Main stops

- Sightseeing tour to De Ferrari Square
- Genoa city center, with the chance to see, independently: The Old Port; The Bigo; The Aquarium of Genoa; The Biosfera; Spianata Castelletto; The **Baruggia** alleys; The Palazzi dei Rolli; The Strada Nuova Museums; The Doge's Palace; The San Lorenzo Cathedral

The programme

- Your **coach** heads for the city centre: From here, **let your curiosity run wild!** Genoa offers **accessible monuments and sites** to suit every taste. Some tips? Here you are!
- To begin with, watch out for these three ultra-modern sights: The **Bigo** panoramic elevator and the **Biosfera**, both designed by Renzo Piano, as well as the **largest aquarium in Europe**.
- If you cross the street, you'll find yourself in the **Baruggia** typical medieval **paved** alleys, where you'll discover **squares, churches, traditional shops** and the city's rich **multicultural** side.
- Indulge in some art on via Garibaldi, where you'll find the **Rolli**: The Palazzo Rosso, Palazzo Bianco and Palazzo Tursi. These museums are **UNESCO World Heritage sites** and accessible to everyone, including visitors with limited mobility. A quick visit?
- A **Liberty elevator** will comfortably take you from Piazza Portello to **Spianata Castelletto**, and here the sights over the city and the port are just no match for the camera.
- Don't forget the **Doge's Palace**, the ancient residence of the doges, and the **San Lorenzo Cathedral!** And if you find the exteriors striking, treat yourself to a look inside: Thanks to elevators and walkways, no one needs to miss out.

FINALBORGO AND NOLI: TWO VILLAGES NESTLED BETWEEN THE SEA AND THE MOUNTAINS

In a nutshell

Discover the close link between **the sea and mountains of Liguria** through **two medieval villages** carved from rock and shaped by waves. Mountains take center stage in **Finalborgo**, where an **exclusive Costa guide** will lead you between the **monuments, walls and piazzas dating back to the feudal age**, while in **Noli**, your guide will accompany you through **loggias, arcades** and stories of the Mediterranean sea. 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- Now it's time for a change of scenery in **Noli**, a fishing village with a thousand stories. Like that of the **Torre Papone tower**, for example, which features a room for hiding from enemy sea captains and their crews.
- After admiring the **views of sea and mountains from the Vescovado viewpoint**, head to the **Noli arcade**, with its 'risseu' black and white pebble paving. Did you know that once upon a time, there was just water here? And that Christopher Columbus set sail from these walls?
- Meanwhile, those looking to discover Ligurian treasures had to pass through the **loggia of the Repubblica Nolese** and the **Porta Piazza gate**. You can make your way through them too: it's time to learn about local legends at the **Oratory of Saint Anna!**

 - In the late morning you'll proceed to **Montecarlo**, the most famous area of the Principality, with its **casino, luxury hotels**, social life and streets where the **annual Formula 1 Grand Prix** takes place. - You'll reach the Expo area, in Genoa's **Ancient Port**, a restored seaside area in the heart of Genoa's old town. This is home to the **Genoa Aquarium**, one of Europe's leading aquariums. You'll follow a path along **71 tanks** full of marine plants and animals. You'll discover multicolored tropical fish, sponges and jellyfish, natural corals, steely-eyed sharks and even playful dolphins, seals and penguins. You can even stroke some ray fish specimens in the **touch pools**. A real 'tour through the oceans of the world' that will thrill young and old.

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- Slight changes may be made to itineraries and the length of excursions to protect your health and to comply with regulations and the safety protocol.
- This excursion is suitable if you have slight mobility impairments and can walk short distances unassisted. If you are a wheelchair user, the presence of a companion not provided by the ship is required. Most of our operators require the wheelchair to be foldable. Wander along its narrow streets, known as *Breuze* and past its colorful houses: you'll feel like time has stood still.
- Discover the elegant **districts of Albaro and Foce** by bus and stroll through the city center: from the vast **Piazza De Ferrari** to the **Doge's Palace**, the **Cathedral of San Lorenzo**, with its sayings and mysteries, to the outside of the house of **Christopher Columbus**.

