DISCOVER THE MARVELLOUS NORWAY: HIKE AND TRAIN

Description

Amid snowy mountains and deep gorges: a unique opportunity to immerse yourself in Norway's spectacular landscapes aboard the famous Flåm Railway before discovering the beauty of nature on foot.

What we will see




- Flåm
- Flåm Railway
- Spectacular landscapes
- Vatnahalsen
- Blomheller or Berekvam

What we will do

- We will set off from **Flåm**, a village with 450 inhabitants that takes its name from the ancient Norwegian word *flå*, which means 'plain' and refers to the flood plains of the River Flåm.
- The **Flåm Railway**, or Flåmsbana, is one of the world's steepest railways: 80% of its length has a gradient of 5.5%. We will admire spectacular sights, steep mountains and thundering waterfalls as we pass through 20 tunnels, captivated by the variety of the landscapes. National Geographic has named the Flåmsbana one of the world's ten most picturesque train rides, while Lonely Planet described it as the most beautiful of all in 2014.
- On arrival at **Vatnahalsen** (Aurland Valley) station, we will begin our walk up river towards **Blomheller** (approx. 7 km) or **Berekvam** (approx 9 km). As we walk, we will literally be surrounded by the wonderful natural paradise of the fjords.

- As soon as we arrive in Blomheller (or Berekvam), we will board a train back to the port of Flåm.

MARVELLOUS TVINDE WATERFALL AND THE SECRETS OF THE VIKING CIVILIZATION
Description
What we will see

- Unique Aurlandsfjord landscape
- Nærøy valley, from its river to the waterfall accompanying us along the way
- Oppheim lake and spectacular Tvinde waterfall
- Beautiful Nærøyfjord
- Viking village of Gudvangen




What we will do

- We set off on our excursion by coach from **Flåm**, a lovely colourful town at the tip of **Aurlandsfjord**, one of the branches of the second largest fjord in the world – **Sognefjord**.
- Two **long tunnels**, the longest of which measures over 9 km, take us to the opposite side of the mountain where we drive through the **ancient Viking village of Gudvangen** and along **Nærøy valley** and its river famous for **salmon fishing** accompanied by the breathtaking views of the **waterfalls** on both sides of the road.
- Only a few km separate from the green shores of **lake Oppheim**, then we venture into the woods and fertile countryside taking us to the spectacular **Tvinde waterfall** where the water drops from a rocky wall approximately 110 metres high.
- We stop to photograph this marvel of nature and return to **Gudvangen** winding along the 13 hairpin bends of the steepest road in Norway dating back to 1849 – the famous **Stalheimskeiva**.
- Once in **Gudvangen**, we stop to discover this enchanting town on the shores of **Nærøyfjord**, the fjord dedicated to Njord, god of the sea and prosperity according to Norse mythology. It was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 2005 due to its **outstanding natural beauty**.
- We head to the **Viking community** village displaying the habits and traditions of this centuries-old culture. A true journey into

the past allowing the most fearless visitors to try their hand at **axe throwing or archery** and the most curious to chat with the locals.

- At the end of our excursion, we get back to our coach and to Flåm.

NÆRØYFJORD BOAT TRIP AND STALHEIM

Description

A thrilling trip that takes us along the Nærøyfjord by boat, through the picturesque villages of Gudvangen and Stalheim, where time seems to stand still, then into the surrounding steep mountains up which the breathtaking roads struggle to climb. An adventure not to be missed!

What we will see


- Aurlandsfjord and Nærøyfjord
- Village of Gudvangen
- Valley of Nærøy and the Stalheimskleiva road

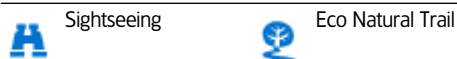
What we will do

- We will leave from Flåm, on one of the inner branches of the Sognefjord (which, extending more than 200 km inland, is the longest fjord in Norway), and travel the inner edge of the **Aurlandsfjord** by boat. The word "fjord" is of Norwegian origin and indicates a marine cove of glacial origin that is usually narrow, with steep shorelines that extend below sea level.
- We will then continue along the **Nærøyfjord** which, due to its geological features and the incomparable beauty of its natural landscape, was made a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 2005. We will move slowly on across the fjord, which is 17 km in length and roughly 500 m deep, and surrounded by the steep slopes of the mountains (up to 1400 metres), passing waterfalls and navigating narrow sections (the narrowest measures 250 metres).
- Having reached the edge of the fjord, we will disembark in the small **village of Gudvangen**, where we will board a coach.
- Our tour continues through the **Nærøy valley**, descending down thirteen steep hairpin bends along the **Stalheimskleiva road**. Approximately 1.5 km in length and built in 1849, the road is flanked on both sides by a series of waterfalls.

