Description

An excursion dedicated entirely to Matera, the so-called '*città dei Sassi*' (literally 'city of stones', its cave dwellings being dug out of the rock), which was declared both a UNESCO World Heritage Site and European capital of culture for 2019, to discover its exceptional historical, artistic and cultural heritage and its wholesome, authentic folk.

What we will see

- Alleys and dwellings dug out of limestone
- 'Sassi' and rock-hewn churches with frescoes

OLD BARI AND THE NEW CITY: TWO FACES OF THE SAME CITY

Description

A tour exploring Bari and discovering its hidden treasures, passing from the old historic centre to the modern part of the city, visiting the main monuments along the way and ending with a pleasant walk along the famous seafront promenade.

What we will see

- The historic centre of Bari: Basilica of Saint Nicholas and Church of Saint Gregory
- Norman-Swabian Castle (external visit)
- The New City

What we will do

- This tour takes us to the beautiful historical centre of Bari to visit its 'treasures'. We start with the **Basilica of Saint Nicholas** - built in the Apulian Romanesque style during the Norman domination - where the relics of the famous patron saint of the city

are preserved, followed by a tour of the exterior of the **Church of Saint Gregory**. Built during the 10th and 11th centuries, its interior is divided into three naves which lead to three apses.

- The tour proceeds with a visit of the exterior of the famous **Castello Normanno-Svevo (Norman-Swabian Castle)**, a defensive bulwark of the old town that has come to symbolise the whole city. Built by the Normans in the 12th century, it was destroyed in 1156 and rebuilt at the behest of Frederick II between 1233 and 1240. The manor is one of the most interesting fortifications in the region, above all because of its strategic location. The castle, which is a fascinating example of a medieval construction, has numerous extensions that were built in successive periods. Today it hosts occasional events and temporary exhibitions.
- Once we leave the old part of the city we move to the **città nuova** (the new city) where we have some free time to explore the surroundings as we please. We then go for a walk along the seafront promenade, Bari's pride and joy, which features numerous imposing buildings from the 1930s.
- The visit to the old city involves walking for approximately 2 hours.
- Dress code that is appropriate for the places of worship to be visited is recommended.
- This excursion is not recommended for guests with mobility problems.

THE 'TRULLI' OF ALBEROBELLO

Description

A great opportunity to visit Alberobello's famous "*trulli*", traditional, cylindrical buildings that are unique to this region and have seen part of the town declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site. We can immerse ourselves in the magical atmosphere of the old rural tradition that exudes from every nook and cranny of this fairytale setting.

What we will see

- The Trulli of Alberobello
- The "Monti" and "Aia Piccola" quarters of the town
- Tasting typical local products

What we will do

- We leave Bari by coach and we reach **Alberobello**, a picturesque town in the *Murge* area known the world over for its **trulli**, the typical domed, cylindrical white dwellings that have earned two districts of the town a place on the **UNESCO list of World Heritage Sites**. Trulli - which are typical of the *Itria* valley - are still used as houses today. They are modular dwellings with a roughly circular plan with internal rooms distributed around a central space. The thickness of the walls and the almost total absence of windows ensures an optimal thermal equilibrium; warm in winter and cool in summer.
- Accompanied by a local guide we visit the two most typical *rioni* (neighbourhoods) of Alberobello: **Rione Monti** - which covers about 15 hectares in the southern part of town - where there are about 1000 *trulli* arranged in 8 delightful streets, and used mainly for tourist accommodation and as artisan workshops, and the **Rione Aia Piccola** in the south-eastern part of town, where there are about 400 *trulli* used exclusively as residential dwellings ('Aia Piccola' is Italian for little barnyard, and refers to a space once used for the threshing of wheat). We have some free time here for shopping.
- Before returning to Bari there is another stop to **taste some typical local products**.
- The transfer to Alberobello takes approximately 1 hour each way.
- It is recommended to wear comfortable shoes.
- This excursion is not recommended for guests with mobility problems.
- In case of heavy traffic, the excursion may last longer.

