ADVENTURE ALONG CAMINITO DEL REY

Let us defy the laws of gravity just like the first pioneers who built the incredible Caminito del Rey, with its kilometres of walkways pinned along the vertical walls between hydroelectric stations among scenarios of rare beauty.

- To facilitate communication and transport, a 5 km walkway only 1 metre wide and **rising as high as 100 metres above the river below**, pinned on practically vertical walls, was built. And it is precisely on this narrow structure, restored in 2015, that we will test our courage!
- Surrounded by **rugged nature**, we retrace the steps of the workers who first built Caminito del Rey and worked on these steep heights and discover interesting facts about the local flora and fauna as well as curious anecdotes concerning the pioneers.

- At last we are ready to visit the **botanical gardens** in the **Quinta do Bom Sucesso**, an estate that once belonged to the Reid family and is immersed in an area that boasts the ideal climatic conditions in which to grow luxuriant vegetation.
- Once back in **Funchal city centre**, we will visit the **market with its typical produce**: endless fruits, vegetables, flowers, fish and traditional artisan products.
- We will stop off at a **local handicraft shop**, where we can admire a range of typical lace products and taste the unmissable wines produced using the renowned local **Madeira** vine variety, thanks to which the island has achieved worldwide fame.
- The market is closed on Saturday afternoons, Sundays and on public holidays.
- The cable car is a popular attraction; you may encounter a delay.

- Streams of waters flow through the tunnel, so we recommend walking on the rocks not to get wet.

- A half an hour drive will take us to the lee side of the island regardless of the means of transport chosen (coach or boat).
- The village of **Wallilabou**, which we admire from the sea, looks familiar to anyone who watched Pirates of the Caribbean, as it was the set for the film. The village welcomes us with a series of dilapidated huts overlooking the bay and surrounded by vegetation that looks both protective and menacing at the same time. Beware! Captain Jack Sparrow may rush down from the mountain any time!
- At **Dark View**, we then admire a lovely 33 metre waterfall.
- After a small bamboo and rope bridge, we are welcomed by a landscape dotted with bamboo trees. The spectacular Dark View Falls gush down a rocky wall into a small natural pool where we can go for a dip and let ourselves be massaged by the cool water.
- An excursion to Saint Vincent would not be complete without a photo stop of the **Bat Cave**.
- During our boat ride, we can sunbathe or enjoy a swim or a dive.

- A **packed lunch** at a restaurant or eco-lodge on the beach is served during the visit.
- There is limited availability of English speaking guides.
- We recommend that you book early because only a limited number of places are available.
- Do not forget to bring snorkeling equipment.

Kingstown **KAYAKING AND SNORKELLING IN BYAHAUT COVE**

In a nutshell

- Following our guides, we paddle along the lush coast slipping through the crystal-clear Caribbean waters as far as the Bat Cave, where we can listen to the shrieks of its residents, and head out to Byahaut Cove for a swim and snorkel.
- **Byahaut Cove** can only be accessed by sea and was also the set for the film Pirates of the Caribbean. We admire the black cliffs overflowing with jungle creepers, frangipani and cactuses while warm waves hit the rocks.

- The spectacular coral reef is home to a myriad of plant and animal species such as yellow or orange tube sponges, purple sea fan and shoals of colourful fish.
- Finally, we return to Buccament bay on our kayak before heading back to the port of Kingstown.

- We move on to **Princess Margaret Beach** to relax on the beach and go for a swim. The beach was named after the Queen's sister who chose it for her honeymoon in 1960 and is an unspoilt place dotted with yachts and a wooden pier perfect for diving.
- The time has come to reluctantly leave Bequia and head back to Saint Vincent.
- We recommend that you book early because only a limited number of places are available.
- Safety and trip information will be provided by the crew in English.
- Do not forget to bring swimwear, a towel, sunglasses and sun cream.

- Before we leave, we will have the chance to see and take photos of the locomotive changing direction as it is linked to the opposite end of the carriages for the return journey.
- At the train's double whistle, we will get back into the carriage and descend back down the hill, admiring **breathtaking views of the north coast of the island and the sleepy rural villages** in the area.
- When we reach **the station**, we will have **free time to visit the souvenir shop and buy a few things**, including rum and sugar-based products produced and only sold here.
- After shopping, we will **return to the port by coach**, stopping for **photos at the Morgan Lewis Mill**, the largest remaining windmill in Barbados, which dominates the **stunning views of the Atlantic coast**.

- The light which filters through the limestone walls renders this amazing **underground world** even more magical.
- We are surrounded by thousands of **stalagmites and stalactites**, some of which have joined to form columns, **natural waterfalls and crystal clear lakes** : a unique natural spectacle.
