The programme

- The tour starts on the seafront, with a view of the **port** and the city **skyline** in the background.
- Proceed to **Bellver Castle**, an example of **Majorcan Gothic architecture** and the only **circular plan** fortress in Spain. Its raised position will tempt you with a unique view of Palma Bay: can you fit it all into one picture?
- The **panoramic route** continues along the **Paseo Maritimo**, between historic buildings and luxury yachts, **Avenida Jaime III** and **Paseo del Borne**.
- Cross the **Parque del Mar**, where the saltwater lake reflects your next destination: the **Cathedral of Santa Maria**, renovated by Gaudí in the early 1900s. Aim your lens at the great **Ojo del Gótico** rose window, one of the biggest ever created in the Gothic style.
- Your gallery won't be complete without a few glimpses of **Old Palma**, including the **Town Hall**, craft shops and cafés.
- Before returning to the ship, take a final snapshot of the **Lonja**, the former fish market now converted into a contemporary art museum. Don't be amazed if your social media accounts get lots of likes.
- The **Adagio Tour** was born from the collaboration between Costa Crociere Foundation and AISM, with the aim of offering land experiences at a **lower price** and itineraries with fewer architectural barriers, designed for people with accessibility needs.

In the Sierra de Tramuntana there is a ver train that **travels back in time**. It takes you to the town of **Sóller**, a seaside jewel of the Balearics. Retro atmospheres and **27 km of beautiful scenery** to get there. So climb aboard.

- The mode of transport is an **old electric train dating from 1912**, perfectly preserved and complete with polished wooden carriages, leather seats and overhead luggage racks.
- The journey takes you along the ancient track that crosses the Sierra de Tramuntana, declared a **UNESCO World Heritage Site**, past villages, terraces and panoramic views.
- After around fifty minutes, **passing through 13 tunnels dug out of the rock** and across several bridges, you'll arrive in Sóller. Follow **our guide** through the streets and past architectural gems like the **Church of San Bartomeu**.
- At the end of the tour, our bus will take us all back to reality.
- The trip can be taken by train for the outward journey, returning by bus, or vice versa.
- The train has no toilets (these are only available at the station) and no air conditioning, and is not equipped for passengers in wheelchairs.

- Then it's through the alleys of the **old town** to a local bar. Are you ready for the ultimate Spanish tasting session? You'll taste **tapas** accompanied by a glass of **sangría**, the traditional drink made with sweetened red wine and fresh seasonal fruit.
- A shuttle bus is available for your outward and return journey to the ship.

Palma De Mallorca GOTHIC SEASIDE

In a nutshell

Discover a side of Palma that's unknown to most tourists. In the medieval quarter, you'll find the **only** seaside **Gothic cathedral** in the world, with its emblematic sixty-one colored windows projecting huge swatches of light into the building. And as a souvenir, buy a few **Majorca pearls**: you'd never tell they were artificial! At the end of the excursion, if the length of the stopover permits, stay as long as you wish in the city center for a walk and some shopping and then get back on board free of charge with the Costa shuttle bus service, showing your Costa Card to the driver. Check the time for returning on board and of the last available shuttle bus in **Øggi a Bordo**

Main stops

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- Cathedral of Santa Maria, medieval quarter
- Pearl shop

The programme

- It looks like a huge ship anchored by the sea, but it is the **Cathedral of Santa Maria**, better known as **La Seu**. Built in the **Levantine Gothic** style, it will amaze you with the size of its nave and the so-called **Ojo del Gótico**, the gigantic rose window made up of 1,236 pieces of colored glass. Built between 1229 and 1601, it was renovated in the 20th century by none other than Antoni Gaudí, who added to it some elements in the modernist style.
- Right beside it is the **Almudaina Royal Palace**, a **Muslim alcázar** from 1281, later the seat of the Kingdom of Aragon and today the summer residence of the Spanish royal family.
- And as a final touch to remember, take home a few **Majorca pearls**. They are artificial, but will deceive even an experienced eye. They have been produced by craftsmen on the island since the end of the 19th century.
- On Sundays and religious festivals, the visit to the cathedral will be limited to the outside.
- The excursion may take place in the morning or afternoon.

- Following one of these routes, you'll skirt the ancient city walls and arrive at **Parc de la Mar**. There are a few stops here and there to see the ancient Church of Sant'Eulalia and the **Gothic Cathedral** of Santa Maria (La Seu), renovated under the direction of **Antoni Gaudí**. Did you know that this is where you'll find the **Ojo del Gótico**? It's one of the biggest rose windows in Europe.
- Keep pedaling and you'll come to **Plaza Mayor**, the heart of the cultural and commercial life of Palma. Then it's a gentle downward slope to the Ramblas and the Passeig Maritim. We'll come back fully fit and toned after this **bike city tour**.
- During the tour, a local guide will provide information in English and Spanish.
- Child bikes and seats are available on request.

CONCERT IN THE DRAGON CAVES AND MAJORCAN PEARLS

In a nutshell

One excursion, **two pearls**, in the true sense of the word. As you enter the **Dragon Caves**, a **floating orchestra** will perform a classical music concert for you. Immediately after this, you'll visit a factory making **Majorcan pearls**: as beautiful as the real thing.