'CASTEL DEL MONTE' AND THE BASILICA OF ST. NICHOLAS
Description

An unmissable opportunity to see two of the most precious jewels of Italian architecture, the Basilica of St. Nicholas in Bari and the *Castel del Monte*, in one excursion, retracing the events that have left a mark on the history of these fascinating, mysterious places.

What we will see

- Basilica of St. Nicholas
- *Castel del Monte*

What we will do

- Our excursion, which includes a visit to two of the finest examples of Italian architecture, starts at the **Basilica of Saint Nicholas**, which was built in the Apulian Romanesque style during the Norman domination. It is here that the relics of the city's famous patron saint are preserved. Its construction dates back to the year 1087 AD when, following the legendary expedition of 62 sailors from Bari to Myra, the sacred relics of Saint Nicholas were brought to the city.
- We then proceed by coach to the second destination of our excursion: **Castel del Monte**, the symbol *par excellence* of the melting pot of artists and scholars of many different nationalities and races that were hosted at the court of **Frederick II of Swabia**. The castle, now a UNESCO World Heritage Site, is traditionally believed to have been built around 1240. It lay abandoned for centuries until 1876 when it became a place of great interest to experts of history of art and astronomy, scientists and architects, who even today are amazed by the perfection of a mathematically imperfect structure.
- The building has an octagonal plan with a 24-metre high octagonal tower at each corner. The interior is divided into two floors that are raised with respect to the forecourt. Observing the building in detail, it is amazing to note that not one of the façades of the internal octagonal courtyard is the same as any other, yet the beauty and **harmony of the building** as a whole is quite beguiling. The castle was built from three main materials (limestone, white marble and *breccia corallina*, a type of sedimentary rock with a pink hue), which are carefully distributed to produce the right chromatic effect.
- Places on this excursion are limited. We recommend booking early.?
- Dress code that is appropriate for the places of worship to be visited is recommended.

ITALY'S HIDDEN TREASURES - LOCOROTONDO
Description

Awarded the Orange Flag by Italy's Touring Club for its beautiful shape and the convenience of the historic centre, the ancient heart of Locorotondo unfolds in a string of picturesque views, which we will discover on a pleasant stroll.

What we will see

- Murge Plateau
- Locorotondo: the historic centre and the *cummerse*

What we will do

- We will leave the port of Bari and head south towards **Murge**, the karst square-shaped plateau in central Puglia.
- Our destination is the **town of Locorotondo**, a whitewashed town in a distinctive circular shape which gave it its name.
- When we reach our destination, we will explore the **historic centre**, a unique monument oozing charm and character with its whitewashed cottages, cobbled streets, elegant portals and balconies brimming with flowers.
- In the historic centre, there are also the so-called '*cummerse*': small whitewashed houses in an even geometric shape with a

pitched roof, which have been renovated and opened up to tourists for accommodation in the area.

- Places on this excursion are limited. We recommend booking early.
- Comfortable shoes are recommended.
- The coach transfer takes approximately 1 hour and 30 minutes each way.
- In case of heavy traffic, the excursion may last longer.

What we will do

- Our coach takes to Matera to discover its famous **Sassi** in an unusual way on a rickshaw.
- We venture into the two famous districts – **Sasso Barisano** and **Sasso Caveoso** – to see ancient dwellings carved into tufa rock and prehistoric caves. We also spot ancient stone churches, some of which are home to frescoes boasting a Latin and Byzantine influence. The ancient charm of these district has led to their recognition as a UNESCO World Heritage Site and attracts millions of visitors every year including celebrities such as Mel Gibson, who chose the Sassi di Matera as the set for his film “The Passion of Christ”.
- The driver must have a driving licence and must hand in the licence or an ID that will be returned at the end of the tour.

VISIT TO PRINCESS SISSI'S PALACE AND THE CITY OF CORFU

Description

From the splendour and elegance of Achilleion, the villa of Princess Sissi, the Empress Elizabeth of Austria, to the magnificent landscapes and architecture of Corfu, the enchanting capital of the Ionian Sea's emerald island.