- After a stop to admire the view of the wide valley below, we will return to Flåm, retracing the Nærøy valley and crossing a long series of tunnels.
- Places on this excursion are limited. We recommend booking early.
- This excursion is not recommended for guests who suffer from seasickness or guests with mobility problems.
- The boat has seats inside and outside; in the event of inclement weather, you are advised to bring a raincoat and wear appropriate clothing.
- In the event of adverse weather conditions the Stalheimskleiva road may be closed. In this case the tunnel road will be used in both directions.

AURLAND VALLEY AND ØSTERBØ
Description

A fantastic tour through one of Norway's most beautiful valleys, the Aurlandsdalen, known as the "Norwegian Grand Canyon" due to its natural landscapes. It is impossible not to be impressed by its fjords and mountains.

What we will see

- Aurland: Gothic church
- Lake and village of Vassbygda: power lines
- Laavisdal
- Valley of Stonndalen
- Valley of Aurland
- Østerbø: farm and refreshments

What we will do

- We will start our coach tour by leaving the port at Flåm and skirting the fjords all the way to **Aurland**, a typical coastal town with a wonderful stone **Gothic church** from the 13th century, with windows painted by Norwegian artist Emanuel Vigeland.
- From Aurland we climb the river of the same name - known for its abundance of salmon - and, having passed the **Vassbygda**

lake, we reach the **village** of the same name. Hydroelectric power is produced here, as you might deduct from the many **power lines**. The generators are located inside the mountain.

- The road that takes us even higher, up to **Laavisdal**, comprises hairpin bends and tunnels, giving us a magnificent view of Vassbygda and the region of Aurland.
- We climb further, to **Stonndalen**, a spectacular wide mountain valley typical of western Norway.
- Finally we will reach the **Aurland valley** which, with its breathtaking natural landscape, is known as the 'Norwegian Grand Canyon' and is one of the country's most famous tourist routes. The valley, from Geiteryggen to Vassbygdi, is roughly 40 km in length and varies between 50 and 1660 metres above sea level. Along the way, we will admire the spectacular scenery, which is rich in flora and fauna.
- We will cross the valley to **Østerbø**, a small farm that was inhabited until the end of the 1920s. During the winter, a season that could last from six to eight months in this region, the **farm** was totally cut off from the rest of the world.
- At Østerbø we will enjoy **refreshments**, before taking the same road back to Flåm.
- Places on this excursion are limited. We recommend booking early.

FLÅM, VOSS AND STALHEIM

Description

An unforgettable train tour through the villages of Flåm, Voss and Stalheim, crossing the wild and untouched landscape of fjords, lakes and valleys to admire the spectacular Norwegian scenery from a truly unique perspective.






What we will see

- Flåm, Kjosfossen waterfall, Myrdal
- Gravhalsen Tunnel, Raundalen valley, Lake Vangs
- Voss, the Tvinde waterfall, Oppheim lake
- Stalheim and Stalheimskleiva road, Nærøy river

What we will do

- We depart by train from the picturesque village of **Flåm**, at the tip of the Aurlandsfjord, and begin one of the most thrilling and spectacular tours of Norway. The train will slowly take us through some evocative scenery, stopping close to the marvellous **Kjosfossen waterfall** - roughly 220 metres high - and giving us chance to take some photos.
- After a 45-minute trip, during which we will experience an altitude change of 800 metres, we reach the station of **Myrdal**, located on the main Oslo-Bergen line.
- At Myrdal station we will take another train, through the **Gravhalsen tunnel** and down towards the **Raundalen valley**, to Voss. Immersed in breathtaking surroundings close to **Lake Vangs, Voss** is a renowned all-year-round tourist destination. Its position and the many activities that one can enjoy (rafting, paragliding, etc.) have given it a reputation, internationally, as Norway's adventure capital.
- Leaving the train, we will continue on by coach to the **Tvinde waterfall** that drops down the side of the mountain; we will then reach the **Oppheim Lake** before continuing on to **Stalheim**. Between 1647 and 1909, the village of Stalheim was a resting place for travellers taking the Royal Postal Road between Copenhagen, Christiania (Oslo) and Bergen. In 1780, a road for horses and carriages was constructed and Stalheim became the resting place for postmen who would rest and change their horses after climbing the valley.
- We will then take the **Stalheimskleiva**, the country's steepest road, which was built in 1849. Roughly 1.5 km in length, the road boasts 13 spectacular, steep hairpin bends and is flanked by wonderful waterfalls on each side.
- As we return to the ship, we travel alongside the salmon-rich **Nærøy river**, crossing two long tunnels.

