INTO THE EARTH'S DEPTHS: SPECTACULAR EXPLORATION OF THE CUEVA DEL VIENTO

In a nutshell

Venture into the wildest heart of **Tenerife**. From the **Mirador de San Pedro**, where the coast opens up like a tropical painting, to the **Cueva del Viento, the largest lava flow in Europe**, created 27,000 years ago by the Pico Viejo. Grab helmet and torch and cross ancient pine forests and fields, to the entrance of **Boca del Sobrado**. From here on, light fades and the adventure begins: Volcanic stalactites, deep crevices, primordial silence. A majestic lava maze that only reveals its secrets to those who dare descend into its depths.

Main stops

- Photo stop at the Mirador de San Pedro
- Cueva del Viento visitors centre
- Exploring the underground passages on foot

The programme

- We will leave the port by coach and head for the north-west part of Tenerife, where we will make our first stop at the **Mirador de San Pedro**, a scenic vantage point from where we will be able to admire the north coast in all its splendour, with its enchanting succession of palm trees, banana

plantations and ancient constructions.

- We will arrive at the visitors centre for the **Cueva del Viento**, the largest lava tunnel in Europe with 18 km of underground tunnels and branches.
- At the visitors centre, we will listen to **an interesting presentation** about this incredible geological site, during which we will find out that the intricate labyrinth, spread over three levels, was formed 27,000 years ago by the outflow of lava from the volcanic cone of the Pico Viejo.
- After being equipped with a helmet, torches and spare batteries, we travel by bus to the start of our **walk** that takes us into the heart of stunning panoramas, through cultivated fields, volcanic areas and pine forests, as we get closer to the **entrance to the Boca del Sobrado**: this is where our adventure in the bowels of the mountain really begins!
- With wide-eyed wonder **we explore the belly of the Earth** following spectacular underground tunnels decorated with stalactites, concretions of different kinds and deep fissures that will leave you lost for words.
- Back on the surface, we return to Santa Cruz, taking with us some unforgettable memories of an experience the like of which few can boast about!
- Guests with disabilities are not allowed on this excursion.
- This excursion is not recommended for guests that suffer from claustrophobia or problems with their knees or lower limbs.
- Children under the age of 5 are only allowed to participate if they are able to walk unaided on uneven ground.
- During the tunnel visit, you will not need to walk on all fours; in some sections, you will need to pay attention to obstacles located at head height.
- Helmets and torches are provided at the visitors centre.

LAS CAÑADAS DEL TEIDE NATIONAL PARK: A HIKE THROUGH PINES AND VOLCANIC LANDSCAPES

In a nutshell

Let **La Esperanza Forest** carry you away, a realm of ancient pine trees and younger eucalyptus trees, with

El Teide standing out on the horizon. Perfect for a **trekking** that will fully restore you. Continue amid changing landscapes and intense colors to the vast **Las Cañadas del Teide National Park**, which guards the tallest volcano in Spain. Here, amid ancient lava flows and lunar landscapes, reach **Los Roques de García**, a natural amphitheater made of rocks sculpted by time. An immersion into earth, fire and silence that will leave you breathless.

Main stops

- La Esperanza Forest
- Las Cañadas del Teide National Park and Mount Teide
- Los Roques de García

The programme

- We will leave the port by coach and arrive at **La Esperanza Forest**, where a magnificent pine reserve awaits, inside which we will also discover a eucalyptus plantation. From here, it is already possible to glimpse an attractive view of Mount Teide.
- We then head towards a magical area characterised by alternating colour hues to arrive at the **Las Cañadas del Teide National Park**, which presently covers an area of 18,990 hectares and which includes the volcanic crater from where the majestic Mount Teide emerges, the highest summit in Spain (3,718 metres).
- After admiring the various lava formations and enjoying the impressive views, our trip concludes in **Los Roques de García**, within the grounds of the Hotel Parador Nacional, from where we will then return to the ship.
- We recommend that you book early because only a limited number of places are available.
- This excursion does not include a guide. Information in English or Spanish will be provided by a local escort during the trip.
- This excursion is not recommended for guests with mobility problems.
- It is recommended to wear appropriate clothing.

As soon as you arrive, the **Basilica of Our Lady of Candelaria** will call to you from afar: it's the most beloved sanctuary of the Canary Islands, home to the famous patron saint of the archipelago. And when you approach the square, surrounded by statues of the Guanche – indigenous inhabitants of the island – with the scent of salt in the air, you'll understand why over two million people come here every year.

Wander along the seafront and find yourself catapulted into a world that alternates between **picturesque corners** and **ultra-modern shopping centers**, in a surprisingly harmonious way. Fresh fish? Here, it's everywhere: It is the beating heart of **Villa Mariana** (another name for Candelaria), which has turned tradition into an art form, and its deep roots into a real strength.

And when you want to take a break, the **black volcanic sand beaches** await you, creating a spectacular contrast with the green of the hills.