What we will see

- Achilleion: Princess Sissi's Palace
- Kanoni (photo stop)
- City of Corfu

What we will do

- After leaving the port, we set off to discover one of the numerous attractions of the island of Corfu, which the Greeks call *Kerkyra*. It is no surprise that Princess Sissi, the Empress Elizabeth of Austria, chose the island as a refuge, far from the obligations of the Habsburg court. The Empress, who was prone to solitude, loved spending time on this peaceful island, admiring its rolling landscape. She therefore had a magnificent villa, **Achilleion**, built here in neoclassical style. Following her death it was purchased by Emperor Wilhelm II, who was also enchanted by the beauty of Corfu. Accompanied by our guide, we step back into the past, admiring the sumptuous frescoed rooms decorated with classic motifs, the works inspired by Greek mythology, and the furniture and customs associated with this enchanting residence dedicated to the Empress's favourite hero: Achilles. We then gaze at the magnificent Italian-style gardens that slope towards the sea.
- This charming visit continues to one of the most beautiful places in Corfu: **Kanoni**, a small island from where the white monastery of Vlacherna can be seen, connected to the mainland by a small bridge. We will have the opportunity to take photos to remember this truly evocative sight.

- The last stop on our excursion is the **city of Corfu**. We walk through the labyrinth of narrow streets that flow into picturesque squares, brought to life by traditional craftsmen's shops that tell the history of the island.
- Places on this excursion are limited. We recommend booking early.?
- It is not allowed to take pictures/videos and guiding in St. Spyridon church.
- Dress code that is appropriate for the places of worship is recommended.

JEEP ADVENTURE: INLAND CORFU
Description

Driving along the inland roads by jeep, to discover the most characteristic villages in Corfu, enjoying breathtaking scenery, ending the day in one of the most beautiful bays on the island: Paleokastritsa.

What we will see

- Alykes, Kontokali, Gouvia, Sokraki, Troumbetta (panoramic tour)
- Lakones and tasting at the Castellino restaurant
- Bay of Paleokastritsa: relax and swimming (weather permitting)

What we will do

- Leaving the port in our jeep, we head for the island's northern coast. On the journey we enjoy enchanting panoramic views, passing through the seaside resorts of **Alykes, Kontokali and Gouvia**.
- We drive past Agios Vasilios and Ano Korikiana, and here we take a winding road that crosses **Sokraki**, one of the oldest villages on the island, immersed in pine and olive trees and perched on the summit of Mount Korakio, which commands an incredible view over both the Adriatic and the Ionian seas.
- We continue our tour towards the characteristic village of **Troumbetta**, along a mountain ridge, where we are enchanted by the magnificent view of the islands of Mathraki and Othoni in north-western Greece.
- We continue our inland excursion across the island towards the west, passing through Alimataed, Vistonas and Makrades,

villages where time appears to stand still.

- We will sample the delights of **typical Greek meze at the Castellino restaurant** that dominates the village of **Lakones**, which commands a magnificent view.
- The last stop on our tour is in the **bay of Paleokastritsa**: a natural port with a sandy beach, framed by a rocky promontory. According to the legend, Odysseus met Nausicaa here after the shipwreck. Who could resist diving into the crystal clear waters of this enchanting bay and relaxing on this magnificent beach before returning to the port?

EASY TOUR OF CORFU ISLAND

Description

Between legend and reality in this short panoramic tour, the island of Corfu will amaze us with its magnificent coasts, evocative scenery, characteristic villages and the historic centre of its capital, enhanced by elegant residences that retain a Venetian flavour.

What we will see

- Kanoni, Mouse Island, Vlacherna Monastery (panoramic tour)
- Garitsa Bay
- City of Corfu: historic centre, Old Fortress, Durrell Gardens, Spianada Square, City Hall, Church of St. Spyridon (free time)
- Tasting session at a typical distillery

What we will do

- We begin our excursion with a panoramic coach tour through the island of **Kanoni**, where we can admire Pontikonissi, or **Mouse Island**: according to the legend, the island was formed when the Phoenicians' ship was turned into stone by Poseidon, after having brought Odysseus home to Ithaca. We are then enchanted by the evocative **monastery of Vlacherna**, connected to the mainland by a small bridge. We cannot miss the opportunity to take magnificent photographs of the spectacular views.
- We then continue our panoramic tour towards the green **Garitsa bay**, before arriving at the **city of Corfu** with its rich history and undeniable charm. We walk through the city's narrow streets, which boast elegant buildings with diverse architectural styles that bear witness to the various foreign influences that have left their mark over the centuries. On this Greek island, with

its wealth of buildings and squares dating back to Venetian times, we are surrounded by reminders of the Italian city. We are enchanted by the **Old Fortress** that dominates the port and the city, the magnificent **Durrell gardens**, the **Spianada** where cricket is still played, the **City Hall** and the **Church of St. Spyridon**, the island's patron saint.

