### **A BIKE ADVENTURE AMONG THE SECRETS OF NHA TRANG**

#### **In a nutshell**

Forget the standard tourist tours. Here, **some serious pedaling is required**, through stunning landscapes with authentic encounters and a touch of adventure. From the crystal-clear sea to the most typical Vietnamese countryside, this bike ride is a full immersion in the local culture.

#### **Main stops**

- Cycle ride along the coast of Nha Trang with the sea just a stone's throw away.
- Authentic rural villages, with traditional houses and rice paddies.

#### **The programme**

We'll set off from the port of Nha Trang, with a brief bus transfer to Nha Trang Beach Public Park. From here, we'll start pedaling along the coastal road. First stop: **Tram Huong Tower**, the symbol of the city. A few minutes later, the route will take us past the **Nha Trang Cathedral**, a piece of France in the heart of Vietnam, with its Gothic architecture soaring above the streets of the city.

But now comes the best part: we'll leave the traffic behind us and **plunge into the countryside**. Here, life has a slower pace, with rice paddies, water buffalo and traditional houses in wood and bamboo. Smell the incense burning in the courtyards, while children play in the street and every now and then a farmer greets us with a smile. A special stop awaits you at the **Loc Tho Pagoda**, a little corner of peace where the monks take care of orphaned children. An experience that will touch your heart and make you reflect.

After a few kilometers, take a pit-stop in a typical Vietnamese house. Here, time seems to stand still: dark wood furniture, shrines to ancestors and a family that welcomes us with the hospitality typical of Southeast Asia. But don't worry, relaxation is just around the corner. It's just a few minutes' ride to the **Bamboo Island Resort**, on the banks of the river Cai. This is the perfect opportunity to recharge your batteries with **fresh fruit and just-opened coconut**, surrounded in a dreamy tropical atmosphere.

Just the time necessary to catch your breath and then it's back in the saddle, heading into the past. The last part of the tour will take you to the **Cham Ponagar tower**, a Hindu temple that's over 1,000 years old, a sacred place that still tells stories of a distant past. Then, it's a tranquil cycle ride along the **Cai river**, where the colorful fishing boats float on the water, ready to set off for another day of work.

A last look at the view, and then it's back to the city.

These two domes represent a design innovation and, surprisingly they are cool **havens**: indeed, the rare species housed here come from cooler climates than the sultry Singapore climate.
- Wandering along the garden pathways, we come to the **Hotel Marina Bay Sands**, where we have some free time to enjoy the wide selection of shops, the casino and to admire the spectacular architecture.

Once the site of newspaper offices, over time they have become purely shopping streets, packed with people and shops of all types, where you can find an infinite number of gifts or clothes, also at excellent prices. Not to mention the fact that we can always try our hand at a spot of haggling...

### The programme

- Just off the ship, we board a comfortable bus and arrive at the famous **Victoria Harbour**, admiring the waterfront with its views, one of the very most beautiful spots in the entire Hong Kong region.
- Then we head to the island's southern coast to visit the **Aberdeen** area where much of the population, especially immigrants from China, lives and works aboard junks anchored in the harbour.
- Our tour then stops off at **one of the largest of jewellery factories** in Hong Kong, where specialist designers create new models and artistic productions of special beauty, embellished with multiple varieties of semiprecious stones.
- Then we take a break to enjoy **a tasty light lunch** with rich exotically flavoured dishes.
- Next, we visit **Repulse Bay**, one of the most popular and best loved beaches in Hong Kong, surrounded by modern buildings erected under the watchful eye of the imposing statues of two Taoist deities, overlooking the bay. This place is packed with photo opportunities!
- After the spectacular view of Repulse Bay, we foray into one of the most colourful and delicious places in the city. **Stanley Market** is a vast indoor market located on the southern tip of Hong Kong. This distinctive building has all the charm of a time when there was only a small fishing village in the area, and offers views of the picturesque bay. In this enchanting setting shopaholics can indulge in the latest fashion clothes, gift items, handicrafts and much more.
- We then take a more mystically flavoured trip to the **Man Mo Temple**, built in 1847, where they worshiped two deities, the god of literature and god of war. People flock here to ask for academic success and to resolve disputes. We could call it a temple-court!
- We continue shopping on a road particularly well-known for its shops: **Hollywood Road**. The vast assortment of curiosities, antiques and local handicrafts offered by its shops make it a favourite destination for people who want to make special purchases.
- Our day ends fittingly with a visit to the Kowloon **Flower Market** a small oasis of scents in the midst of the city's dense high-rise buildings, where along with plants and flowers we can also find a wide range of useful accessories such as baskets, plant stands, and dried flower arrangements.

