the Casa Batllò will also be added.