- It's time for some **food tasting**. Some traditional **fried fish** await you at the harbor, strictly accompanied by a **glass of local wine**.
- But your adventure in Savona doesn't end here. You still need to see **Palazzo Gavotti**, which houses the **Savona Picture Gallery**, and the **Ceramics Museum**, showcasing an art mastered by the Ligurians. A **journey through six centuries** awaits, from 15th-16th century tiles, known as **Loggioni** to majolicas inspired by oriental porcelain.

The programme

- At the **La Scolca estate**, you'll find out about the **origins of Gavi DOCG**, which is famed worldwide.
- Thanks to a **local sommelier**, you'll also discover the history of the **Soldati family**, who have been living here for more than 100 years: a family business that dates back four generations, established when great-grandfather Giorgio planted **Cortese vines** on this land in 1919.
- It's thanks to him that **Gavi DOCG** exists today. While you wander among the **50 hectares of vines in rows**, just think that in the past, only red grapes were grown here!
- After you've learned all there is to know about vines, it's time to head to the **winery**. Here, a **zero food miles process** transforms the grapes into wine, **respecting the raw materials and the land** that enable them to grow.
- All with a nod to the sea, too: did you know that the cork in the latest wine to be created by the estate is made from **plastic waste recovered from the ocean**?
- And while we're on the topic, it's time to pop a cork or two. On the terrace overlooking the vines, you **can turn into a sommelier yourself**, as you taste three of the **estate's labels**, and complete your rating card.
- Before leaving, a buffet of **typical dishes** and a **small gift** symbolizing the company's commitment to sustainability await you.
- Before booking the excursion or once on board, contact the excursion office to check the availability of vegetarian or gluten-free dishes and to report any food intolerances.

Savona THE FLAVOURS AND HISTORY OF ALBENGA

In a nutshell

Albenga stretches, as though it was itself a peninsula, towards the sea on the estuary of the River Centa.

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Accompanied by our tour rep, we set off in discovery of the sites and history of this ancient city.

Main stops

- Albenga
- Old town: Cathedral of San Michele and the eponymous Piazza
- Free time

The programme

- Leaving the port, we set off towards the city of **Albenga**, whose ancient city walls enclose its pointed red towers and protect a treasure trove of Roman, Medieval and Renaissance architecture.
- Our guide leads us through atmospheric streets, helping us to discover the best that this little city on the *Riviera di Ponente* has to offer. You can visit **Magiche trasparenze** exhibition (**Magical Transparencies**) which displays glassware found during architectural excavations in the city's necropolises. These include the famous Blue Plate, a piece unlike any other anywhere in the world.
- We cross the picturesque **Piazza di San Michele** over which looms the eponymous Romanesque-Gothic **Cathedral**, and admire the octagonal 5th-century **Baptistry** the oldest palaeo-Christian monument in Liguria which houses an impressive mosaic.

TREASURES OF ART AND POPULAR CULTURE

In a nutshell

The tradition of Valencia between the sacred and the profane: monuments and Christian relics, markets and pagan celebrations to enjoy the city in all its countless facets.

Main stops

- Cathedral and Holy Chalice
- 'Las Aguas' water court
- The Lonja, Central Market
- 'Fallas' Museum

The programme

- We will begin our tour of Valencia at the **Cathedral**, better known to Valencians as 'La Seu', or 'The seat', which is now the hub of religious, cultural and daily life in the city. We will admire this stunning church from outside. Construction began in 1262 in a Gothic-Cistercian style and took until the 18th century to complete, producing a wonderful blend of complementary styles.
- Every Thursday, at one of its gates, the famous '**Las Aguas' water court** is held, the oldest judicial institution in Europe which, because of its tribunals and irrevocable sentences, mostly settles disputes over the use and exploitation of irrigation water from the fertile plain of Valencia. The court, which originated in the Middle Ages, gathers every Thursday at midday at the chiming of the bells of the Miguelete, the cathedral's bell tower, announcing a lively and unique tradition.
- But it is inside the cathedral that the oldest relic worshipped by the Christians is carefully held: the **Holy Chalice** which, according to tradition, would have been the chalice used by Jesus Christ during

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the Last Supper.