With your eyes still full of wonder, you can sit down and **let yourself be transported to the airport in comfort**. A last treat before heading home.

Candelaria is not just a pit stop: it's a living mosaic of land, sea, people and tradition that continues to resonate inside you, even after you leave.

BY CABLE CAR TO THE CAÑADAS DEL TEIDE: THE HIGHEST MOUNTAIN IN SPAIN

In a nutshell

Venture into the wild soul of **Tenerife!** Let nature surround you in **La Esperanza Forest** and majestic **Orotava Valley**. Mighty pine and eucalyptus trees accompany you to **El Portillo**, the natural threshold to **Las Cañadas del Teide National Park**. Here, the landscape changes: Volcanic canyons, lunar expanses, craters that seem suspended in time. **Take the cable car up to El Teide**, a scenic flight between sky and lava, until you brush against the fire titan that dominates the island and the ocean. A vertical trip where the ground still burns under your feet and the sky looks just a step away.

Main stops

- Santa Cruz, La Esperanza Forest and Orotava Valley
- El Portillo and Las Cañadas del Teide National Park
- Cable car and Teide Volcano

The programme

- We will depart from **Santa Cruz** on the discovery of the hinterland of the island of Tenerife, crossing **La Esperanza Forest** and **Orotava Valley**, amongst a wealth of giant pines and eucalyptus.
- We will arrive in the area of **El Portillo**, a natural access route to the circular mountain chain of the **Las Cañadas del Teide National Park**, where **Mount Teide** stands, which, at 3,718 metres high, is the tallest mountain in Spain.
- We will continue our tour bypassing magnificent and unforgettable landscapes until we get to the **Teide cable car**, at the heart of the National Park of the same name, the largest on the Canary Islands and the most visited in Europe. Climbing to the very top by cable car, we can admire the immense landscape and view the craters and coloured lava, least forgetting, the **Teide volcano**, one of the four tallest and largest structures on the planet, measured from the bottom of the sea and the third largest active volcano in the world.
- After the cable car experience, encircled by stunning landscape, we will return to the ship.
- During this excursion we reach an altitude of 3,500 metres, along a road that is winding in parts, it is therefore recommended to wear appropriate clothing. For your safety, it is important to wear hiking boots or trainers.
- We recommend that you book early because only a limited number of places are available.

NORTHERN TENERIFE: 4X4 INTO UNTOUCHED NATURE

In a nutshell

On a 4x4, venture amid legendary hairpin turns and impressive landscapes. Climb to **San Andrés**: The landscape changes with every bend, **from subtropical vegetation to laurel forests** that witnessed distant eras. Take a photo from **Mirador de Los Roques**, then get lost in the alleys between the white houses of **Taganana**, with its **the ancient church** guarding a **Flemish gem**. Breathe in the ocean's might on the black sands of **Playa de Almáciga**, inhale the inebriating scents of **Roque Negro**, and finally let your gaze embrace the entire island from the **Pico del Inglés**. The **northern side of Tenerife**, amid nature, history and unfiltered wonder.

Main stops

- San Andrés
- Mirador de Los Roques
- Taganana and Santuario de Nuestra Señora de las Nieves
- Playa de Almáciga
- Roque Negro
- Mirador Pico del Inglés and Mirador de Jardina

The programme

- We will depart in a jeep in the direction of **San Andrés**, taking a road with abundant turns and stunning views bypassing a constantly changing landscape. Over a range of just 4-5 km, we will see both subtropical plantlife and laurel tree woodland, typical of the coast. The island's native plantlife cannot but fascinate: some plants even date back to the Tertiary period.
- After a short break to take some photos at **Mirador de Los Roques**, a truly stunning panoramic viewpoint, we will head towards **Taganana**, a typical village with small white houses, which clings to the slopes of a hill overlooking the sea. By way of stone passageways, we will arrive at the **Church Nuestra Señora de las Nieves**, where it is possible to admire a fascinating Flemish triptych from the 500s.
- We will descend towards **Playa de Almáciga**, famous for its volcanic beach with black sand, where we will take a brief break and admire the landscape.
- We will then head towards **Roque Negro** by way of a road which captivates the senses with decidedly Mediterranean colours and scents.
- Once we arrive at **Mirador Pico del Inglés**, 992 metres above sea level, we can finally enjoy a view of the entire island, from north to south, at a glance.
- The last stop on our tour is **Mirador de Jardina**, from where we will begin our return to the port.
- The planned panoramic itinerary includes a number of curves and hairpin bends.
- This excursion does not include a guide. Information in English or Spanish will be provided by the driver during the trip.

- If the stop at Pico del Inglés and/or Jardina cannot be carried out, it will be replaced with a stop in San Cristóbal de La Laguna before returning to the port.
- This excursion is not recommended for guests with mobility problems.
- We recommend that you book early because only a limited number of places are available.
- Minimum age: 5 years.
- Minimum height: 120 cm.

Excursion Booking