STALHEIM AND UNDREDAL
Description
What we will see

- Gudvangen and Nærøyfjord
- Nærøy valley and river
- Village of Stalheim and Stalheim Hotel photo break
- Stalheimskleiva Road and Undredal village

What we will do

- We leave from the picturesque village of Flåm, at the tip of the Aurlandsfjord, and head for the other side of the mountain and the Viking village of **Gudvangen**, which is located at the tip of the **Nærøyfjord**. This fjord, roughly 17 km in length, is part of the larger Sognefjord and is considered to be the most spectacular branch of this fjord. The Nærøyfjord is also the world's narrowest fjord. At one point it measures only 250 m and is surrounded by 1800 m high mountains that loom over its tranquil waters. In 2005 it was made a UNESCO World Heritage Site along with Geirangerfjord, together with which it was also elected by National Geographic as the world's most significant natural heritage site.
- After taking a photo break, we will continue along the **Nærøy valley**, following the salmon-rich **river of the same name**, and pushing on to **Stalheim** on the side of the mountain. Between 1647 and 1909, the village of Stalheim was a resting place for travellers taking the Royal Postal Road between Copenhagen, Christiania (Oslo) and Bergen. In 1780, a road for horses and carriages was constructed and Stalheim became the resting place for postmen who would rest and change their horses after climbing the valley. From Stalheim we can enjoy a breathtaking view of the Nærøy valley and the surrounding mountain range. We will stop at the **Stalheim Hotel** to take a **photo break**.
- On our way back to the ship, at Flåm, we will take the **Stalheimskleiva**, the country's steepest road, which was built in 1849. Roughly 1.5 km in length, the road boasts 13 spectacular, steep hairpin bends and is flanked by wonderful waterfalls on each side.
- Before returning to Flåm, we will visit the splendid **village of Undredal**, renowned for its long tradition of producing goats cheese, both fresh and mature. Undredal has a population of 80 and boasts Scandinavia's smallest wooden church.
- Places on this excursion are limited. We recommend booking early.
- In the event of adverse weather conditions the Stalheimskleiva road may be closed. In this case the tunnel road will be used in both directions.

THE FLÅM RAILWAY AND A CYCLE TOUR THROUGH THE FJORDS
Description

A unforgettable tour along the famous Flåm railway line – an engineering masterpiece – to admire some of Norway's wildest and most spectacular views, with rivers that cut through impressive gorges, rolling waterfalls that skim the steep sides of the mountains and villages perched on rocky outcrops: prepare for the spectacle of nature in all its grandeur!

What we will see

- Flåm railway station, train trip along the banks of the River Flåm, Rjoandefossen Falls, Mount Vibmesnosi
- Nali, Myrdalsberg, four levels of railway
- the Kjosfossen waterfall, Myrdal, Berekvam station
- By bike to Flåm

What we will do

- We will start our excursion by taking a train from **Flåm station**, on a level with the Aurlandfjord. The Flåm railway is one of the world's most interesting engineering masterpieces. The line measures only 20 km in length, leaves from the station of Flåm at sea level and reaches Myrdal station, at a height of 867 m, offering some of Norway's wildest and most spectacular views.
- On board the **train**, we skirt the **banks of the river Flåm**, known as one of the best rivers for salmon fishing in the west of the country. As we pass, we will see, on the right hand side, the characteristic **Rjoandefossen falls**, which boast a 140 m perpendicular drop, and the impressive peak of **mount Vibmesnosi**, which is 1269 m in height.
- Having passed through the longest tunnel in the **Nali** area, we find a fantastic panorama opening up before our eyes. To climb the 300m of the **Myrdalsberg**, the **line** is composed of **four levels**. From this point, as the train stops on line four, we can admire the other three lines. We will also be able to see the old road that was built between 1895–96 at the same time as the construction of the Bergen–Oslo railway line, which was inaugurated in 1909. The line climbs three bristly hills, covering 21 hairpin bends before reaching a beautiful waterfall. We will then take a brief break close to the **Kjosfossen waterfall**, getting off the train for a moment to photograph the 93 m drop of the falls (with a total height of 220 m).
- During the trip the train will slowly descend towards the most interesting view points. We will cover the whole track to **Myrdal**,




the final station on the route at 867 m above sea level, before returning to **Berekvam station**, approximately half way from Flåm station.