- We will then head to the **Lonja**, the old silk exchange and one of the most fascinating pure Gothic-style civic buildings in history. Declared a UNESCO world heritage site in 1996, the Lonja is a symbol of Valencia's wealth during the Golden Age, in around the 15th century, and the commercial and social revolution that took place in the Late Middle Ages.
- Then we will cross the road to explore the famous **Central Market** of Valencia, which, with an area of over 8,000 m2 and one thousand sales points, is one of the largest indoor markets in Europe.
- Glass domes, liberty-style finishing and brightly coloured *tiles* today provide the backdrop for the scents and colours of the stores offering products from the earth and sea in a picturesque setting.
- An abundance of tradition and biting satire is on offer at the '**Fallas**' **Museum**, where we can see genuine satirical hand-made figures created by the inhabitants of each district to be burned on the evening of 19 March, the day of the festival of Saint Joseph. We can see which ones were saved from the stake by a public vote and kept in the museum.
- Dress code that is appropriate for the places of worship to be visited is recommended.
- When the cathedral is being used for religious ceremonies, our tour will be limited to the exterior of the building.
- On Fridays, public holidays and in the event of exceptional closures, the Central Market can only be visited from the outside.

- And to finish off, take a stroll through the **Umbracle**: it offers stunning views over the City of Arts and Sciences, as well as serving as an open-air contemporary art gallery and a botanical garden, all at once.

A HISTORICAL WALKING TOUR IN VALENCIA

In a nutshell

We will get to know Valencia **through its history** with a **tour of the buildings that are symbolic** of the city's past - today the heart of contemporary art in Spain, and at the same time, the guardian of a historical

legacy that began two thousand years ago. Finally, we will stop to sip the typical **local orange juice**, the iconic drink of Valencia.

- We will begin our tour of Valencia at the **Cathedral**, better known to Valencians as 'La Seu', or 'The Seat', which is now the hub of religious, cultural and daily life in the city. We will observe this stunning church, the construction of which began in 1262 in a Gothic-Cistercian style and took until the 18th century to complete, producing a wonderful blend of complementary styles.
- Every Thursday, at one of its gates, the famous **Tribunale de 'Las Aguas'** water court is held, the oldest judicial institution in Europe which, because of its tribunals and irrevocable sentences, mostly settles disputes over the use and exploitation of irrigation water from the fertile plain of Valencia. The court, which originated in the Middle Ages, gathers every Thursday at midday at the chiming of the **bells of the Miguelete**, the cathedral's bell tower, announcing a lively and unique tradition.
- Now a stop with typical flavors awaits us: we will taste the famous juice made from the **local Valencia oranges**, which are iconic throughout the world.
- We will then pause in front of the **Lonja**, the old silk exchange and one of the most fascinating pure Gothic-style civic buildings in history. Declared a UNESCO world heritage site in 1996, the Lonja is a symbol of Valencia's wealth during the Golden Age, in around the 15th century, and the commercial and social revolution that took place in the Late Middle Ages.
- Next, we will cross the road to admire the famous **Mercado Central** of Valencia, which is one of the largest indoor markets in Europe, home to around one thousand sales points and spanning more than 8,000 m².
- On Sundays and religious festivals, the visit to the Cathedral will be limited to the outside.
- On Fridays, public holidays and in the event of exceptional closures, the Central Market can only be visited from the outside.

