*Cagliari***CAGLIARI, ANCIENT STORIES AND SEAFARERS****In a nutshell**

**The programme**

- With **our guide**, discover **Cagliari, the regional capital of Sardinia**, inhabited since Neolithic times. Start the tour on **Mount Urpinu**, which means vulpine in Sardinian dialect, an urban wildlife park that affords a view of the whole city: with **Poetto beach** and the **Molentargius-Saline Regional Nature Park** to one side, and the modern city, overlooked by the old town, to the other.
- As we skirt around this **natural oasis**, take a picture of the **pink flamingos** that nest here every year and then get ready to visit the **Shrine of Nostra Signora Bonaria** by reading the story that links it to the birth of Buenos Aires.
- Proceed to the highest part of the old town, with the **Museum Citadel** that includes the National Painting Gallery and Archaeological Museum exhibiting the **Giants of Mont'e Prama**.
- You've now come to the Castle, the medieval district from which the Sardinian name of the city, **Casteddu**, is derived. Admire the **Palazzo Viceregio**, the Genoese baroque style **Cathedral** and the bastions.
- Then say farewell to Cagliari passing through the ancient fishing district of Marina.
- Slight changes may be made to itineraries and the length of excursions in order to safeguard your health and comply with regulations and the safety protocol.
- When there are religious festivals, the visit to the cathedral will be limited to the outside.
- The excursion may take place in the morning or afternoon.

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## *Cagliari* **OLIVE GROVES, ART AND VINEYARDS**

### In a nutshell

What does **tradition taste like in Sardinia**? Of the **Sardinian extra virgin olive oil** that you will **taste** in a **historic family-run oil mill**, of the **superb wines that you will sample in a local winery** with views over the vineyards, but also of a surprising and fascinating culture: discover what an unusual snake is doing on the façade of the **church of San Pantaleo**, which dates back to 1101 AD.

- Dolianova: vineyards, olive groves
- Church of San Pantaleo
- Oleificio Locci and a tasting of 3 types of extra virgin olive oil
- Ferruccio Deiana winery with a tasting of 2 local wines and Sardinian products

### The programme

- When you see the vineyards that seem to be shaped by the wind, and the low, rolling hills criss-crossed by dry stone walls and flocks of animals, you know are in **southern Sardinia**, where everything has its own story to tell.
- You'll realize this immediately as you stand in front of the façade of the **church of San Pantaleo**, adorned with a long serpent. But wasn't this creature a symbol of evil? With the help of your **local guide**, the mystery will be solved in an instant.
- In Dolianova, **the owner of the Locci oil mill** will reveal the secrets of Sardinian oil production which goes back centuries – this particular mill has been pressing olives for the entire community since 1600.
- He will teach you how to **taste three types of extra virgin olive oil**, as well as how to recognize a high-quality product: it leaves the mouth feeling fresh and clean.
- And then you'll take a trip to the **Ferruccio Deiana winery** in Serdiana, where the skills required in order to care for the indigenous vines are handed down from father to son, along with a number of clever little tricks: do you know why there are always roses between the rows?
- After a tour of the cellars, you can enjoy a tasting **of our wines of excellence: Vermentino and Cannonau**, with views over the vineyards. Accompanied by Sardinian pecorino cheese, sausage and pane carasau, of course!
- This is one of the most popular experiences so book early.

## *Cagliari* **CAGLIARI, FROM A LOCAL'S POINT OF VIEW**

### In a nutshell

Discover Cagliari with someone who knows it really well. Take a seat on the bus and move among the most beautiful views of the city without taking a step: from the **Basilica di Bonaria** to the beach at **Poetto**, with the **Devil's Saddle**, then on to **Golfo degli Angeli** viewed from **Mount Urpinu** and a panoramic of **Castello** district, which encompasses all of the city's historic eras.