- Here we will leave the train and take **bicycles** on **towards Flåm**. The descent by bike is via a narrow gravel track along the river banks, with spectacular views of the falls, mountains and valleys. If we want, we can fill our water bottles directly from the river, before continuing along the path.

EXCURSION BY RIB-BOAT TO THE ISLAND OF RØVÆR
Description

An exciting, intense excursion by RIB-boat to the island of Røvær, amidst uncontaminated nature, stories of daily life of its inhabitants and their great knowledge of the sea, the main source of sustenance for all Norwegians, from the times of the Vikings to the current era of oil.

What we will see

- Tour of the island of Røvær
- Tasting of a flavoursome fish soup

What we will do

- This excursion takes us to the **island of Røvær** which lies approximately 10 km north west of Haugesund, in the Norwegian county of Rogaland.
- There is a regular maritime transport express service between Røvær, the island near Feøy and the town of Haugesund.
- Many residents of the island also have a private boat with a car parked in Haugesund which they use on the mainland.
- The island of Røvær, or rather the islands which make up the archipelago of the same name, extend for 1.4 km and have about 100 permanent residents (data of 2014), as well as seasonal residents and visitors who rent holiday homes or stay at the Røvær Seahouse (Røvær Sjøhus) or at the more recent Røvær Culture Hotel (Røvær Kulturhotell).
- The permanent residents who are not retired practise agriculture, fishing, work on the ferries, teach at the local island school, work on the salmon farms or are commuters to the mainland. During our visit to the island, we'll be able to **try a tasty fish soup** before returning to Haugesund.

This excursion takes place aboard a 4-seater helicopter.

The pilot reserves the right to cancel the flight at any point in the event of poor weather.

We recommend that you book early because only a limited number of places are available.

A HELICOPTER ADVENTURE TO THE PULPIT ROCK
Description

Get ready for one of the most exhilarating experiences of your life as we explore Haugesund and the surrounding region by helicopter!

We set off to the airport, steeling ourselves **for one of the most thrilling experiences we’ve ever had.**

From our vantage point, high in the sky, we admire the splendid landscape of the Haugesund region, from beaches of white sand, the Langfoss waterfall, steep mountainsides and scenic viewpoints to the luxuriant countryside and the sea, which stretches as far as the eye can see.

However, the real highlight of our helicopter ride is the Preacher’s Pulpit (Preikestolen), a flat-topped rock formation that extends 30 metres out from a granite wall above a sheer, 600-metre drop to the fjord. It is one of the most visited locations in Norway and it is not difficult to see why.

This excursion takes place aboard a 4-seater helicopter.

The pilot reserves the right to cancel the flight at any point in the event of poor weather.

We recommend that you book early because only a limited number of places are available.

VISIT TO THE ARQUEBUS WAR MUSEUM
Description

A unique excursion through history and the present day, ideal for those who love the mountains but want to see more than just the countryside: from the most spectacular landscapes the Norwegian fjords have to offer to a museum dedicated to the Second World War.

What we will see

- The city of Haugesund and the pristine surrounding countryside
- The Arquebus War Museum
- The Steinsfjellet viewpoint
- The Haraldshaugen national monument

