A surprising journey through cobbled streets, drawbridges, historic churches and spectacular views of the city and the sea.

The programme

- Touring it on foot you'll discover the traces of the many civilizations that inhabited the island: **Phoenicians, Carthaginians, Romans, Muslims and finally Catalans**. It was they who changed the original Phoenician name, Ibosim, to Eivissa, which then became Ibiza.
- In front of the cathedral of **Nuestra Señora de las Nieves**, remember that it stands on the site of a miraculous snowfall. While the church of **Santo Domingo** will impress you with its red roof tiles.
- Last stop is the **Portal de Ses Taules**: a photo of the drawbridge is a good reminder of the historical side of Ibiza.
- This is one of the most popular excursions so book early.
- The excursion may take place in the morning or afternoon.
- The excursion takes place mainly on foot with uphill routes and cobbled streets.