Built between 1229 and 1601, it was renovated in the 20th century by none other than Antoni Gaudí, who added to it some elements in the modernist style.
- Right beside it is the **Almudaina Royal Palace**, a **Muslim alcázar** from 1281, later the seat of the Kingdom of Aragon and today the summer residence of the Spanish royal family.
- And as a final touch to remember, take home a few **Majorca pearls**. They are artificial, but will deceive even an experienced eye. They have been produced by craftsmen on the island since the end of the 19th century.

DISCOVERING SARDINIA, THE HOME OF NURAGHI

In a nutshell

A dip into the past takes us from the iron age to the Roman era, revealing the secrets of the mysterious Nuraghi.

Main stops

- Nuragic civilisation, Nuraghi
- Nuraghe La Prisgiona
- Giants' Grave in Coddu Vecchiu
- Cannigione

The programme

- The excursion takes on a journey of discovery of Nuragic civilisation, to admire one of the largest Nuragic settlements in the north of Sardinia.
- **Nuragic civilisation** developed in Sardinia at a time when the rest of the Mediterranean basin and Western Europe were experiencing the iron age and the bronze age (1800 BC), up to the Roman era (2nd century BC). The civilisation takes its name from the imposing megalithic constructions called **Nuraghi**, a term that is believed to derive from the pre-Latin word *Nur* meaning "heap of stones, hollow heap".
- It is believed that around seven thousand examples of these extraordinary constructions are still standing, scattered around the whole island, one every 3 km² on average, meaning that they are an important part of the characteristic Sardinian landscape. Considered one of the oldest in Europe, the Nuragic civilisation was the result of the meeting of different Mediterranean peoples and the gradual evolution of pre-existing cultures that had spread across Sardinian soil since the Neolithic period.
- The Nuragics had a very strong ethnic unity even though they were organised politically into tribes, and the tribes into clans. Their economy was predominantly based on agriculture and livestock rearing. It is therefore assumed that there were frequent clashes between rival tribes over the right to the richest, most fertile land.

- We head north west from Olbia towards Arzachena until we reach the vast archaeological site which houses the **Nuraghe La Prisgiona**, a unique Nuragic setting in Gallura and the jewel in the crown of the region's historic heritage. Its location and the size and complexity of its architectural structure are testament to the prominent role it played in the past.
- The **Nuraghe La Prisgiona**, which we will visit, is a complex "tholos" Nuraghe. It is dominated by a central tower (the keep) which looks out over the village consisting of around ninety huts.
- In the immediate surroundings we will find the **Giants' Grave** (*tumbas de sos gigantes* in the Sardinian language "Sardo") at **Coddu Vecchiu** o Capichera. It is masterful example of the architecture that was typical of funeral monuments in prehistoric times in Sardinia, located in the Capichera countryside with its vineyards and wild olive trees.
- After the visit we move on to **Cannigione**, a well-known seaside resort in a central location near the tourist villages and beaches of the Emerald Coast, lapped by the waters of the Gulf of Arzachena of which it has always been the natural port.
- Before continuing on to Olbia, we can enjoy some free time for a relaxing end to our excursion.

- After a brief visit to the town, we will head for the **Gallura Ethnographic Museum** where, lying next to over 5,000 pieces on display, you will also find the small hammer that is believed to have been used by the so-called 'Femmina Accabadora', women who put an end to human suffering: a sort of early form of euthanasia.
- After the visit, we will make our way to the **Valley of Carana** where we can see some of the oldest trees in Europe: the thousand-year-old olive trees, the oldest of which has a circumference of over 12 metres at the base of its trunk.
- Then we move on towards Olbia, with a stop in **Telti** to visit the small historic centre and the residential hub of the town, all built around the square that is home to the **Santa Vittoria cathedral** where we can admire the colour of the local granite and a variety of murals.
- Before boarding the ship again, we can't miss the chance to taste one of the typical local products: **Myrtle**, a liqueur produced from the berries of the plant with the same name.