- After using our free time to do a little shopping, the excursion concludes with a **tasting session at a typical distillery** near the city.
- Places on this excursion are limited. We recommend booking early.?
- Dress code that is appropriate for the places of worship to be visited is recommended.

PANORAMAS AND FLAVOURS OF ATHENS
Description

A unique opportunity to experience the historical and architectural wonders of Athens, the cradle of Western civilisation, and to discover its aromas and flavours in the best restaurant in Mikrolimano.

What we will see

- Port of Zea
- Athens
- Acropolis, Parthenon
- Panathenaic Stadium, University, National Library, National Academy and Syntagma Square, Greek Parliament and the Tomb of the Unknown soldier (panoramic tour)
- Plaka, Old University, Tower of the Winds, Ancient Agora and the Choragic Monument to Lisicratus
- Mikrolimano, tasting in a typical restaurant

What we will do

- After leaving the port of Piraeus, we drive by coach past the **naval port of Zea**. It was built by Themistocles as a defence against the Persian Empire in the early 5th century BC.

- We then arrive in **Athens**, the cradle of Western civilisation and the capital of Greece. Approximately one hundred metres above the city stands the Acropolis, which dates back to the 5th century BC, the golden age of Athens. We make a photo stop at the foot of the famous steps before continuing our excursion.
- We see the most famous monument in all its splendour: the **Parthenon**, built as a temple to honour the goddess Athena, the patron deity of Athens.
- Our panoramic tour continues in the direction of the imposing **Panathenaic Stadium**, the only large stadium in the world to be built entirely of white marble. Traffic permitting, we have a short photo stop.
- We continue our tour, driving past the **University, the National Library, the National Academy and Syntagma Square**, the **Greek Parliament** and the **Tomb of the Unknown Soldier**.
- We leave the coach and set off on foot to explore the oldest part of Athens: **Plaka**, home to elegant neoclassical buildings, ancient monuments and shops with an antique aura, interspersed with typical restaurants, cafés and boutiques. We admire in awe the **Old University**, the **Tower of the Winds**, the **Ancient Agora** and the **Choragic Monument to Lisicratus**.
- After a little of shopping, we return to our coach to continue on to the beautiful **seafront at Mikrolimano**, which means 'little port' in Greek. The small fishing boats sheltered here form the backdrop of a wonderful panorama. It is not surprising that this port, second only to Piraeus, attracts tourists from all over Attica. In one of its many typical seafront restaurants, we sample the delicious local cuisine, accompanied by the joyous melodies of *sirtaki*, typical Greek dancing.

PREMIUM TOUR: ACROPOLIS, THE BIRTHPLACE OF GREEK CIVILISATION
Description
What we will see

- Acropolis
- Temple of Athena Nike
- Erechtheion
- Parthenon
- Panoramic city tour