- photostop of Basilica of Nostra Signora di Bonaria

### The programme

- Eyes and ears wide open: you're about to discover **Cagliari with a local guide**. The bus starts at the **Basilica di Bonaria**, the protector of the city and of sailors. Dated 1307, it houses the **statue of the Virgin miraculously brought from the sea**.
- You're close to **Poetto**, a seafront promenade well-known for its fine sand and summer nightlife. You'll see the **salt flats**, an ancient source of wealth for the city, and the **Devil's Saddle**, a headland with a strange curvature. Legend has it that this is the devil's saddle that fell to earth and turned to stone during a battle between the angels and demons.
- Climb up to **Mount Urpinu**, a green haven just a stone's throw from the center, to take pictures of the view of **Golfo degli Angeli** between **Villasimius** and **Cape Spartivento**.
- Stroll along **Viale Buoncammino**, which passes close to the **Roman Amphitheater**, to the **Museum Citadel**, where archaeological finds and art collections are housed. Before moving on, take a look at the **San Pancrazio Tower**, the tallest in Cagliari, built in the 13th century.

The area is dominated by the **Temple of Jupiter**, built around 250 BC, and the **Basilica**, Pompeii's most impressive public building, used at the time both as a court house and as a place for commercial dealings.
- The **Street of Abundance** is the lower decumanus of Pompeii. Along it are many of the most beautiful houses in the city, some on two floors, belonging to the rich Pompeian bourgeoisie, with many colorful decorations which you can photograph.
- You will see the **House of the Ancient Hunt**, the original layout of which dates back to the mid-2nd century BC, with its refined frescoed pictorial decorations, and the **House of the Faun**, a sizeable, noble private residence covering an area of 3000 square meters.
- But Pompeii is more than just ruins, it is also a craft center, particularly for coral. Find out what cameos are.

## *Naples* **THE ROYAL PALACE OF CASERTA**

**In a nutshell** One of the most visited sites in the world and a UNESCO World Heritage site. With such credentials the Royal Palace of Caserta (Reggia di Caserta) does not fall short of expectations.

### Main stops

- We leave the Port of Naples by coach and head for Caserta and its splendid Royal Palace.
- The **Royal Palace of Caserta**, which was once the historic residence of Naples' Bourbon royal family, is recognised by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site. It is one of the most visited, and renowned examples of Italy's rich artistic heritage. The Bourbon King Charles of Naples, struck by the beauty of the landscape at Caserta and anxious that Naples have a worthy seat of government, decided in 1750 to build a residence that could compare with Versailles.
- Construction started on 20 January 1752 and continued without any interruption until 1759, the year when Charles had to move to Spain. At that point construction work slowed down and when the architect, Luigi Vanvitelli, died in 1773 the palace had not yet been completed. It was therefore his children, Louis and Charles who completed this monumental palace. The palace has a rectangular plan and is made up of blocks surrounding four internal courtyards, covering a surface area of approximately 47,000 square metres.
- The Royal Palace is surrounded by extensive **grounds** that are three kilometres long and cover approximately 120 hectares. They comprise two sections: the Italian garden and the English garden, the former characterized by various fountains and the famous **Grand Cascade**, and the latter by thick vegetation.

- At the port, your **guide** will already be waiting for you, along with your **electric bikes and helmets**, ready to pedal around the city safely, in an **environmentally-friendly way**.

- On **Via San Lorenzo**, which is entirely pedestrianized, you will spot loggias and decorations on the **noble palaces**: some of the most important visitors to Genoa and many other illustrious travelers have looked out of these windows over the centuries.

- From **Corso Italia**, the promenade par excellence, you'll already be able to catch a glimpse of the **little beach at Boccadasse**: the bay, which is hemmed in by the colorful houses, seems to be frozen in time, even with the modern city buzzing all around.

Excursions Office staff will be happy to offer you advice and assistance.

#### Number of participants

Some excursions require a minimum number of bookings and/or a maximum number of participants. These excursions are available on a first come first served basis, so it is advisable to book them well in advance.

#### Duration

The stated duration of excursions is subject to change without prior notice and can vary due to unforeseen circumstances, such as adverse weather conditions and/or transport delays. The order of certain visits may also be changed for the abovementioned reasons. #### Guests with limited mobility

#### Prices

The prices of excursions include transport available on site, which might include coach, limousine, taxi, funicular railways or boats.