What we will do

- This scenic excursion takes us on a journey exploring the area east of the coastal town of **Haugesund**. Along with its spectacular natural landscape, Haugesund boasts a unique and fascinating history: not only was the Statue of Liberty made using copper from one of its mines, but it can also claim to be the original “fatherland” of Marilyn Monroe, whose grandfather worked locally as a baker before emigrating to the United States. Not bad for a town that was only recognised as a separate municipality in 1854!
- The highlight of our time in Haugesund is a visit to the **Arquebus War Museum** (Arquebus Krigshistorisk Museum). Located in the inner stretch of the Førresfjord, this museum brings to life various events associated with the Second World War, from the everyday lives of local people, the merchant navy’s contribution to the war effort, defence operations and the 1940 invasion, the enemy positions along the coast, the liberation, the fall of Berlin in 1945, and the allied victory in Europe. During our visit, we learn all sorts of fascinating details. For instance, the word Arquebus comes from the code name adopted by a local resistance fighter for communications made using a clandestine radio transmitter. The museum is the largest in Norway, with over 2,000 m of exhibit space housed in an old farm building. The exhibits include manikins dressed in genuine uniforms and historical costumes.
- Following our visit to the museum, we make our way to the **Steinsfjellet viewpoint** which, at 227 metres above sea level, and with breathtaking views of Haugesund and the surrounding area, is a favourite spot among locals for walks and trips to the country.
- The next stop is at the **Haraldshaugen**, a national monument erected in 1872 to commemorate the thousand-year anniversary of the Battle of Hafrsfjord, which was fought and won by King Harald Hårfagre (Harald Fairhair) at Hafrsfjord near Stavanger in 872, leading to the unification of Norway. Harald Hårfagre established his court at Avaldsnes, on the nearby island of Karmøy, while the monument stands at a location believed to be the site of his burial, about 3 km north of the centre of Haugesund.
- We are bound by the timetable set by the local operator, which is communicated to the ship the day prior to the excursion depending on the different language options required. As such, we are unable to make changes to the excursion timetable.

This excursion in the Åkrafjorden offers a combination of natural beauty and art, with the Langfoss waterfall – the fifth-highest in Norway – steep mountain slopes, rich pastures, the still, silent fjords and famous artist Unni Marie.

- A boat will be waiting to whisk us across the blue waters of the fjord to the base of this natural wonder which, according to legend, has mysterious powers that can boost fertility.
- We disembark, then, at Eljarvik Farm – where we risk remaining spellbound by the breathtaking view of the falls – and enjoy a delicious lunch before boarding our coach once again.
- Our next stop is Ølen where we make a brief visit to Unni Marie Rosemaling, a one-of-a-kind structure that houses a tourist information office, a small shop and a workshop.
- Here, we find something rather unique waiting for us: Unni Marie is an internationally renowned artist who specialises in rosemaling (painting images of roses), a traditional art form in Norway that is on display both on the outside of the building and in the shop, where numerous items are available for purchase.
- We also visit the charming garden at the back of the house, which is tended by Unni Marie herself who, it turns out, also has green fingers.
- Our excursion has nearly reached its end, but it has one more treat in store, as we enjoy a little free time and a sightseeing tour of Haugesund.

- We will set off from the port by coach through the lush agricultural landscape to **Ullandhaug**, an area famous for its reconstructions of Iron Age farms. Ullandhaug also boasts breath-taking views of the **Hafrsfjord** where, in 872, the Viking king Harald Fairhair defeated the last of the local princes and unified 29 small kingdoms under one crown, founding the Kingdom of Norway. To the east stretches the fertile **landscape of Jæren**, with the **Ryfylke Mountains** in the distance.
- We will then continue to the outskirts of Stavanger to admire the **Sverd i fjell ('Swords in Rock')**, a fascinating memorial by the sculptor Fritz Røed. The monument depicts three 10 metre-high swords that commemorate the historic battle of Hafrsfjord. The largest sword represents the victorious Harald, while the smaller ones symbolise the vanquished kings. The monument is also intended to symbolise peace, as the swords are struck in solid rock, from which they can never be removed.
- We will now pass through both the older and more modern districts of Stavanger; we will admire the inside of the **Cathedral**, built in around 1125 by Bishop Reinald of Winchester with the help of British craftsmen. Of all the churches built in Norway during the Middle Ages, Stavanger Cathedral is the only one that still retains its original features.
- Before returning to the ship, we will treat ourselves to a walk through 'Old Stavanger', with its typical narrow streets lined with picturesque wooden houses that date back to the 18th and 19th centuries, a time when it was home to sailors, craftsmen and merchants. This unique area, located just a few minutes from the port, is now at the centre of the city's most ambitious redevelopment project.
- Places on this excursion are limited. We recommend booking early.
- During religious functions the visit to the cathedral will only be a tour of the exterior.