What we will do

- We set off from the port of Pireo and head towards our destination: **Acropolis**, the largest ancient complex in the Western world. Located at the heart of an ancient plain, the Acropolis stands on upland and presents architectural marvels of rare beauty. The upland was in actual fact a suitable place to build a high, fortified city, firstly a stronghold for the Kings of Athens and base of the most ancient sanctuaries. Having become the religious centre of ancient Athens, Acropolis owes its magnificence to the period under Pericles which made it a monument dedicated to Greek civilisation.
- Our guide will present us with the marvellous **Temple of Athena Nike**, dating back to 427-424 a.C., to commemorate the victory of the people of Athens over the Persians.
- We continue our visit with another delight: **Erechtheion**. Built in the most religious part of Acropolis, this temple is dedicated to both Athena and Poseidon. We are able to take photos of the extraordinary caryatids which adorn the southern portico of the temple.
- We will end the visit perfectly by admiring the **Parthenon**, a magnificent and perfect architectural work. We will carry this image of the world's most famous temple with us forever. Built in 447 BC and dedicated to the goddess Athena Parthenos in 438 BC, it has been used over the centuries as a church, mosque and arsenal and is still a symbol of the city of Athens, and perhaps, without any exaggeration, it can be considered the greatest symbol of our civilisation.
- We can wave goodbye to Athens from above, with a breathtaking, panoramic visit.
- The visit to the Acropolis involves a climb and walking on uneven ground. We therefore recommend that you wear comfortable shoes.
- It is strictly forbidden to bring large bags or pushchairs into the Acropolis.
- Visitors with mobility problems will be able to access the Acropolis using a lift. In the event of inclement weather, or for safety reasons, the lift may be closed without warning at the sole discretion of the local authorities responsible for the site.
- On reaching the archaeological area, visitors with reduced mobility will be able to partially tour the ruins by following a special route.
- We recommend that you book early because only a limited number of places are available.

Description

What we will see

- Port of Zea (sightseeing tour)

- The **Acropolis** dominates the city, magnificent testimony of Athens's Golden Age. We cannot miss the opportunity to take magnificent photographs.
- We will continue on foot to visit what was once the most lively area in the city: ancient **Agorà** of Athens. People would gather here for political, commercial and administrative purposes, as well as to discuss religious issues and questions of social relationships. Agorà was also headquarters of the legal system and it was here that, in 399 B.C., Socrates was sentenced to death accused of introducing strange gods and of having corrupted the youth.
- With the guide, we will continue on our journey to the picturesque area of **Monastiraki**, where we will be offered the most famous and typical example of traditional Greek cuisine, **gyros pita**, a favourite street food amongst the Greeks made up of a pita stuffed with meat, vegetables and chips, accompanied with a glass of ouzo or wine, or a drink and water.
- Before we bid farewell to the city, we will have time to enjoy a stroll through Monastiraki or Plaka to browse the shops or sit in one of the many cafés that line Via Andrianou, where we cannot take our eyes off the wonderful Acropolis.

THE CANAL AND ANCIENT CORINTH

Description

A unique opportunity to admire the great Corinth Canal, an idea which dates back to the times of the Roman which was developed up until the nineteenth century, and the remains of ancient Corinth which stuns with the famous Apollo Temple.

What we will see

- Corinth Canal
- Ancient Corinth

What we will do

- We will leave the port and by coach, arrive at the **Corinth Canal**: it is 6 kilometres long, 23 metres wide and 8 metres deep, with sloping sides that reach 80 metres in height. The idea of building a canal to cut across the isthmus linking the Ionian and Aegean seas dates back to Roman times, when Emperor Nero ordered the first excavations using silver shovels and Jewish slaves. It was only in 1881 that technology was good enough to 'cut' the isthmus.
- We may get lucky and see a ship passing through the strait: such a sighting is sensational and is definitely worthy of a photo!
- We will leave the canal behind and visit **Ancient Corinth**, described by Saint Paul as 'rich and licentious'. Protected by a powerful fortress, the city had a forum which was bigger than the one in Rome, with temples, theatres, baths, fountains, shops and basilicas. Before hopping back on board the coach, we will treat ourselves to the majesty of Apollo's Temple: a splendid example of the Doric style of the 6th Century B.C.
- The transfer from the port to Corinth Canal takes about 1 hour and 30 minutes.