Main stops

- Dragon Cave, classical music concert
- Palma pearls

The programme

- Your adventure starts at **Porto Cristo**, on the eastern coast of Majorca. Here a huge complex of underground caves and lakes known as the **Dragon Caves** awaits you.
- You will walk towards the **Martel lake**, which at 117 meters long and 30 meters wide, is one of the biggest in the world. You'll come into a natural amphitheater that can accommodate up to 1000 people and where the acoustics are crystal clear.
- A **quartet of cello, harpsichord and violins** will play several pieces of classical music for you. All of this surrounded by the beautiful **dancing lights** and reflections in the water: truly magical.
- Right after this we'll take you to the nearby **Majorica** factory, famous the world over for making imitation **pearls** that even experts struggle to distinguish from the real thing. This authentic **craftsmanship** dates back to the end of the 19th century. The temptation to take some home as a **souvenir** is irresistible.

During the tour, you can take photos and film without using a flash or tripod. No photography or filming is allowed during the concert.

Transfer time from the port to the Caves is approximately 1 hour and 30 minutes.

The Dragon Caves wind their way underground and are reached by descending flights of steps cut into the earth, which are not always dry.

AMONG THE SYMBOLS OF PALMA AND VALDEMOSA

In a nutshell

From a Carthusian monastery to the view from Son Marroig and a **guided tour of Sóller, in the Valley of Oranges**. We're serving up a corner of the Balearics on **the longest ever excursion**.

Main stops

- Valldemossa and the gardens of Valldemossa Charterhouse (external visit)
- Town of Sóller
- Palma: Cathedral and Almudiana Palace (external visits)

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The programme

- In **Valdemossa**, one of the most beautiful towns in Majorca, you'll visit the **Cartuja**, the former hunting reserve of King Sancho that became a Carthusian monastery in the 15th century. Valldemossa is also famous for the 'coca de patata', the traditional brioche that's ideal as a 'quick bite' as this snack is referred to here.
- Accompanied by the **guide**, you'll then arrive in the **town of Sóller**, in the 'valley of oranges' or 'golden valley'. Here you'll find the juiciest and most aromatic oranges in Spain. Also produced here is a fruity distilled liquor called Angel d'Or.
- Last stop, external visit to **Palma Cathedral**, a majestic example of the Catalan Gothic style. You'll also see the exterior of the adjacent **Almudaina Palace**, former residence of the Kings of Majorca and, earlier still, an Arab fortress.

- In the reproduction of the Andalusian quarter, we visit the Tablao de Carmen, named after the great dancer Carmen Amaya, where we attend a flamenco show, the dance that best represents the Iberian soul.

The programme

- We leave the port behind us and head towards the Eixample district, where we begin by visiting an extraordinary UNESCO World Heritage Site: the **Hospital de la Santa Creu i Sant Pau**, a complex of monumental buildings connected via underground passages and enchanting gardens boasting numerous sculptures featuring symbolic details. It is one of the most unusual and lesser known of Barcelona's marvels created by architect Domènec i Montaner.
- We continue with the **Sagrada Família** to admire its façades, doors and towers. The vastness of the design and its unique style have made Gaudí's unfinished project the most iconic in the city.
- We have lunch in a **typical restaurant** where we can savour **a few Iberian specialities** including *patatas bravas, ensaladilla rusa, corquetas, buñuelos* and *pulpo*... All these traditional delicacies cater to our palate's every whim and perfect to nibble and share *para compartir*. Just the way the Spaniards do!
- After refuelling, we continue towards **Casa Vicens**, the first important project commissioned to Gaudí. Declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 2005, the modernist building combines Gothic, Mediterranean and Islamic elements while expressing the amateurish yet already unique style of the artist, who was looking for a *Gothic building full of light, which made use of colour; a Gothic that was half maritime, half continental*.
- Our excursion continues with a stop for photos at one of Gaudí's most famous works of art: **Casa Milà**. This monumental, eccentric and futuristic building – also known as *La Pedrera* * enabled the architect to break with all of the architectural rules of the time thereby sparking the rage of the municipal authorities and attracting the criticism of his colleagues while, at the same time, managing to create what went down in history as one of the most representative examples of his naturalist period and modernism in general.
- We then move on to the splendid **Barrio Gótico**, the historic city centre and vibrant hub of the Catalan capital. We take in this open-air museum and let ourselves be conquered by the timeless atmosphere which envelops its maze of alleyways.
- The central element of the Barrio Gótico and the maximum representation of the style the district is named after is Barcelona Cathedral, i.e. **Cathedral of the Holy Cross and Saint Eulalia**. With its

stained glass windows and statues characterized by a more expressive and angular naturalism, it perfectly incarnates the archetype of Gothic architecture whose features inevitably invite observers to lift their gaze upwards and admire its beauty in its entirety.

- Our tour has come to an end but, before returning to the ship, we enjoy some **free time** to do a spot of shopping or stroll around the city centre while we remind ourselves of the incredible experience that has enabled us to fully experience this dynamic city.
- We recommend that you book early as only a limited number of places are available.

Excursion Booking

You can book excursions before departure by visiting the website www.mycosta.com, or by requesting to be contacted by our "Excursion Service" at +34 932952144 or through a request on the MyCosta website. Once on board, excursions can be booked through the Costa App, the Excursion Totem, or by visiting the MyTours office, where our staff will be available to offer advice and assistance.

Participation

Some excursions require a minimum number of bookings and have a maximum number of participants, so it is advisable to book them in advance.

Duration

The duration of the excursions is indicated in the description of each tour. Due to unforeseen circumstances, such as adverse weather conditions and/or transport delays, the duration may be subject to change. The program of individual excursions may also be modified for the reasons mentioned above. Please adhere to the times indicated by the guides at each stop (rest stops, photo stops, etc.).

Description

The descriptions of the excursions are up-to-date as of the printing of this document. However, in the interest of continuously improving our guests' shore experiences, the actual program may differ from the description.