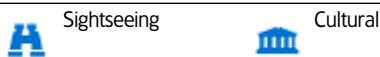

- At the end of the magnificent Avenyn boulevard, we come across another **famous square: Götaplatsen**, inaugurated in 1923 on the occasion of an international fair to celebrate the 300th anniversary of the founding of the city. The square represents the cultural hub of the city with its Auditorium, Art Museum, Theatre and Municipal library. At the centre of the square, we admire the majestic **bronze statue of Poseidon** by Carl Milles and one of the city's symbols.
- We continue our tour exploring the **district hosting events** of all kind such as the **Svenska Mässan exhibition and congress centre**, the gigantic **Liseberg amusement park** filled with thrilling attractions suitable for all ages and visited every year by around 3 million people and the **Ullevi Stadion** built for the 1958 Football World Cup of and now home to the local team, IFK Göteborg. This magnificent multi-purpose stadium can hold 43,000 spectators during football matches and 75,000 for concerts and shows.
- The itinerary continues with an interesting visit to **Masthuggskyrkan**, a **church** built in 1914 in the Swedish Romantic style and one of the city's symbols as well as a popular tourist attractions thanks to its incredible vantage point.
- After visiting the church, we continue towards the **Haga district**, renowned for its **picturesque wooden houses, its 19th-century atmosphere and its many cafés**. It started off as a suburb inhabited by the working class but it evolved over the years to become one of the most popular destinations for both tourists and locals, especially after many buildings were refurbished or rebuilt during the 1980s.
- After our visit to Haga, we have some free time available before returning to the ship.

What we will see

What we will do

- We start our tour by reaching **Fjärås Bräcka**, a 4 km-long ridge formed as the ice retreated between 12,000 and 13,000 years ago and now one of the country's most impressive and important **glacial formations**.
- Fjärås Bräcka is famous for its **Iron Age cemetery** located on the edge of its ridge featuring **hundreds of ancient gravestones**. From here we can also admire amazing views of the surrounding scenery.
- Our itinerary continues to a magnificent peninsula in the Kungsbacka fjord, location of the marvellous **Tjolöholm castle**, built between 1898 and 1904 by James Fredrik and Blanche Dickson in a perfect **Elizabethan style** on a design by the architect Lars Israel Wahlman. Before entering the castle, our guide provides us with some general information on the building and its fascinating architecture.
- While the **façade** presents typical 16th-century and **Tudor** elements, the **interior** is a splendid example of **Art Nouveau** and William Morris style.
- Despite the many fireplaces, the building is heated by a hot air pipe system. The three bathrooms were, at the time, equipped with showers and sunken bathtubs and the property had its own power generator, making the project very modern.
- After visiting the interior of the castle and before returning to the ship, we have some **free time** available to explore and admire the **amazing garden and exterior**.

- We start our tour along the coast heading north towards the **city of Kungälv**, located on the estuary of the river Göta and made famous by the historical peace meeting between the three Swedish kings in 1100.
- We cross this enchanting city along **Västra Gatan**, a characteristic road flanked by **typical colourful wooden houses** and listen to the narration illustrating the history of these places, of their kings and various battles.
- The itinerary then continues north-west towards the North Sea. A short coach transfer takes us across the **Tjörnbron bridge** connecting the **island of Tjörn** with the mainland and where many **fishing communities** live.
- The first stop on our tour takes us to the picturesque **fishing village of Klädesholmen**, famous all over Sweden for its **herring production** which started off stored in containers and small barrels towards the end of the 1800s.
- Nowadays, almost half of the pickled herrings in Sweden comes from Klädesholmen, where there is also a small herring museum. The village is made up of two small islands and it is a truly enchanting place with its wooden red and white painted houses, a harbour and many fishing boats.
- We continue across this lovely island as far as another characteristic **fishing village** nestled among the rocks and directly overlooking the North Sea: **Skärhamn**. With its 3000 inhabitants, it is the main settlement on the island. The walk along the pier towards the commercial harbour is truly wonderful.
- The village of Skärhamn is also famous for its **Nordic Watercolour Museum** which is built on stilts among the rocks smoothed by the water and characterised by large windows overlooking the surrounding sea. Inside, the permanent collection and temporary exhibitions are dedicated to international watercolour artists and it also features a research and teaching centre for watercolour techniques.
- At the end of the visit, we return to Göteborg and the ship.