**THE THOUSAND SIDES OF MACAU**

**In a nutshell**

An unmissable full-day excursion dedicated to visiting Macau, the special administrative region of China separated from Hong Kong by the Pearl River estuary. A journey into the history of the city that used to be a former Portuguese territory and now characterised by a mixture of cultural influences and often described as Las Vegas of the East due to its many casinos. We delve into the history and tradition of Macau with its temples, cathedrals, squares and the historic city centre declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 2005, as well as into the modern side of this glistening city of a thousand faces.

**Main stops**

- Transfer to the ferry terminal in Hong Kong: visa and passport check
- Ferry from Hong Kong to Macau
- Stop for photos at the statue of Kun Iam
- Stop for photos at the A-Ma Taoist temple
- Delicious buffet lunch at the Macau Tower
- Portas do Cerco: border between Macau and continental China
- Ruins of St. Paul's Cathedral: UNESCO heritage
- Senado Square with mosaic floor
- Free time for shopping
- Macao casino: free time
- Transfer to the Macau ferry terminal: immigration checks
- Return to Hong Kong in the evening

**The programme**

- We set off for our excursion on a coach headed to the **Hong Kong ferry terminal** where we pass the **immigration check with our passport and visa**.
- After going through all the checks, we board the **ferry** and, after around one hour, **arrive in the charming city of Macau**.
- After going through another passport check, we get on a coach and set off on our tour to discover the city.
- The first stop is the **statue of Kun Iam** where we stop for a few **photos**. This bronze statue is 20

metres high and emerges, similarly to the Virgin Mary, from a 7 metre lotus flower. It is probably the only statue in the world depicting the **Goddess of Mercy** that does not look towards the sea.

- We make another **stop for photos** in front of the **A-Ma Taoist temple**, one of the most ancient temples with over 500 years of history declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site and dedicated to A-Ma, protective deity of sailors and fishermen.
- Before continuing our tour of Macao, we reach the **Macao Tower** where we enjoy a **delicious buffet lunch**. The tower is 338 m tall and it is similar to the Sky Tower in Auckland. Its observatory at 223 metres above ground offers breathtaking 360° views over the city.
- After lunch, we move on to **Portas do Cerco**, built by the Portuguese in the 19th century to mark the border after a battle with the Chinese army during which the city governor died. It now marks the **border separating Macau from continental China**.
- We now visit another important sight: the **ruins of St. Paul's Cathedral**, erected in the 16th century in the former Portuguese colony and of which only the façade and grand staircase boasting 68 steps remain. These ruins, featuring many Baroque statues, suggest that the majestic cathedral, which was almost entirely destroyed by a typhoon and a fire, was the largest Christian monument to be ever erected in Asia. In 2005, the ruins were declared a **UNESCO World Heritage Site** together with Macau's entire historical city centre.
- We then reach **Senado Square**, also known as Largo do Senado and one of the main and largest squares in Macau. Its name derives from the fact that the square has been located in front of the Leal Senado Building since the Ming dynasty. It truly shows the Portuguese dominion due to the buildings but also the **mosaic floor** in a wave pattern that recalls the city of Sintra in Portugal.
- We have some **free time available to buy some souvenirs** in the area before reaching the last stop on our tour: **one of the many casinos** thanks to which Macau is known as Las Vegas of the East. Macau's casinos employ around 20% of the population, but the locals rarely visit them, in fact most of the guests come from China and Hong Kong. \* Here, we have some **time available** to try our luck before returning to Hong Kong.
- After visiting the casino, we return by coach to the **ferry terminal** where we go through **immigration checks** again and board the ferry taking us **back to Hong Kong in the evening**. Once there, another coach takes us back to the ship.
- Guests must have their passport with them in order to take part in the excursion.
- We recommend bringing local currency.

- Changing scene, our next stop is the colourful **Flower Market** in the heart of Hong Kong. A small oasis of scents in the midst of dense high-rise buildings of the city, where as well as plants and flowers we find a wide range of useful accessories such as baskets, plant stands, and dried flower arrangements.
- Here we come upon the famous **Good Luck Plants** such as the *Lucky Bamboo* and other original flower arrangements that are so much part of ancient Chinese tradition.
- We continue our tour visiting another famous market, the **Jade Market**. In Hong Kong, jade is considered a symbol of wealth. The various and artistic accessories made with this stone are worn both for celebrations and in ceremonies to ward off evil spirits.