What we will do

- After leaving the port of Piraeus, we drive by coach past the **naval port of Zea**. It was built by Themistocles as a defence against the Persian Empire in the early 5th century BC.
- We soon arrive in Athens, the cradle of Western civilisation and capital of Greece. Large and modern, the city is home to some of history's most incredible ruins. We begin our journey back in time with a visit to the magnificent **Acropolis**, the largest ancient complex in the Western world.
- We are enraptured by the **Parthenon**, a magnificent and perfect architectural work. We will carry this image of the world's most famous temple with us forever. Built in 447 BC and dedicated to the goddess Athena Parthenos in 438 BC, it has been used over the centuries as a church, mosque and arsenal and is still a symbol of the city of Athens, and perhaps, without any exaggeration, it can be considered the greatest symbol of our civilisation.
- Our next stop is a visit to the **New Acropolis Museum**. This building with its modern design houses a wealth of priceless works, in particular the sculptures that originally adorned the monuments of the Acropolis. Built above the excavations, the museum is divided into three levels and is supported by more than 100 individually positioned columns.
- We visit the temporary exhibition on the first floor and we are fascinated by the ancient ruins, visible through a transparent glass floor. We climb the glass staircase to a double-height exhibition space that is the permanent home of archaeological relics from the Archaic age to the last days of the Roman period. Lastly, we enjoy the unique experience of the third floor. This floor which houses the Parthenon Gallery has been constructed at an angle of 23 degrees to the building below in order to mirror the position of the temple on the Rock of Acropolis.
- We continue our visit with a panoramic tour of the city. Athens is a busy capital and, as we weave our way through the traffic, we can see immediately that it is also home to about half the population of Greece. We have the opportunity to see some of the city's most famous attractions, such as **the University, the National Library and the National Academy, as well as the Arch of Hadrian, Constitution Square, the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, and the Parliament**.
- The visit to the Acropolis involves a climb and walking on uneven ground. We therefore recommend that you wear comfortable shoes.

- We use our free time to explore other picturesque parts of the neighbourhood and perhaps to indulge in a little shopping in the shops that line the narrow streets.
- The visit to the Acropolis involves a climb and walking on uneven ground. We therefore recommend that you wear comfortable shoes.

- It is strictly forbidden to bring large bags or pushchairs into the Acropolis.
- Visitors with mobility problems will be able to access the Acropolis using a lift. In the event of inclement weather, or for safety reasons, the lift may be closed without warning at the sole discretion of the local authorities responsible for the site.
- On reaching the archaeological area, visitors with reduced mobility will be able to partially tour the ruins by following a special route.

- Our guide then accompanies us to the street known as **Adrianou**, where we will have some free time to explore the neighbourhood or do a little shopping before meeting up with the rest of the group and setting off for a panoramic tour of the centre of Piraeus.

ATHENIAN RIVIERA AND CAPE SOUNION

- Built in the 5th century BC on the orders of Pericles, **the temple is dedicated to the Greek god of the sea**. Indeed, many of the cruise ships that pass Cape Sounion today still pay homage to Poseidon by lowering their flags or sounding their horns.
- The temple commands **stunning views of the Saronic Gulf and the Cyclades: a feast for both the eyes and the soul!**

- We set foot on terra firma once again at **Syntagma Square** in the heart of the city. From there, our guide will accompany us on a walk to the charming **Monastiraki** neighbourhood, which is famous for its bustling flea market.
- Here, we have the chance to enjoy a taste of one of Greece's favourite street food specialities, indeed one of the country's most iconic culinary treats, a **gyros pita**: a flatbread filled with meat, vegetables and French-fried potatoes.
- We then make our way to the oldest neighbourhood in Athens, the Plaka, where we find a heady mix of neoclassical buildings, actual classical monuments and characteristic shops that seem forgotten by time, all interspersed with traditional restaurants, cafés and boutiques.
- At the end of our guided walking tour, we have some free time to continue exploring or do a little shopping around the Plaka.

WALK AROUND KOTOR

Description

An excursion to discover Kotor, a picturesque town overlooking the crystal clear waters of Kotor Bay, and the Medieval treasures inside its ancient walls.

What we will see

- Ancient walls
- Old town
- St. Tryphon Cathedral
- Maritime Museum

What we will do

- The town of Kotor, at the foot of Mount Lov_en, is located on a coastal strip in the Gulf of Kotor. The construction work on the **ancient fortification walls** started in the Middle Ages, in 1420 when Kotor was at the height of its splendour. and was only finished in the 18th century. The walls are 15 metres high and extend for 4.5 km around the town to St. John's Castle 280 m above sea level.
- In the **old town**, with its well-preserved medieval character, we will visit the **Cathedral of St. Tryphon**, built in 1166, to admire the Romanesque architecture enhanced by Byzantine elements. Inside, we observe the square pillars alternating with ancient columns between the naves and the apse.
- We will then visit the **Maritime Museum**, which illustrates the maritime tradition of the city, consolidated between the 16th and 18th centuries, as well as recalling the most famous fleets and captains of its history.
- After our guided visit, we have some free time to walk around the picturesque streets to do some shopping or relax in one of the many cafés.
- We recommend wearing comfortable shoes.