- Marstrand was already known in the past as an important trading centre and the base for the Swedish fleet and can now be defined as a summer holiday paradise due to its **numerous beaches, natural landscapes, restaurants and cafés, small shops and the Strandverket contemporary art gallery**. But the island still shows traces of its ancient times, such as some caves dating back to the Stone Age.
- During our visit, we go for a **stroll along the picturesque alleyways** to admire the **typical wooden houses** and various sights such as the 19th-century building where King Oscar II used to throw luxurious parties.
- We then head to the higher part of the island with the imposing **Carlstens fortress**, built on the request of Charles X Gustav of Sweden after the Treaty of Roskilde concluded in 1658 that handed back the Bohuslän region, and therefore also the island of Marstrand (previously under Danish-Norwegian rule) to Sweden. Over the centuries, the castle was taken twice, but it was always handed back to the heirs of Charles X through long negotiations and peace treaties.
- We then visit the fortress and admire its **massive walls, bastions and towers** offering amazing views of the coast and archipelago islands as well as on the hundreds of boats taking part in numerous international sailing and racing events.
- After visiting the fortress, we return to the ship.

- We begin our sightseeing tour of Göteborg by admiring its most famous sights such as the **Opera House**, a majestic Post-Modern building overlooking the water, the **Chalmers University of Technology** with its 13 departments founded in 1829 by William Chalmers, director of the Swedish East India Company, the **Gustav Adolf square**, hub of the public life, seat of the Town Hall and named after the 17th-century Swedish king and great leader who founded Göteborg, and the **Avenyn boulevard**, the shopping street brimming with life and boasting many pubs, restaurants and fashionable shops and filled with street artists entertaining the tourists as well as the locals.
- Our guide also shows us other more hidden sights but just as interesting and true symbols of the city.
- Among them, we see the **Feskekôrka**, whose name in Swedish means “fish church” and which derives from the fact that the building looks like a Gothic Revival church. It is in fact an **indoor fish market** overlooking the canal and looks just like a church. It also features many **restaurants and delis** where we can savour the typical products of the western coast (lobsters, prawns, oysters and shrimp).
- We continue our itinerary by admiring the **granite fountain** by Tore Strindberg located in the centre of **Järntorget square** inside a square pedestal. It features **5 female sculptures representing the five Continents**.
- The next stop takes us to the **Skansen Kronan fortress**, surrounded by 23 cannons and built during the second half of the 17th century with a defensive function against the Danish attack from the south. The fortress is now a private facility used for congresses as well as for events and weddings.
- After visiting the fortress, we **stop briefly for photos** near the **Röda Sten art gallery** (meaning “red stone” in Swedish), a famous centre for contemporary art located in an old industrial district under the Älvsborg bridge. Its name derives from the nearby red varnished stones and the gallery is divided into four levels hosting temporary exhibitions and events.
- We then reach the famous **Götaplatsen**, inaugurated in 1923 on the occasion of an international fair to celebrate the 300th anniversary of the founding of the city. At the centre of the square, which is the city's cultural hub, we admire the majestic **bronze statue of Poseidon** by Carl Milles.
- We then have some **free time for lunch** and to discover the wide range of **products local shops** have to offer.
- One last stop awaits us after our lunch and shopping break and before returning to the ship: a stroll in the company of our guide around the **Haga district**, renowned for its **picturesque houses made partly of brick and partly of wood, its 19th-century**

atmosphere and its many cafés. It was born as a suburb inhabited by the working class but it evolved over the years to become one of the most popular destinations with both tourists and locals, especially after many buildings were refurbished or rebuilt during the 1980s.

- The second stop on our tour is **Amalienborg Palace**, comprising four identical buildings; this has been the **principal seat of the Danish royal family** since 1794. It is guarded by soldiers in traditional bearskin hats and is also home to the **statue of King Frederick V** on horseback, depicted as a Roman emperor and considered one of the most important equestrian statues in the world. We visit the palace main square and enjoy a little free time.
- We make our way through the district of **Nyhavn** and then proceed to see some of the city's most important landmarks, including **the Stock Exchange and Christiansborg Palace**. The latter is located on Slotsholmen, Island, fittingly nicknamed the 'Island of Power' which houses the country's main political institutions: the Parliament (Folketing), the Supreme Court and the government offices (to the south and east), as well as the state rooms of the former Royal Apartments (north wing).