BUDVA AND KOTOR: A TALE OF TWO CITIES

Description

We walk past the ancient walls of Budva to admire the picturesque town centre and venture among the Medieval treasures of Kotor, a city that has been declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

What we will see

- Budva: old town, ancient walls, historic centre
- Kotor: historic centre

What we will do

- After leaving the port of Kotor, we travel by coach to **Budva**, one of the most ancient towns of the region. According to the legend, the city was founded by Cadmus, son of Agenor, a Phoenician king. After leaving Thebes, he arrived with his chariot in the place that would later become Budva. The old city was originally located on an island which, over the centuries, became a peninsula due to the formation of a sandy isthmus connecting it to the mainland.
- Surrounded by **15th-century walls**, this imposing Medieval fortress is made up of towers and various access gates located along the walls.
- Once inside, we stroll around the **historic centre** made up of a charming maze of streets, squares and monuments that is made even more interesting by the Venetian-inspired style adopted when rebuilding the city after the earthquake of 1979 in memory of Venetian domination.
- On our way back, we stop to visit **Kotor**, a magnificent town that was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and we spend some time in the **historic centre**, which bears clear evidence of the golden age of the city in Medieval times.

PERAST, VISIT TO 'OUR LADY OF THE ROCKS' AND KOTOR

Description

An evocative journey to discover the Baroque soul of Perast and the only artificial island in the Adriatic Sea, ending with a visit to the town of Kotor and its Medieval treasures.

What we will see

- Perast
- Island of "Our Lady of the Rocks"
- Kotor: St. Tryphon Cathedral, Maritime Museum

- After a brief coach transfer, we stop to visit the picturesque town of **Perast** to photograph its treasures. A great maritime power that reached its apex in the 17th and 18th century, Perast is the best preserved Montenegrin Baroque city.
- A boat then takes us to the **artificial island of 'Our Lady of the Rocks'** (*Gospa od krpjela*), built around a small rock (*krpjel*) by the locals over the centuries using stones and parts of old sunken ships. Here we visit the church, dedicated to the Madonna, which has been defined a 'true treasure trove', a testimony of the history and tradition of Perast. Before heading back, we stop to enjoy the magnificent view of the Bay of Kotor.
- We then board the boat again and head towards **Kotor**, a picturesque city surrounded by imposing Medieval walls that was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site after the earthquake of 1979.
- We stroll around the streets of the historic centre and see the **Cathedral of St. Tryphon**, the oldest cathedral on the eastern coast of the Adriatic Sea which boasts a precious collection of 14th-century Venetian art.
- We then visit the **Maritime Museum**, located in the 18th-century Grgurina palace, where we admire model ships, tools, banners, photographs and artefacts.
- At the end of our guided tour, we will have some free time to wander around the city and buy some souvenirs.

- Photos, prints, arms, war maps, military equipment and objects from the daily lives of the residents and defenders of Dubrovnik during the siege are on display in the museum in addition to original sound and video recordings and military battle flags.
- The return cable car journey takes us back to the lower station, just a ten-minute walk from **Ploce Gate**, the Eastern entrance to Dubrovnik's old town near to the old port, where our walking tour begins.
- We stroll along the **Stradun**, Dubrovnik's main street, passing the **Church of Saint Blaise**, the **Onofrio fountain**, the **Cathedral**, Sponza Palace, the **drawbridge** and **Pile Gate**.

Children and kids

Children between the ages of 3 and 13 are entitled to a 30% discount for excursions on cruises in the Mediterranean and Northern Europe, 25% for cruises in South America and Transatlantic cruises from/to South America, and 10% for cruises to the Caribbean and Transatlantic cruises from/to the Caribbean.

There is no charge for children up to the age of 3 provided that parents carry them during transportation.
